



The MIMU 3W gathers inputs from participating humanitarian and development agencies on **Who is doing What, Where**, across Myanmar. This exercise is currently conducted every 6 months, collecting information on agencies' activities at village/township level (MIMU Village level 3W) as well as in IDP camps (MIMU Camp 3W).

205 agencies contributed to the April '15 3W, providing information on their activities in the 19 sectors and 145 sub-sectors defined through the technical/sector working groups. The level of reporting among INGOs, Red Cross and UN agencies and Border-based organisations is high, but there is still likely under-reporting of the activities of field-based local NGOs and CBOs.

This Overview describes reported *Projects under Implementation* with *Non-IDP beneficiaries* at township, village tract or village level in Kachin as of March 25, 2015. Hence it includes activities with mixed beneficiary populations (non-IDP and IDP), but does not include interventions which were specified as "IDP-only". A village tract level mapping of the projects reported by beneficiary type is also included.

1. Organizations active at Village level in Kachin

In total, 58 agencies reported activities in Kachin state - 20 are engaged in non-IDP response activities only (358 villages), 31 are engaged in activities which target IDP and Non-IDP beneficiaries (207 villages) and 7 are active in IDP-only response activities (156 IDP camps and 97 villages). In all there were 88 village or township based projects in Kachin (non-IDP and mixed beneficiary groups), and 25 reported camp-based projects (IDP only).

For the development focused (non-IDP response) activities, 51 organizations reported 88 projects under implementation in Kachin that are village or township based. The majority are by NGOs. There is some level of agency activity reported in all townships and in most village tracts, with agencies most concentrated in Myitkyina, Waingmaw Bhamo and Mogaung, and least concentrated in Khaunglanhpu and Tsawlaw which are harder to reach.

2. Projects by Sector (Village-level 3W)

88 projects were reported in 16 sectors in 517 villages across Kachin, representing 12% of the total projects reported to the countrywide 3W.

<u>In terms of the number of agencies</u>: Myitkyina township has the highest concentration of active organisations (33 agencies), followed by Waingmaw (24 agencies), Mogaung (20 agencies), Momauk and Bhamo (19 agencies in each) and least concentrated in Khaunglanhpu (1 agency).

In terms of the frequency of project interventions:


Health is the most widespread intervention with 16 organizations reportedly implementing 27 projects in 398 villages. In terms of geographic spread, some level of health activity was reported in 16 of the 18 townships in Kachin, though it is reportedly more concentrated in the townships of Myitkyina (10 agencies), Waingmaw and Momauk (8 agencies in each) and Mansi and Mogaung (7 agencies in each). The majority of village-level health interventions are Harm Reduction (213 villages in 107)

village tracts), Malaria Programme (201 villages in 201 village tracts), TB Programme (135 villages in 90 village tracts).


- Agriculture is the second most commonly reported sector reportedly under implementation by 5 agencies in 108 villages in 85 village tracts across 15 of the 18 townships in Kachin. The main activities; Agriculture Development (53 villages in 44 village tracts), Agriculture Extension (36 villages in 34 village tracts) and Forestry (22 villages in 23 village tracts).
- Protection is the third main sector with 15 agencies reported in 97 villages and 74 village tracts across 16 of the 18 townships in Kachin, particularly in Myitkyina (9 agencies), Waingmaw (7 agencies), Bhamo and Mogaung (5 agencies in each). The most frequent activity is Promoting Gender Equality and Empowerment of Women (54 villages) and child protection (43 villages).
- Non-Agricultural Livelihood/Infrastructure is the fourth main sector of agency activities with 5 organizations implementing activities in 70 villages (50 village tracts/towns), in 9 of the 18 townships. The majority of interventions are Income Generation (70 villages), Vocational Education and Training (66 villages) and Micro-Finance (53 villages).
- There is far less activity reported at village level in other sectors; Environment (5 agencies, 53 villages), Food (7 agencies, 48 villages) and Education (6 agencies, 37 villages). Others were Peace Building/ Conflict Prevention (4 agencies, 49 village tracts), Governance (4 agencies, 3 village tracts), WASH (5 agencies, 3 village tracts), Coordination and Disaster Risk Reduction (3 agencies, 2 village tracts/Towns in each), Mine Action and Nutrition (2 agencies in each), CCCM and Shelter (1 agency in each). No projects were reported as under implementation for the Private Sector development and Non-Food Items Sectors.




