

# Overview of the April 2015 3W KAYAH State



The MIMU 3W gathers inputs from participating agencies on **Who** is doing **What**, **Where** in Myanmar. It is currently conducted every 6 months.

205 agencies participated in the April 15 3W, providing information on their activities in 19 sectors and 145 sub-sectors which have been defined by technical/sector working groups. There is still likely to be under-reporting of the specific activities of field-based local NGOs and CBOs.

This overview of the reported 3W results in Kayah describes *projects under implementation* as of March 25, 2015. Further information on planned and recently completed projects is available from the 3W dataset, published on the MIMU website or available through our offices.

### 1. Active Organizations in Kayah

A total of 46 organizations reported projects under implementation in Kayah. The majority are NGOs with 5 border-based organizations. Some level of agency activity has been reported in all village tracts, with agencies most concentrated in Demoso, Loikaw and Hpruso townships.

### 2. Projects by Sector


75 projects were reported in 16 sectors (10% of the total projects reported to the 3W). In terms of the frequency of project interventions:

- Health is the most widespread intervention with 15 organizations reportedly implementing 26 projects in 566 villages across 74 village tracts (100 % of the total in Kayah). There is some level of health activity in all 7 townships, though more concentrated in the townships of Demoso (12 agencies), Loikaw (11 agencies) and Hpruso (10 agencies). The majority of health interventions are Maternal and Child Health (543 villages), Malaria Programme (343 villages) and Basic Health Care (129 villages).
- **Protection is the second most widespread** intervention with 12 organizations reportedly implementing 15 projects in 191 villages, mainly focus on the activity of Civil Documentation (165 villages). Protection activities are found in all 7 townships but most concentrated in Loikaw and Demoso (5 agencies in each).
- **Education** is the third main sector of agency activities in Kayah with 11 organizations active in 147 villages, most frequently in support to ECD (108 villages). Education activities are also found in all 7 townships but most concentrated in Demoso and Hpruso (7 agencies in each) and Loikaw (6 agencies).
- **Mine Action** is the fourth main sector with agency activities in 118 villages, mostly in Mine-Risk Education (113 villages). Similarly, Mine Action activities are also found in all 7 townships but most concentrated in Loikaw (7 agenceis) and Demoso (6 agencies).
- **Non-Agricultural Livelihoods** is the fourth main sector with agency activities in 118 villages, most frequently in Income generation (95 villages) and Vocational Education and Training (50 villages). The activities are found in 5 of total 7 townships but most concentrated in Loikaw (5 agencies and Demoso (4 agencies)
- Agriculture is the fifth main sector with agency activities in 105 villages across 39 village tracts, mostly in Agricultural Extension (49 villages) but also in Plant production, Livestock and poultry and Capacity building around Agricultural livelihoods (26-30 villages in each).


- **WASH** is the sixth main sector, reportedly through 2 projects under implementation in 65 villages. The majority of WASH interventions are Hygiene Promotion & Behaviour Change (38 villages) and Excreta Disposal/Treatment/Management Household Level (37 villages).
- **Governance** is the seventh main sector with agency activities in 55 villages\_in 29 village tracts, most frequently in Strengthening Civil Society (37 villages) followed by a focus on Human Rights and Advocacy. 1 election focused project was reported in this round, reaching 1 township, Projects focusing on Economic and development planning were reportedly reaching all 7 townships.
- There is far less attention reported to other sectors; Nutrition (3 agencies, 46 villages), Non-Food Items (1 agency, 26 villages), Peace Building and Conflict Prevention (3 agencies, 74 village Tracts/Towns), Food (3 agencies, 9 village Tracts/Towns), Private Sector Development (2 agencies, 7 townships), Environment (1 agency and 1Town) and Coordination and Disaster Risk Reduction (1 agency).
- No organizations reported activities in Disaster Risk Reduction or Shelter sectors.




