

## Overview of the April 2015 3W for SOUTH EAST of Myanmar

Bago (East), Kayah, Kayin, Mon, Shan (East), Shan (South) and Tanintharyi

The MIMU 3W gathers inputs from participating agencies on ***Who is doing What, Where***, across Myanmar. It is currently conducted every 6 months.

205 agencies participated in the April 2015 3W, providing information on their activities in 19 sectors and 145 sub-sectors which have been defined by technical/sector working groups. There is still likely to be under-reporting of the specific activities of field-based local NGOs and CBOs.

This overview covers activities reported to the MIMU 3W in Bago (East), Kayah, Kayin, Mon, Shan (East), Shan (South) and Tanintharyi as of March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2015.

The tables and charts refer to projects under implementation as of March 25, 2015. For information on planned and recently completed projects is included in the 3W dataset which is available on the MIMU website, as well as in the MIMU 3W Dashboard which shows agencies' activities to Township level.

### 1. The South East

The South East of Myanmar comprises 84 Townships, 2,471 Village tracts and 16,608 Villages (as per the MIMU Place Codes). GPS coordinates have been obtained for 61% of these villages in the SE (10,109 villages) through agencies' active support to the MIMU Place Code initiative. Efforts continue to confirm GPS coordinates for the remaining 6,499 villages. Chaungzon, Thanbyuzayat, Mudon and Ye Townships have the best rates of village mapping (availability of GPS coordinates), while Shwegyin, Hpapun and Kyunsu Townships have the lowest level of mapped villages.

### 2. Active Organizations

Agencies were found to be active in all 84 townships throughout the South East with activities in 73% of Village Tracts (1,760 village tracts) and in 36% of the villages across the SE with Place codes (6,029 villages).

A total of 132 organizations reported projects under implementation across the South East (SE). The majority are NGOs (112 agencies, 27 of whom are border-based – namely 22 CBOs, 3 NNGOs and 2 INGOs). In terms of project spread, Mon had the highest concentration of agencies (62), followed by Kayin (61 agencies), Tanintharyi (52), Shan South (49), Kayah (46), Bago East (44). The lowest reported concentration is in Shan East (20 agencies).

### 3. Projects by Sector

368 projects were reported across the SE in 17 sectors, making up 49% of the total projects reported to the 3W. No organization reported activities in the CCCM and Logistics sectors.

- **Health is the most widespread intervention among agencies in the SE** with 42 agencies (30 of them NGOs and 4 Red Cross agencies) reportedly implementing some form of health activity through 98 projects in 3,320 villages across 1,254 village tracts in 83 townships. The majority are Malaria Programme activities (2,504 villages), followed by Reproductive Health Care (1,031 villages), Maternal and Child Health (691 villages), Control of Communicable Diseases (679) and TB Programme (668). Health activities are found in all the states/regions but most concentrated in Mon and Kayin. The Health sector has a higher number of UN agencies than in other sectors of activity.

- **Protection is the second most commonly reported sector** with 45 projects under implementation by 32 agencies in 1,907 villages in 729 village tracts across 60 townships. These consist mainly of activities around Civil Documentation (1,538 villages), but also activities focused on Child Protection (222 villages). Protection agencies were found to be widespread in all states and regions but most concentrated in Mon. Most of the activities are implemented by NGOs/CBOs (28 agencies).
- **Non-Agricultural Livelihoods and Infrastructure is the third main sector** with 32 agencies implementing 41 projects reaching 1,390 villages in 50 townships (367 village tracts). These are mainly Microfinance interventions (1,033 villages), followed by Income Generation activities (289 villages), Vocational Education and Training (211), Social Recovery (204) and Cash-for-work interventions (127). Non-Agricultural Livelihood activities are most numerous in Kayin, Mon and Kayah, while only one agency reported activities in Shan East.
- **Agriculture is the fourth main sector** with 39 projects underway by 21 organizations reported activities in 1,319 villages in 54 townships, the main subsectors being Agriculture Water Resources (896 villages), Agricultural Inputs (153), Capacity Building (139), Agriculture Development (95), Agriculture Extension (72), Agricultural Alternative Development and Plant Production (63 respectively).

Other sectors in order of the spread of activities are:

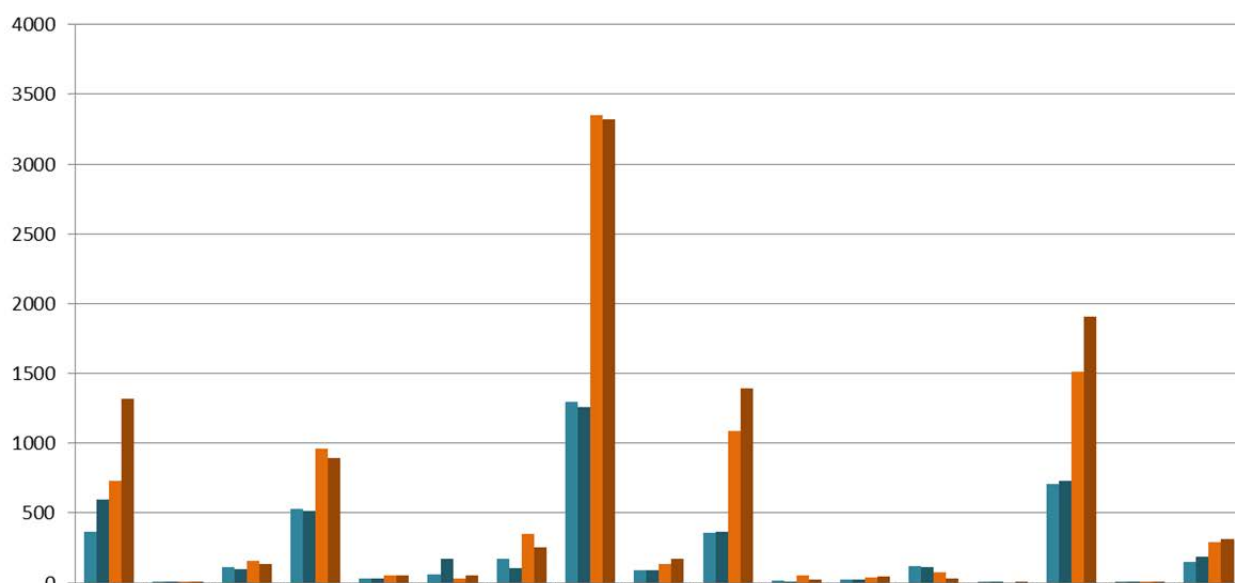
- **Education** – 48 projects under implementation in 891 villages in 516 village tracts by 25 organizations (22 of them NGOs), most frequently Early Childhood Development / ECD (676 villages), followed by support to the Quality Basic Education (183) and Non-Formal Education / NFE support (64). Food for Education activities were reported in 34 village tracts, however village level data was not reported. Agency activities were found to be more concentrated in Kayin, followed by Kayah, Tanintharyi and Shan (South).
- **WASH** - 16 organizations reporting activities in 310 villages, most frequently focused on Hygiene Promotion & Behaviour Change (152), Water Supply – Household Level (135) and Excreta Disposal/Treatment/Management – Household Level (134).
- **Governance** activities are reported by 23 agencies reaching 255 villages, mostly focused on Institutional Strengthening and Public Administration Reform (119 villages) and Strengthening Civil Society (105 villages). Border-based agencies tend to be more active in the Governance sector than in other sectors of activity in the SE with 7 BBOs reporting governance projects under implementation.
- **Mine Action** activities are reported by 13 agencies in 169 villages across 90 village tracts (19 townships). These are mainly in Mine Risk Education (159 villages).
- **Disaster Risk Reduction** / DRR activities are reported by 9 agencies in 138 villages in 97 village tracts across 19 townships, mostly focused on Community-based Disaster Preparedness and Risk Reduction (102 villages) and Public Awareness, Education and Training (36 villages).
- **Food** activities are reported by 15 agencies through 4 projects reaching 172 village tracts in 43 townships, mostly in General Food Distribution (29 villages).
- **Environment** activities are reported by 11 agencies, reaching 52 villages in 17 townships.
- **Nutrition** activities are reported by 4 agencies reaching 46 villages, mostly in Infant and Young Child Feeding (46 villages) and Nutritional Surveillance (30).
- **Peacebuilding/Conflict Prevention** activities were reported by 10 agencies reaching 33 villages and 111 village tracts with activities in Conflict Transformation and Peacebuilding (26 villages), Civil Administration (7 villages) and Support for Durable Solutions for Returnees (81 village tracts).
- **Non-Food Items** activities mainly focusing on NFI distribution are reported by 1 agency reaching 26 villages in 2 townships in Kayah.
- **Private Sector Development activities** – being included for only the second time to capture emerging work in this sector, private sector development activities have been reported by 3 agencies, reaching 12 townships with activities in Public-Private partnerships (11 villages).
- **Shelter activities** (Permanent Shelter activities) were reported in 1 township by 1 agency (1 village).

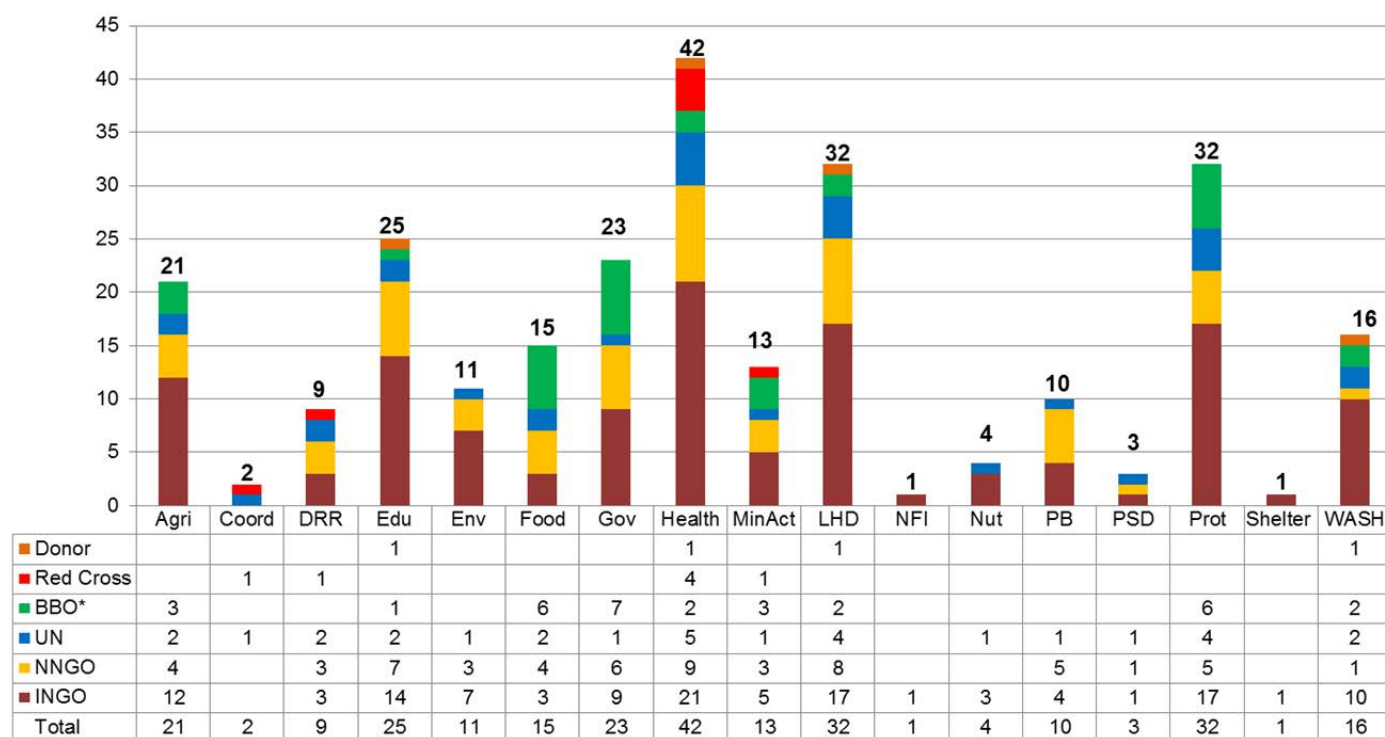
### Reporting Status on the Village Tract (VT) / Village Level



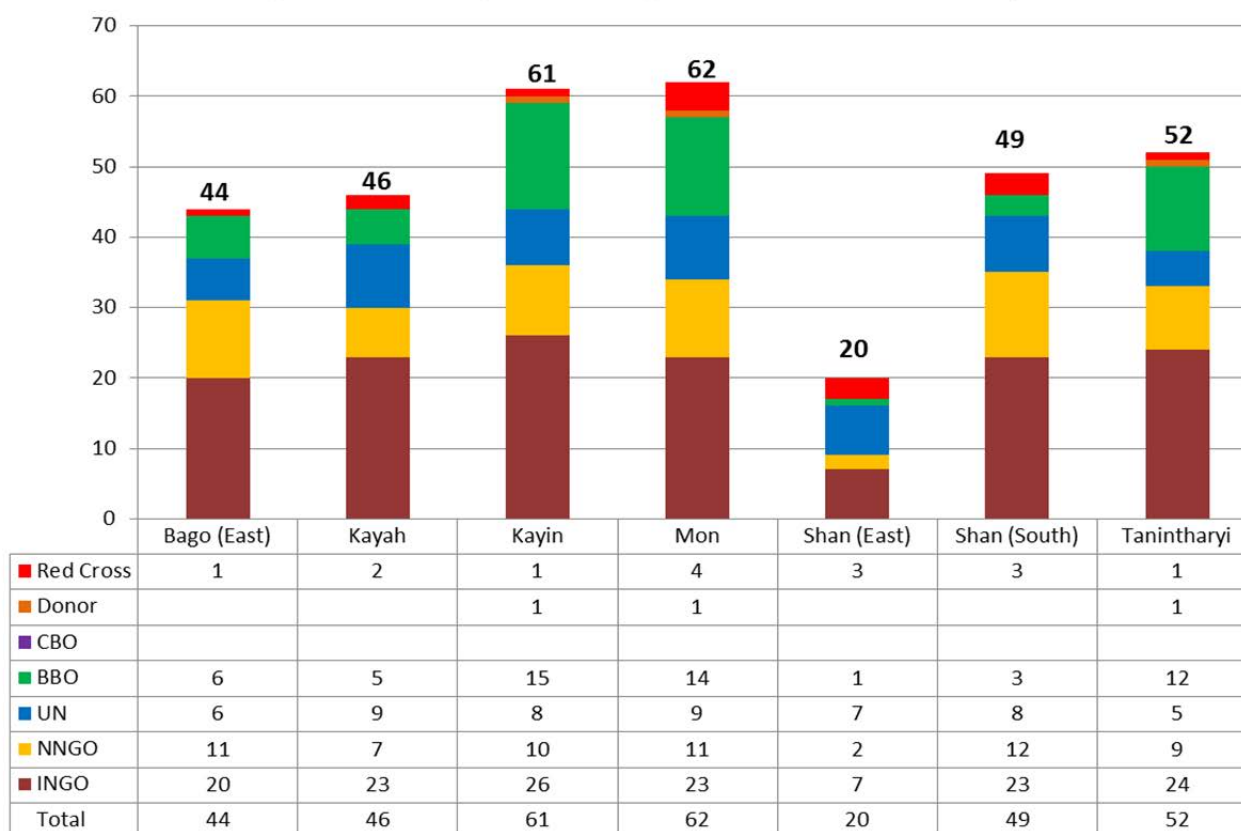

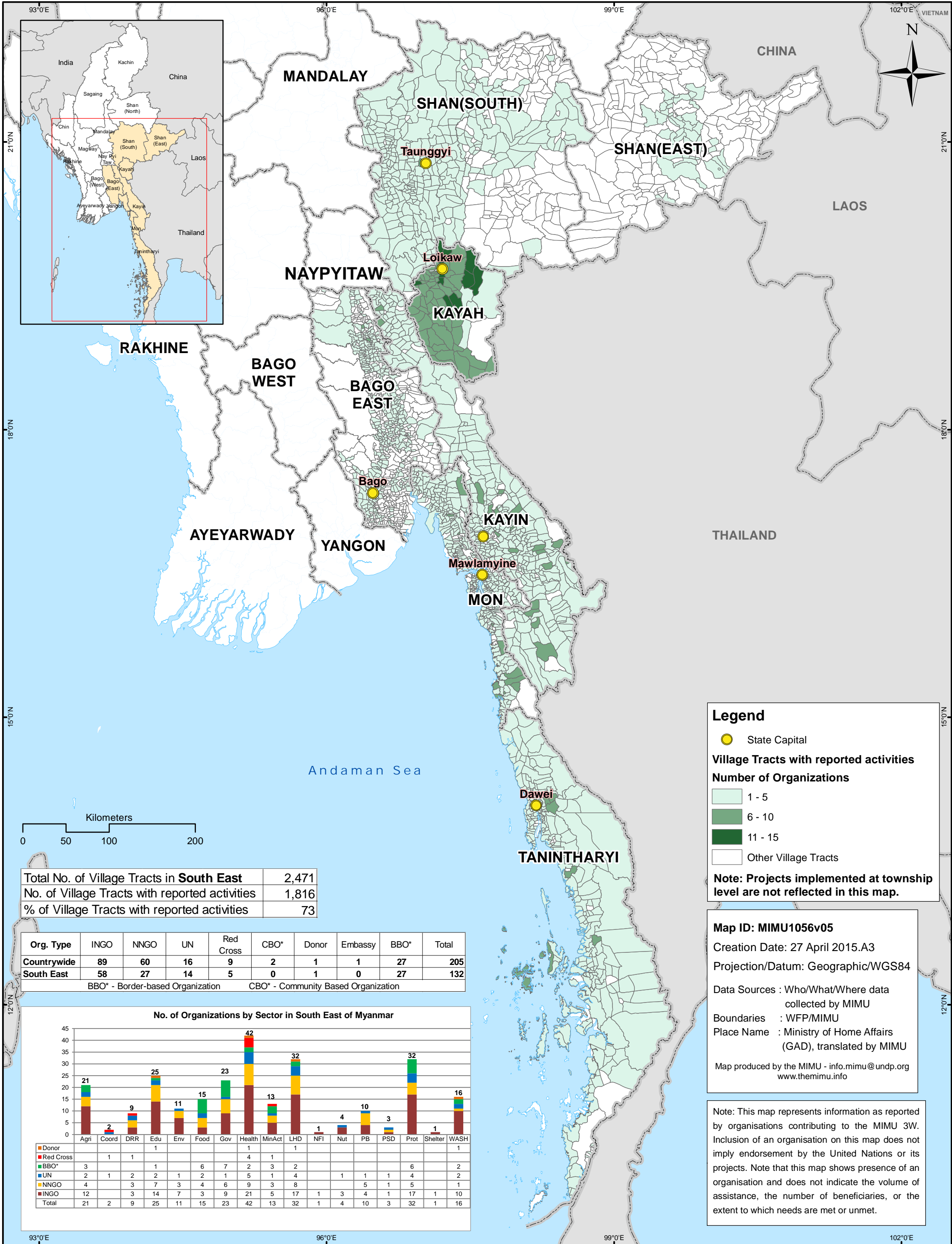
