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HIV Harm Reduction



- Implementing partners → 8 Organizations (including NGOs, INGOs and UN organizations)
- Coverage → 41 townships
- Activities →
 1. Harm reduction implementation
 2. Technical Assistance
 3. Work to support legal and policy review and reform

Data counting → Output level



1. People reached by intervention services
 - a) Outreach service
 - b) DIC (Drop-in-centre) service
 - c) VCCT (Voluntary Confidential Counselling and Testing)
 - d) Sexually Transmitted Infection Testing and Treatment
 - e) Hepatitis B testing and Vaccination
 - f) Methadone
2. Commodity distribution through partners
 - a) Needles and Syringes
 - b) Condoms

TUBERCULOSIS



A. TB Active Case Finding (TB-ACF)

- Partners → 3MDG is financing TB-ACF activities through public-private (not-for-profit) partnerships between the National TB Programme of the MoH and seven implementing partners (NGO, INGO, National Programme)
- Coverage → Targeting screening of high-risk populations across States and Regions through mobile teams modality
- Data Counting → Output level: Case referred, Case examined, All forms of TB, Bacteriologically confirmed TB among
 - a) ACF in hard to reach areas
 - b) Peri-urban areas
 - c) PPM (Public-Public Mix) hospitals
 - d) MCH (Maternal and Child Health) clinics & Diabetes clinics

Tuberculosis



B. Multi-drug resistant tuberculosis (MDR-TB)

- Partners → NTP and 4 other implementing partners
- Coverage → 57 townships in Yangon and Mandalay
- Data Counting → Output level:
 - a) Patient enrolment in treatment
 - b) Patient support for transportation and socioeconomic support
 - c) Community volunteer trained to provide DOT (Direct Observed Treatment)
 - d) Patients received DOT service by trained DOT provider at community level

3MDG-funded Operational Research & Studies



1. Situational assessments in mines (completed)
2. Measuring the effectiveness of current strategies on mobile teams - case contribution, cost analysis.
3. Effect of Mobile team strategy in active case finding
 - a) Mobile team focusing on internal migrants
 - b) Mobile team for mines
 - c) Mobile team for prisons
 - d) Mobile team in remote underserved areas
4. Cost effectiveness of mobile team strategy for TB ACF
5. Situational analysis of TB screening at diabetic clinics
6. Exploratory study on TB ACF in antenatal care services
7. Operational research on hospital screening

Malaria



- 6 Implementing Partners (through 2015), 4 Implementing Partners (through 2016)
- Coverage → 45 townships
- Data collection from organizations;
 1. Diagnosis and Treatment
 - RDT Rapid Diagnostic Testing
 - Treated confirmed case: confirmed P.f Plasmodium *falciparum* and P.v Plasmodium *vivax* malaria cases
 2. Prevention
 - LLIN (Long Lasting Insecticide Treated Nets) distributed to 1) migrant mobile pop 2) general pop
 - Bed-net treated/re-treated
 - Other protection measure 1) repellent distribution 2) indoor residual spraying
 3. Training and support to community volunteers

1. MARC (Myanmar Artemisinin Resistance Containment) baseline survey (2012)
2. Malaria indicator survey (2015-2016) – co-funded by 3MDG
3. Community Household Survey (2013-2014)
4. Facility Based Survey (2013-2014)
5. Stratification Survey (2013-2014)

3MDG-funded Operational Research & Studies (completed)



1. Entomological Study (vector bionomics) and insecticide susceptibility in 3 new areas
2. Studies of Day 3 parasitaemia
3. Mapping of private sector activities
4. Behavioral study of population at risk in Tier 1 and 2 areas
5. Economic-epidemiological modelling to support the containment of artemisinin resistance in the MARC regions of Myanmar

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
