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Overview of 3MDG MNCH Townships (1)

- The 3MDG MNCH program roll-out began in 2013 with full coverage reached in early 2015

- As of February 2016, there are 8 Implementing Partners in 34 townships supporting public sector service delivery in collaboration with Township Health Departments:
 - Ayeyarwady 6 townships (IOM, MdM, Relief International, Save the Children)
 - Chin 9 townships (Danish Red Cross, IRC, StC)
 - Magway 5 townships (MSI, StC)
 - Kayah 7 townships (IOM, IRC)
 - Shan 7 townships (Cesvi, Relief International, StC)

Overview of 3MDG MNCH Townships (2)



- In addition, there are private sector grants focusing on family planning services and FP commodities implemented by:
 - MSI 15 townships in Ayeyarwady, Chin, Magway (2014 to 2016)
 - PSI 34 townships in Ayeyarwady, Chin, Magway, Kayah, Shan (2014 to 2016)
- There are also **Special Region programs** in Wa and SR4 regions for MNCH, HIV Harm Reduction, tuberculosis and malaria activities implemented in collaboration with Non-State Actors (Ethnic Health Organisations) by:
 - HPA 9 townships in Wa and SR4 area (2015 to 2017)

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
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
