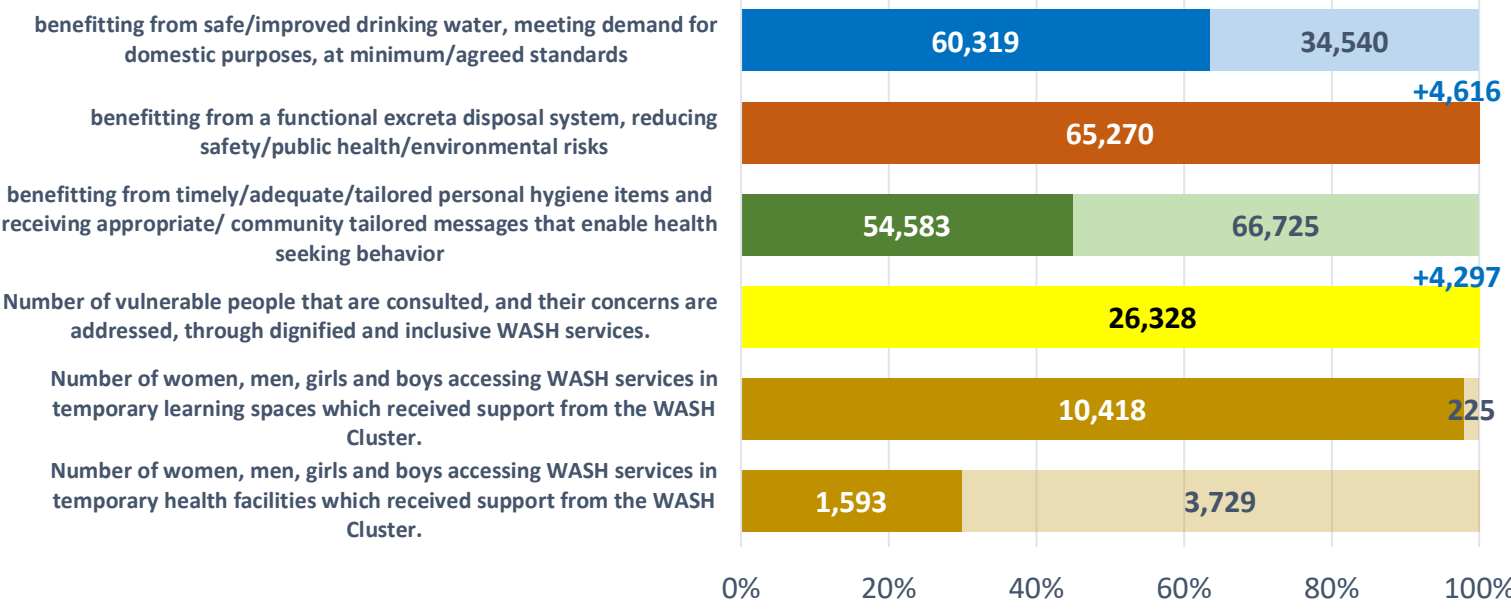


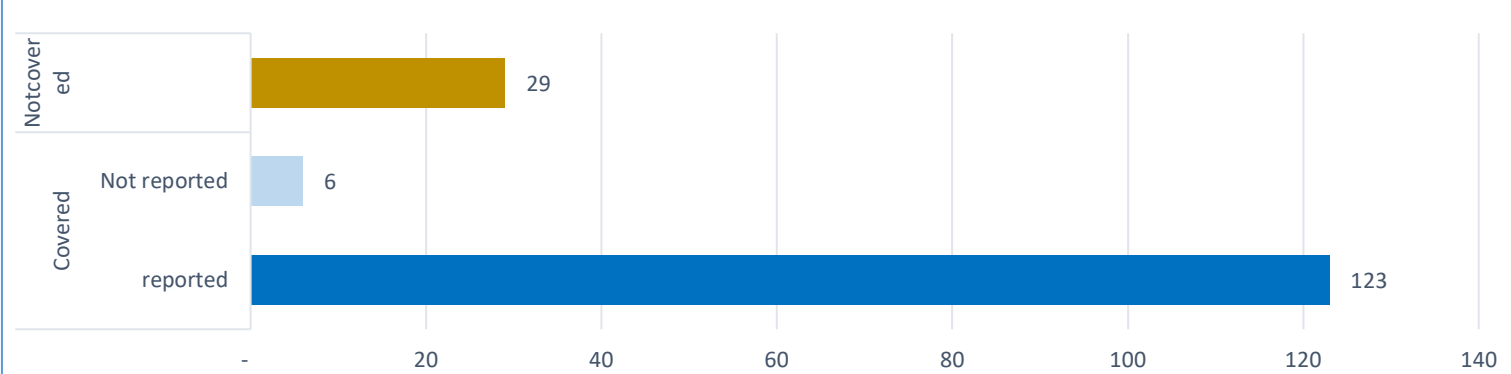
Number of ppl Covered against 2023 HRP targets



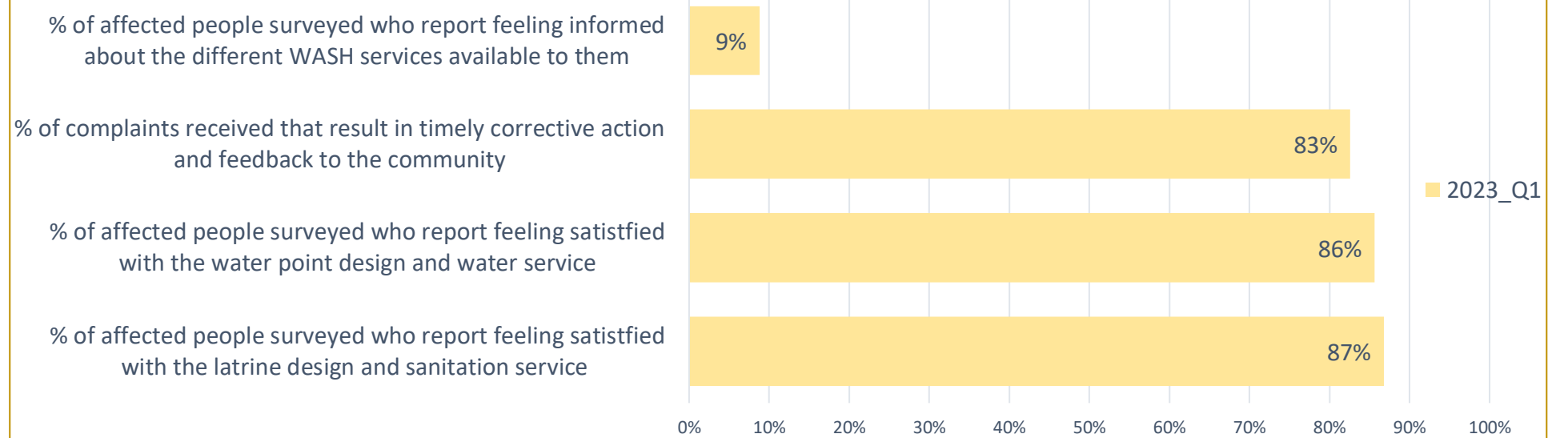

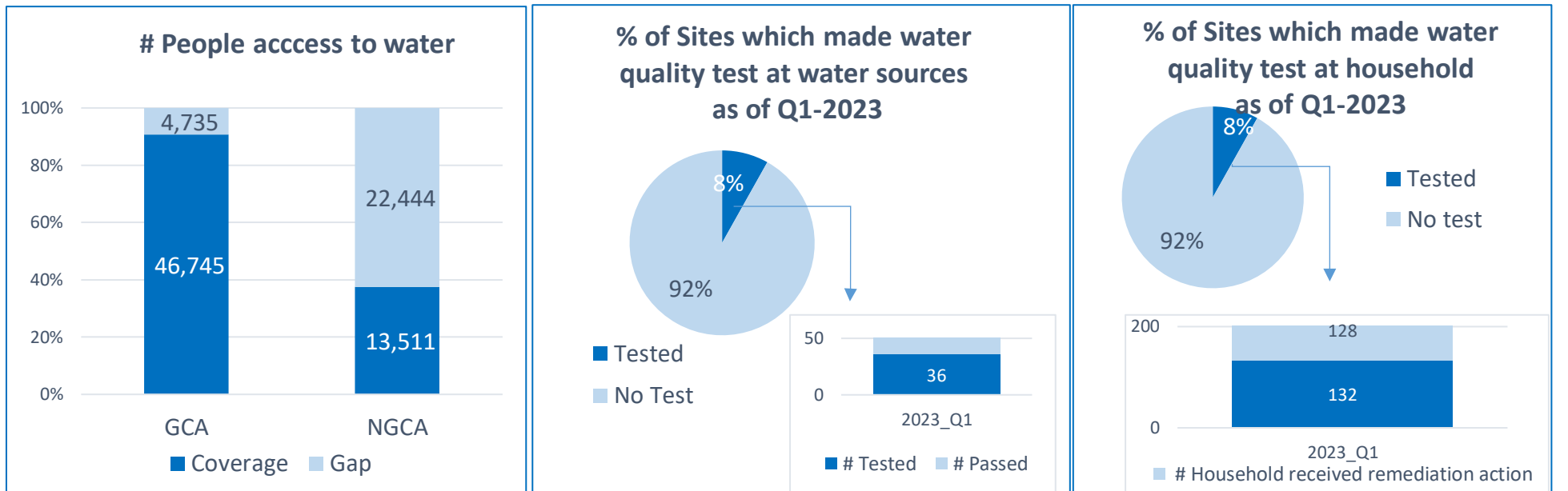

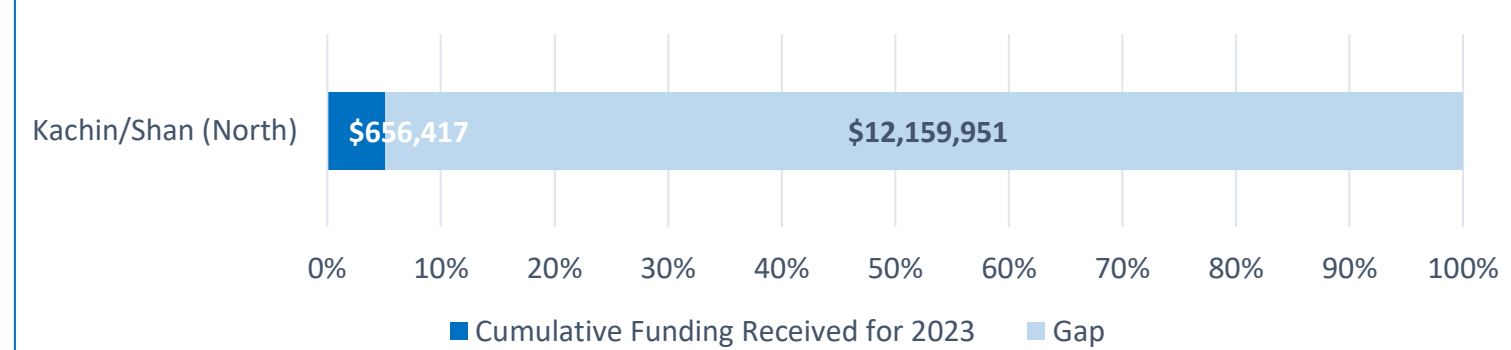

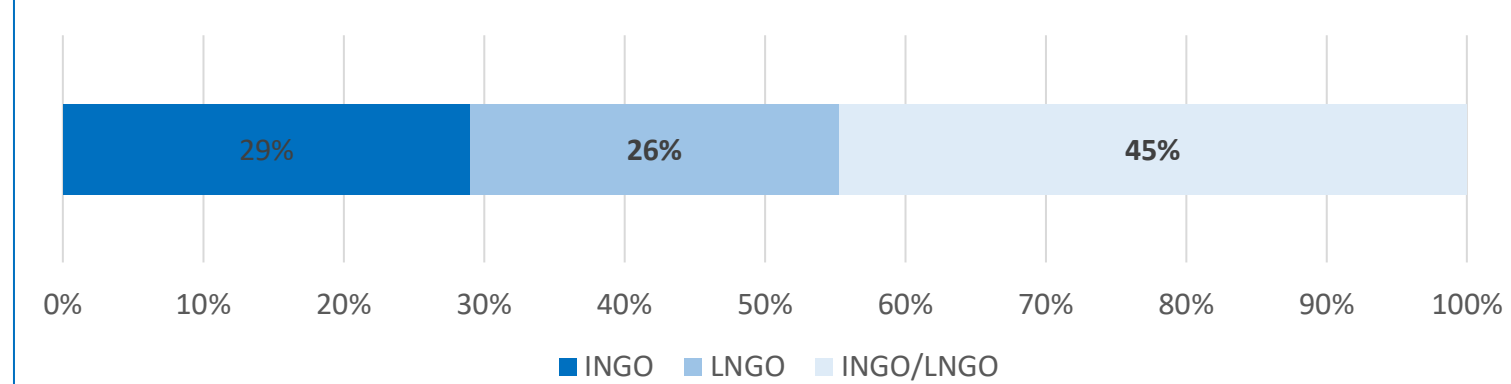
Water Quantity & Water Quality in protracted camps



Cumulative Funding Received/Gap as of 2023-Q1 (US\$)

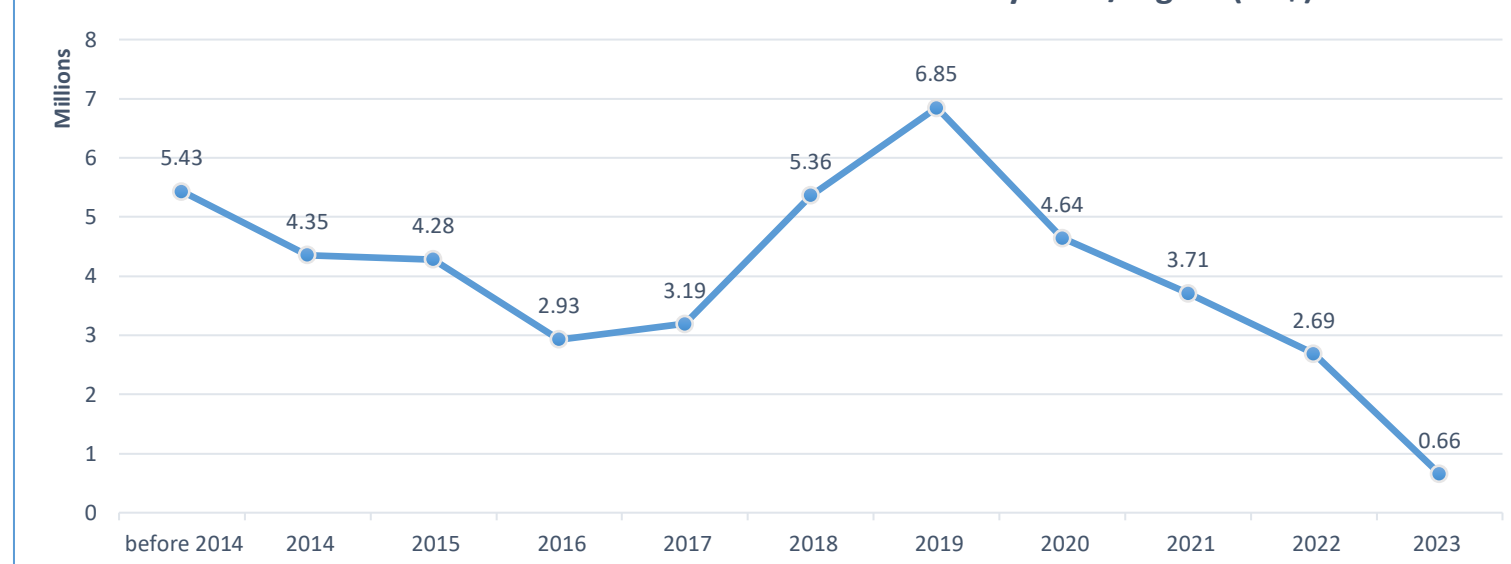

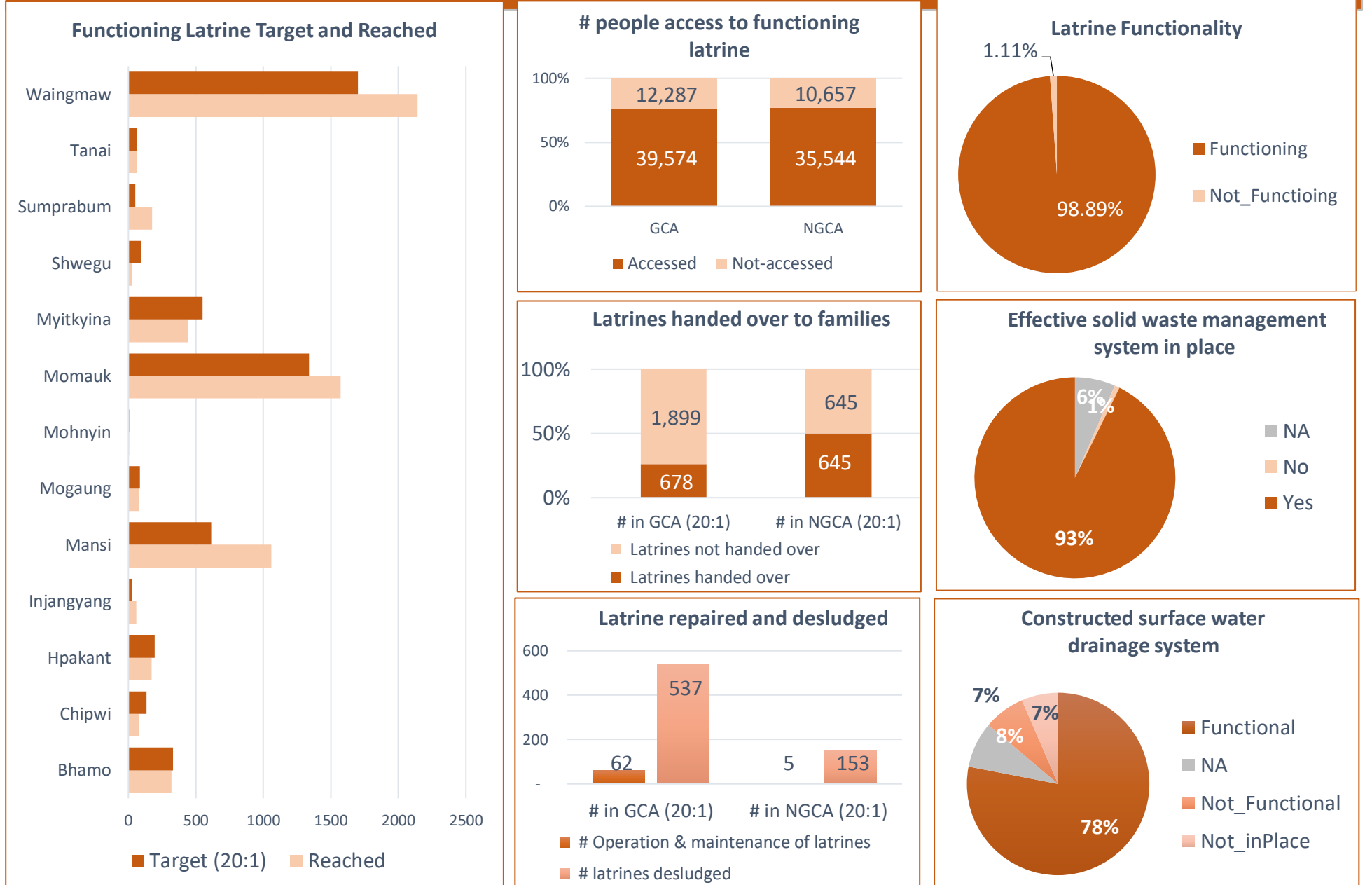

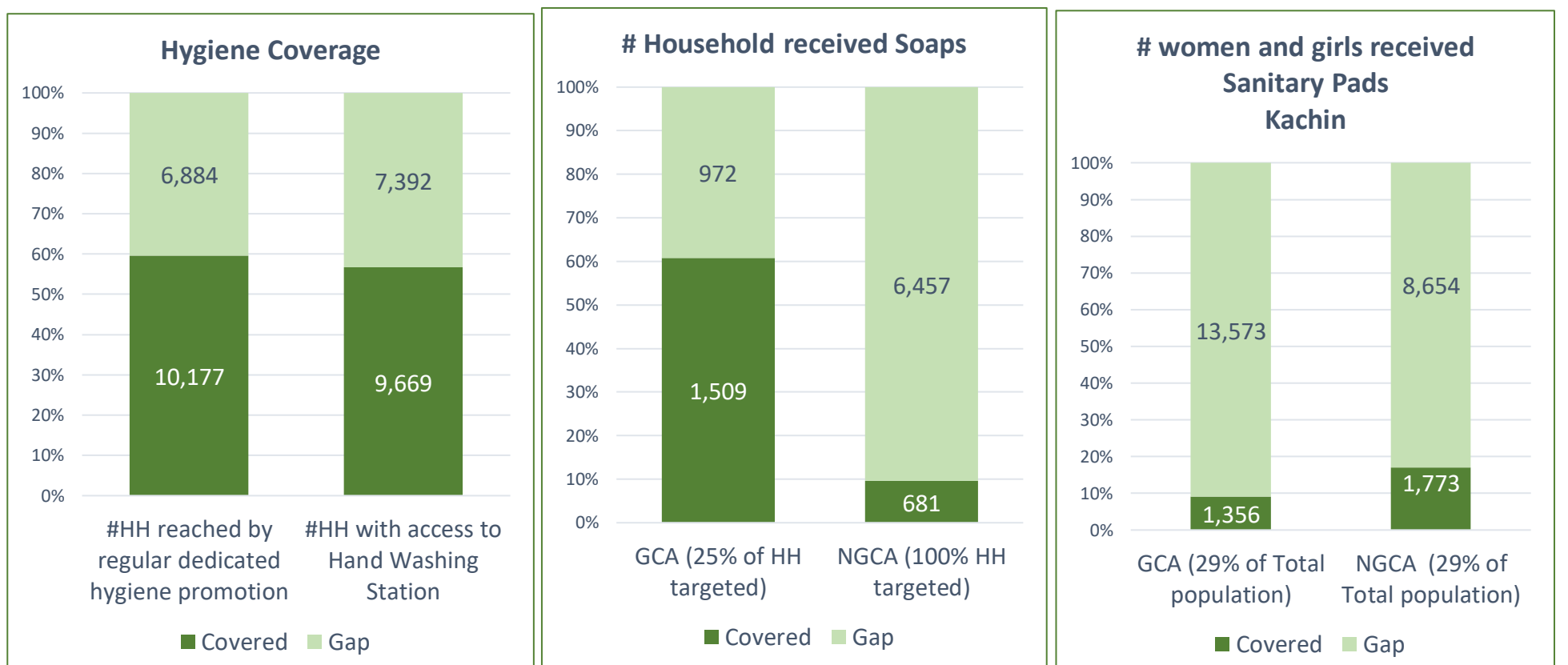
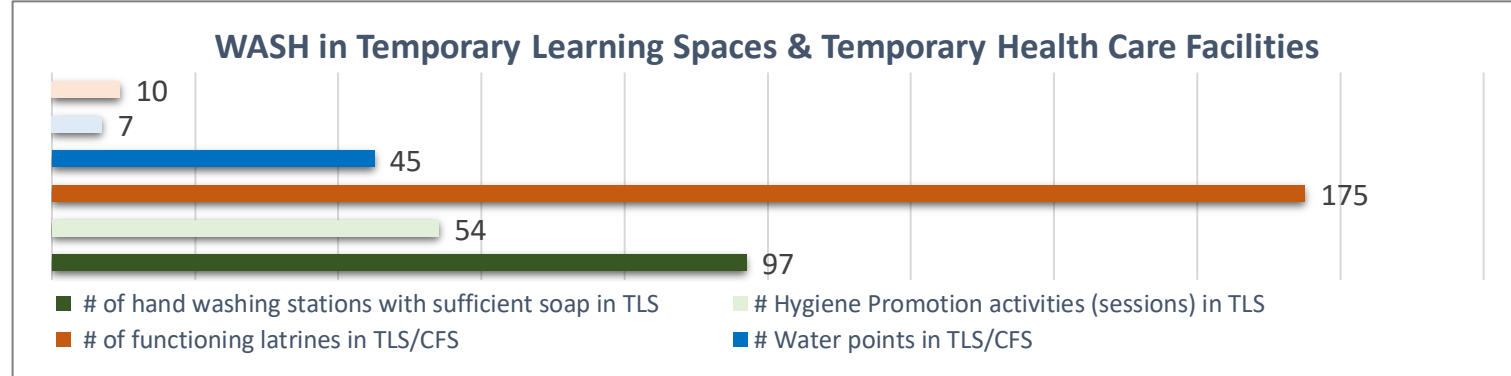
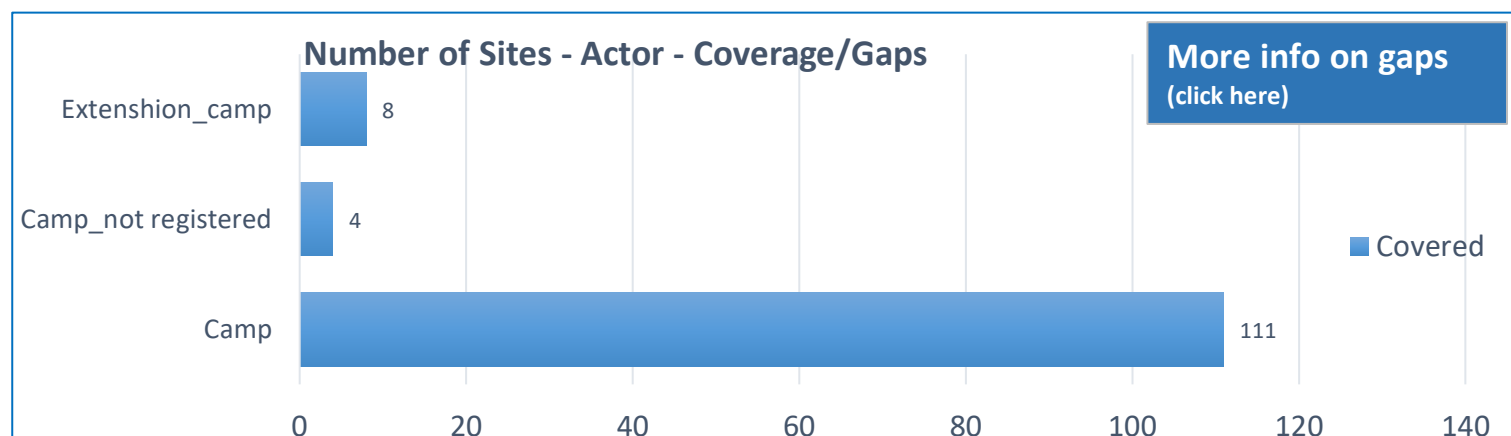
APPROXIMATE TOTAL FUND ENGAGED PER YEAR by state/region (US\$)



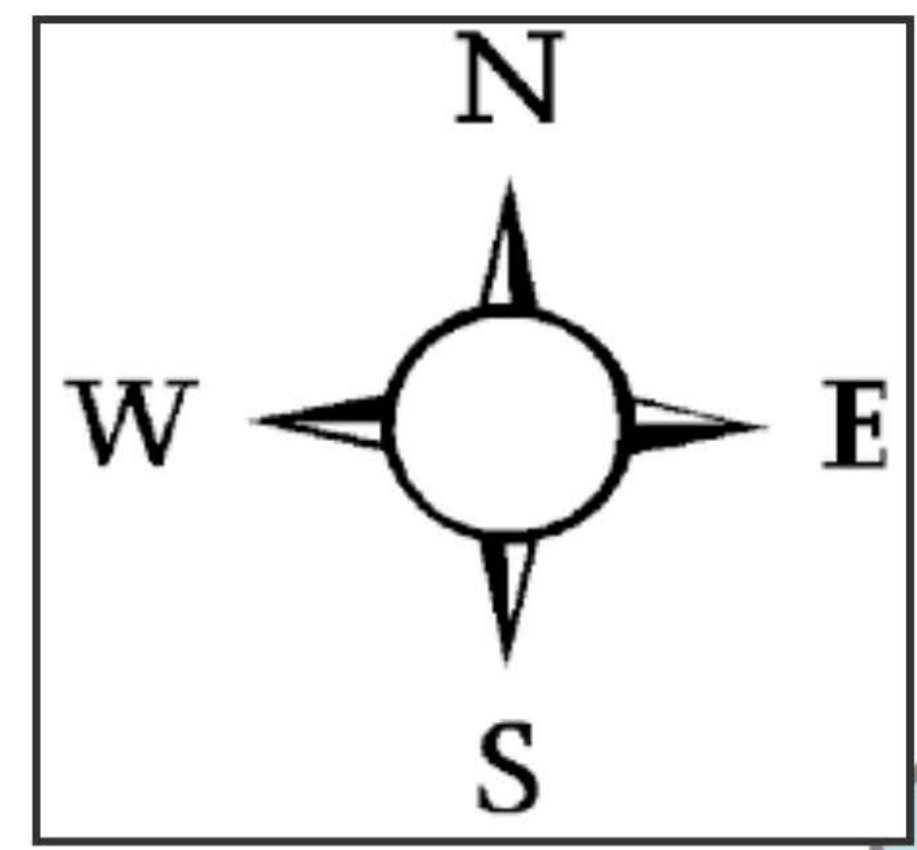

