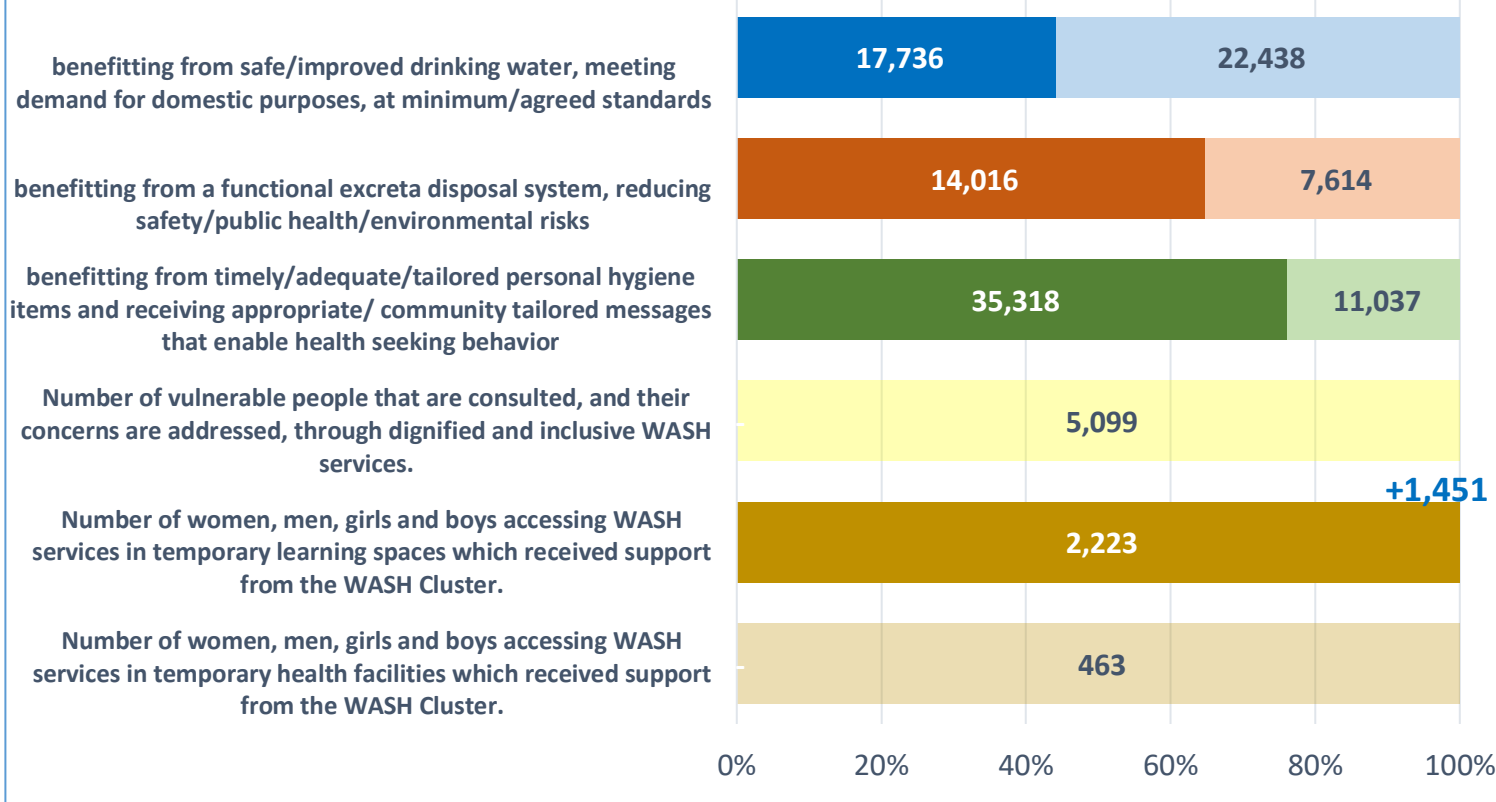


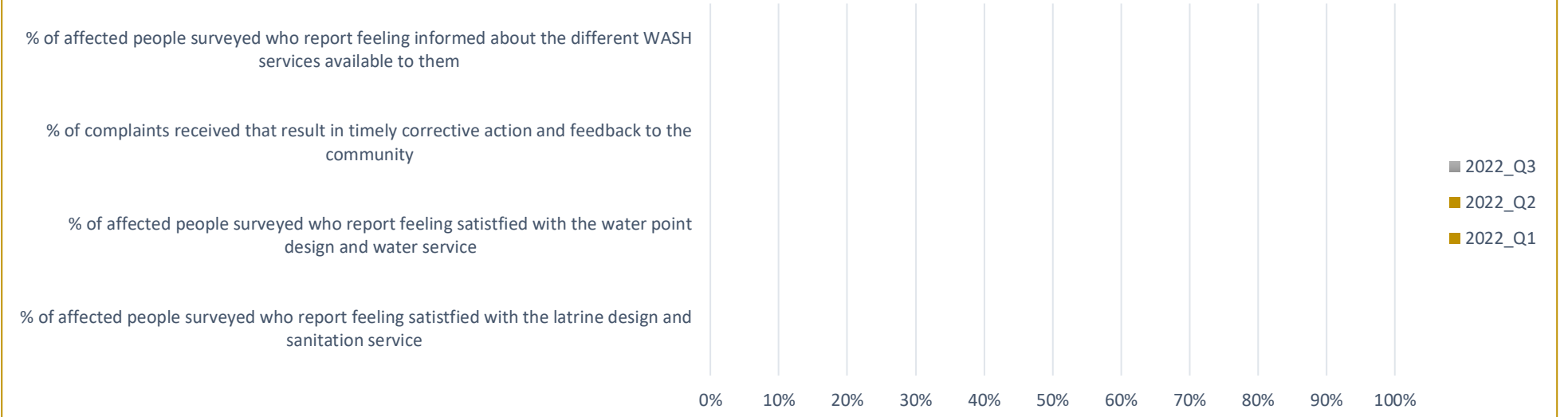
Number of ppl Covered against 2022 HRP targets

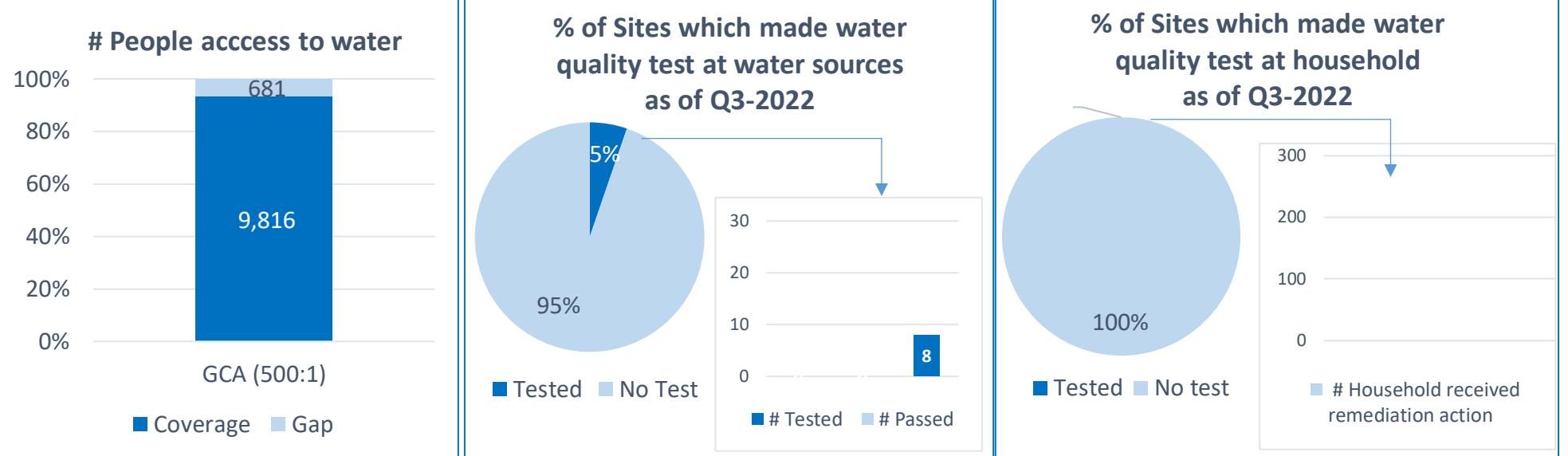

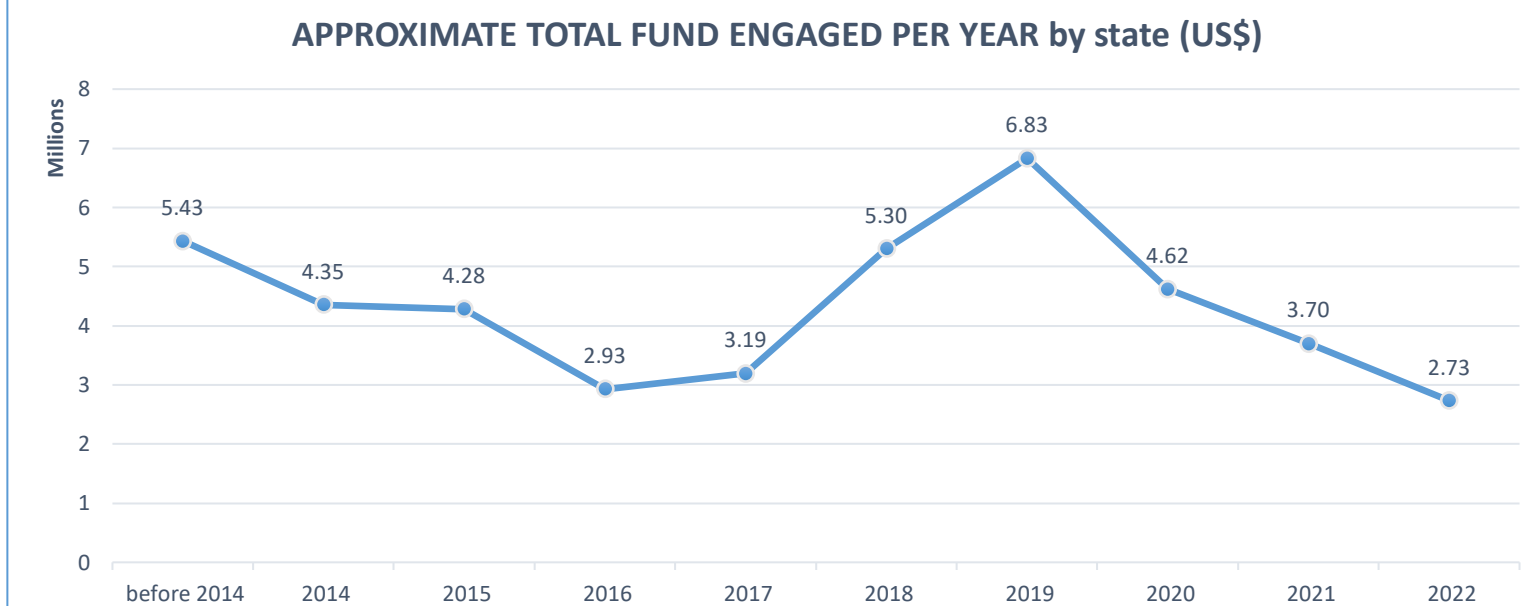
