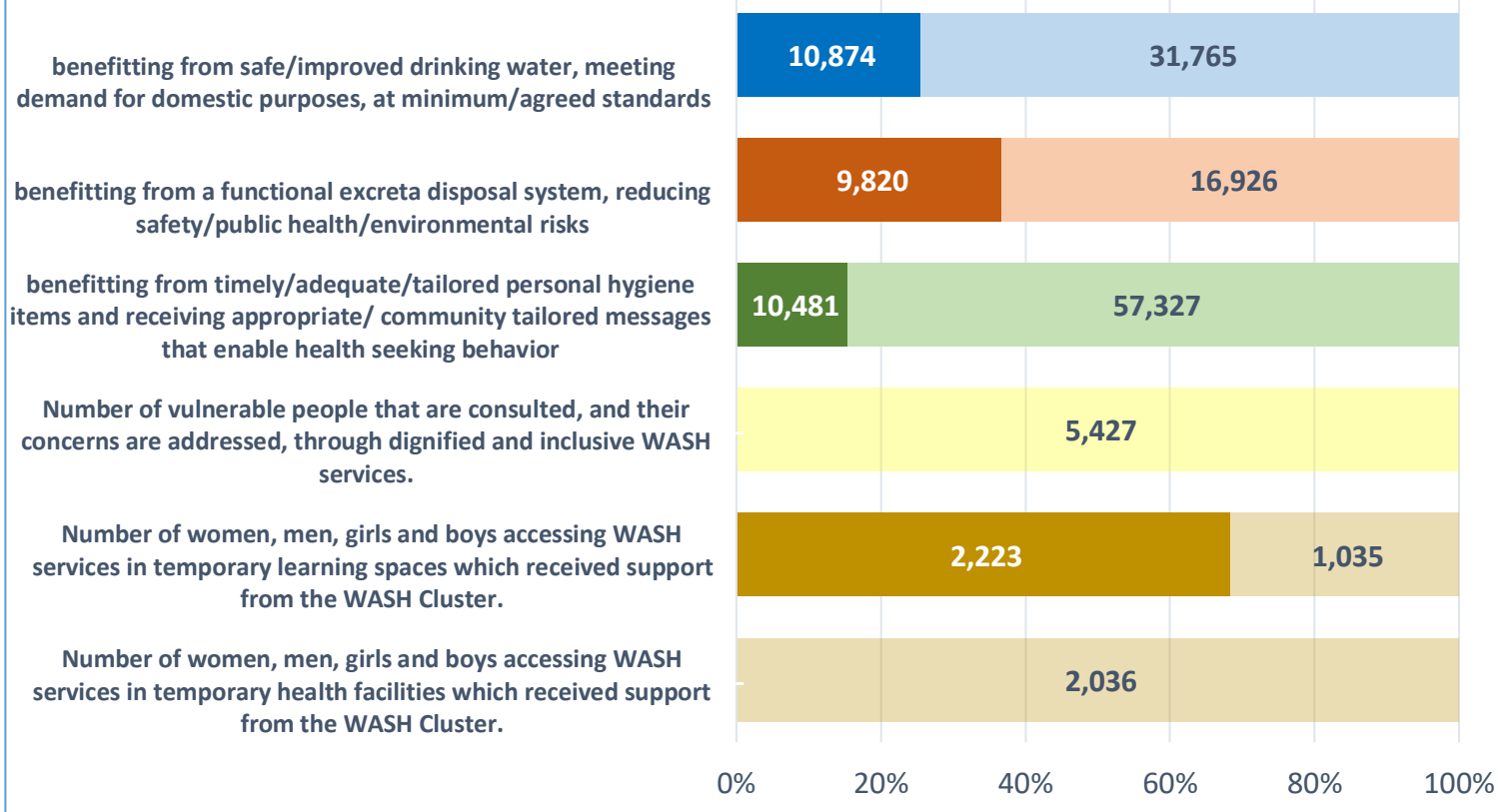

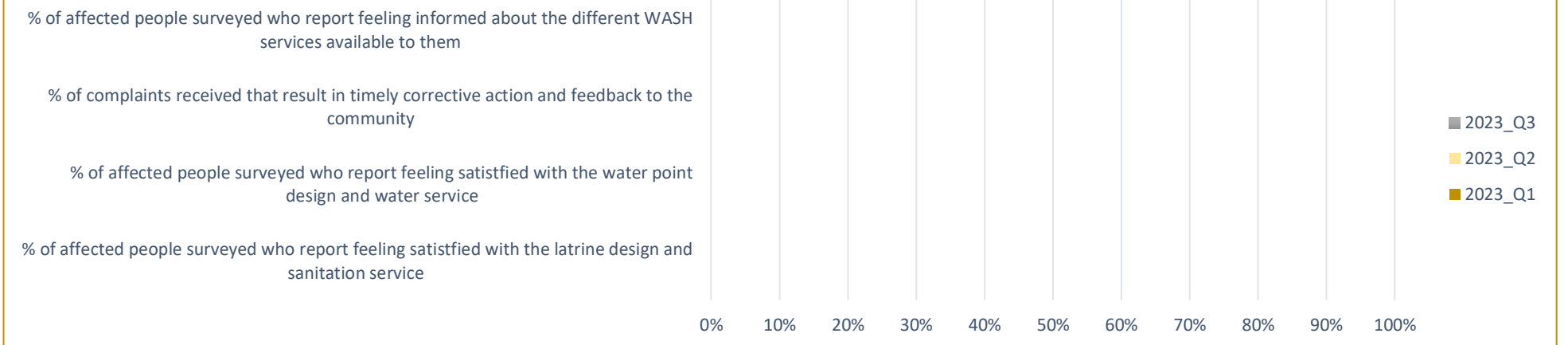

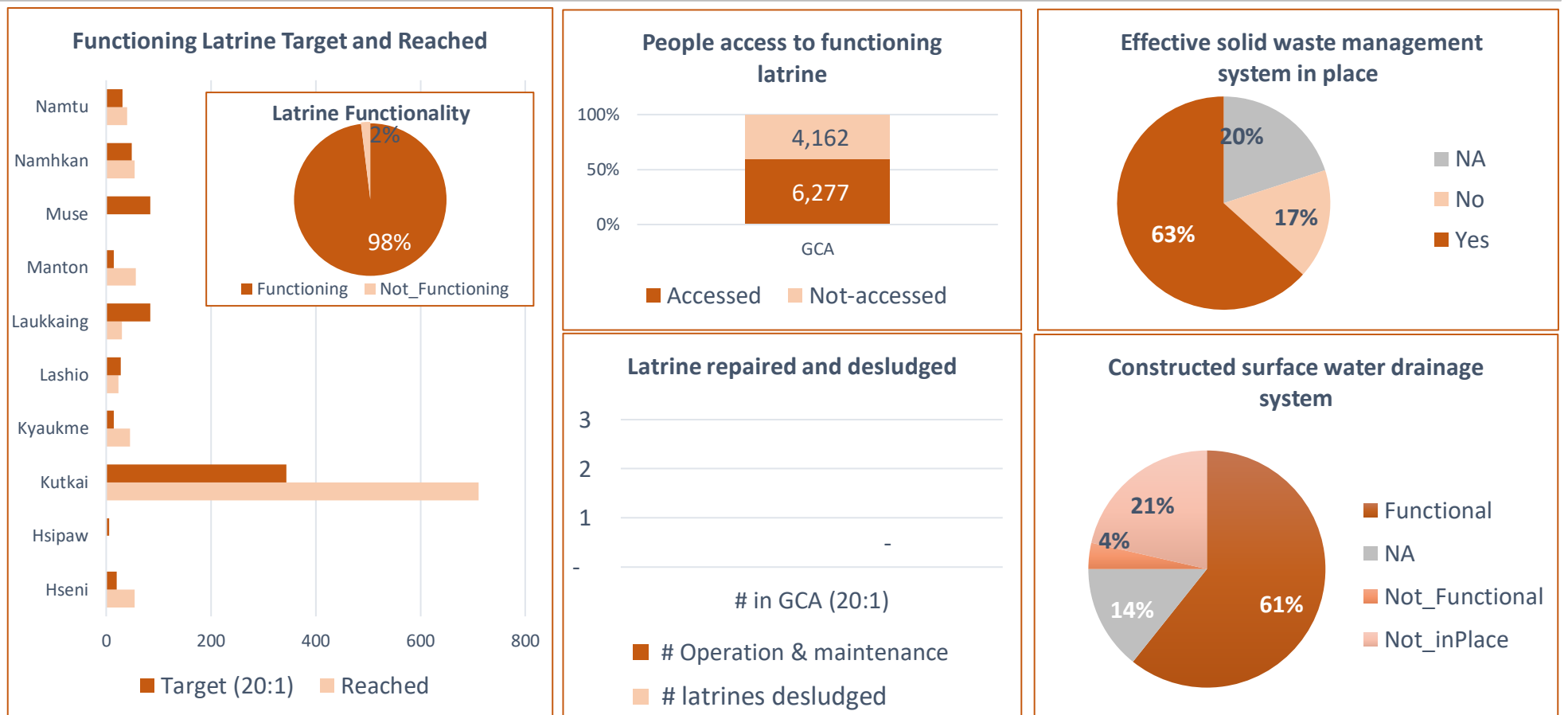
Water Quantity & Water Quality in protracted camps



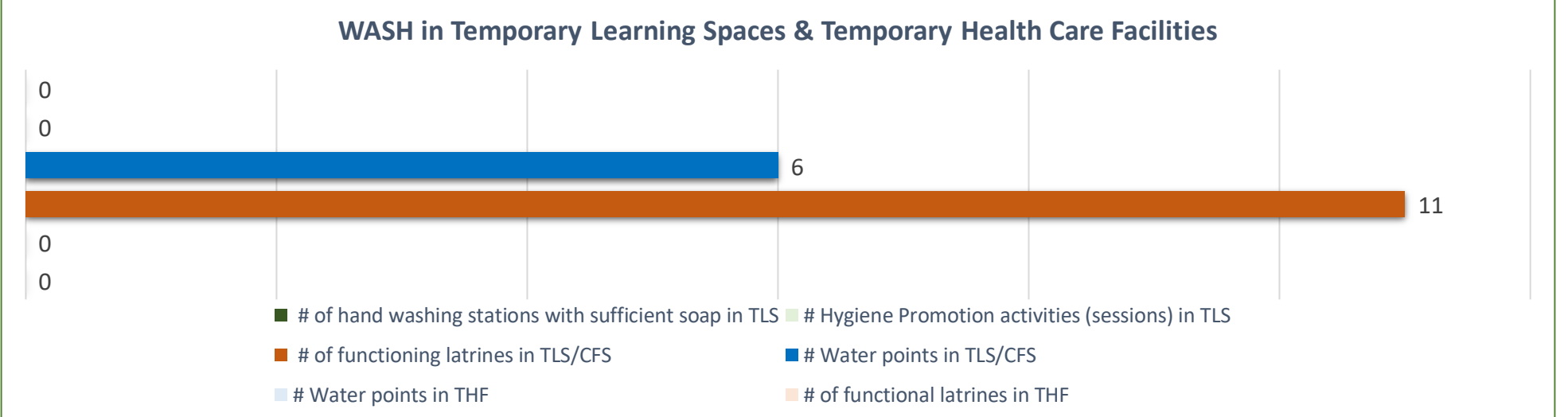
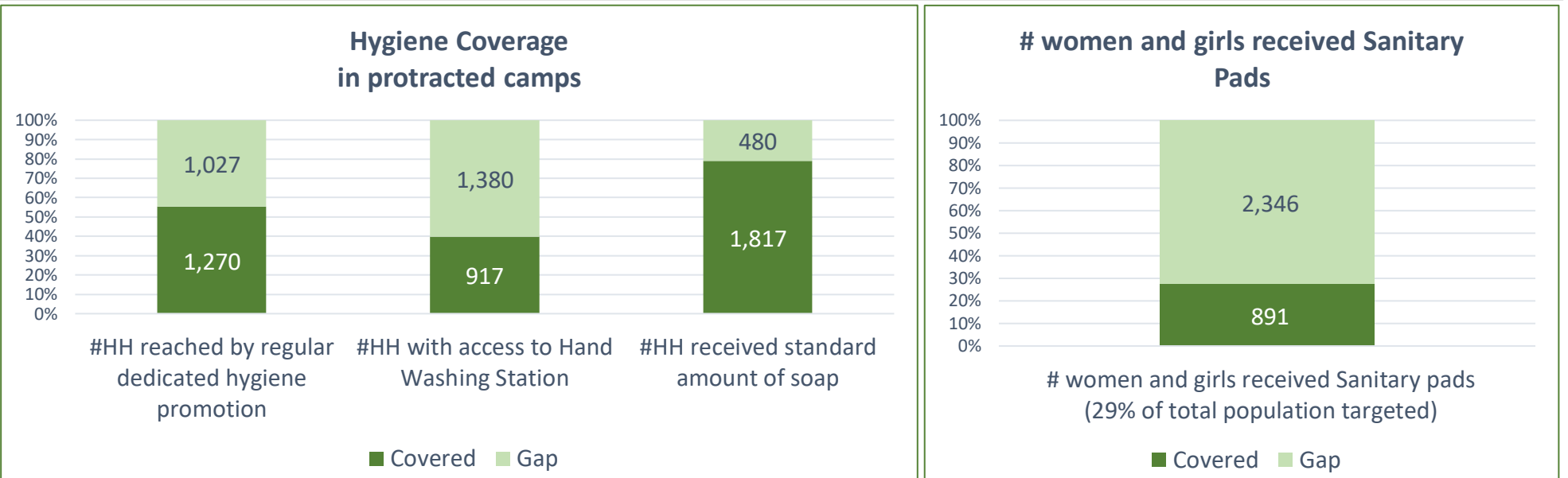
