



#### RAKHINE STATE - IDP sites (2022 - Qtr 1 - 4W Analysis, as of 31 March 2022)














## **Under WASH cluster partner management:**

- 2. 7,400 students have access to functioning school latrines
- 3. 600 people have access to functioning latrines in temporary health care facilities
