- Under WASH cluster partner management:**
1. 210 students have access to functional water points in temporary learning spaces and child friendly spaces
 2. 5,300 students have access to functioning school latrines
 3. 50 people have access to functioning latrines in temporary health care facilities
 4. 61,312 people have received regular hygiene promotion, regular hygiene promotion sessions are decreased to adopt social distancing and to avoid crowded people in the camps as part of covid-19 prevention but covid-19 hygiene awareness
