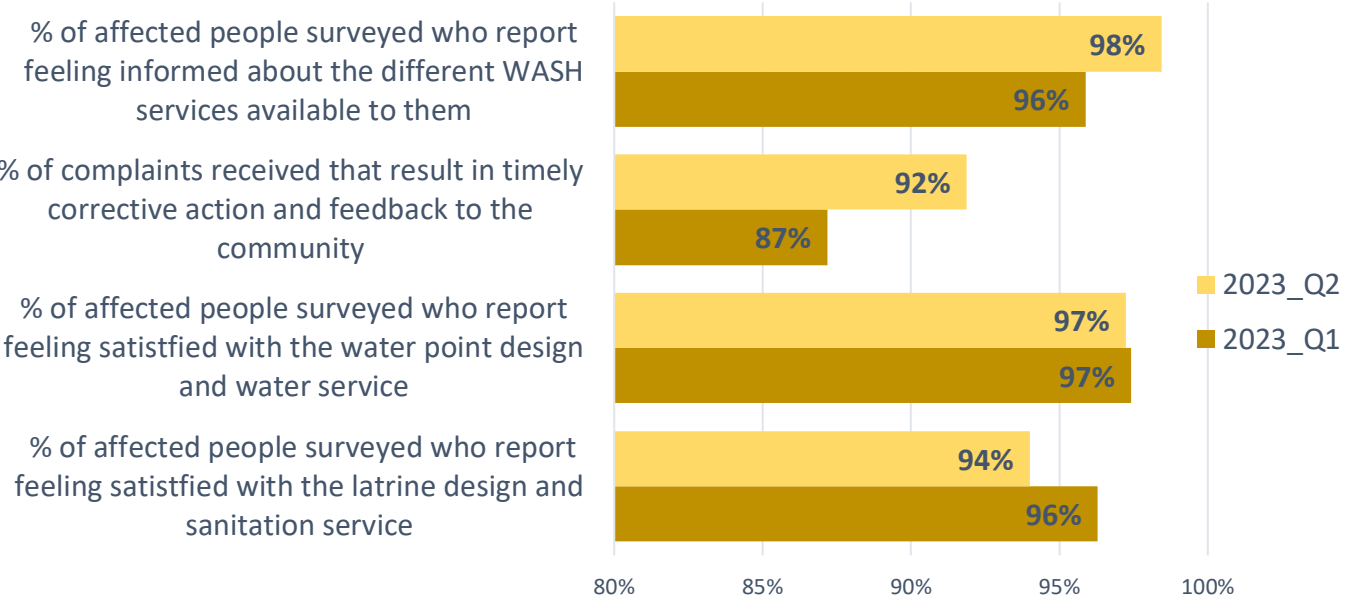

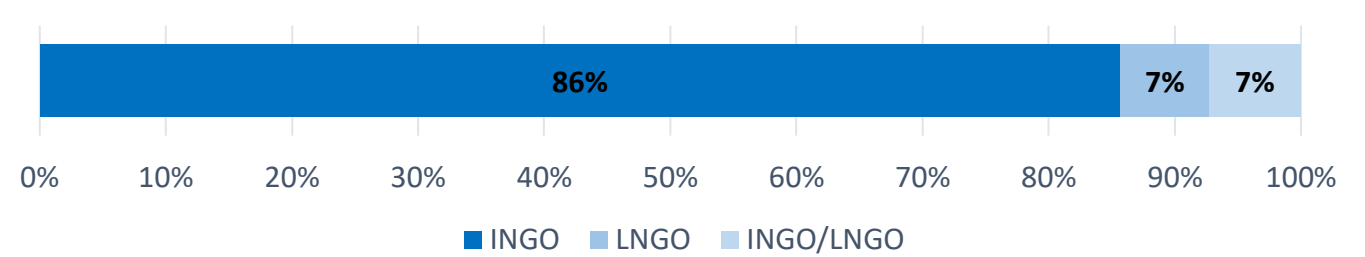

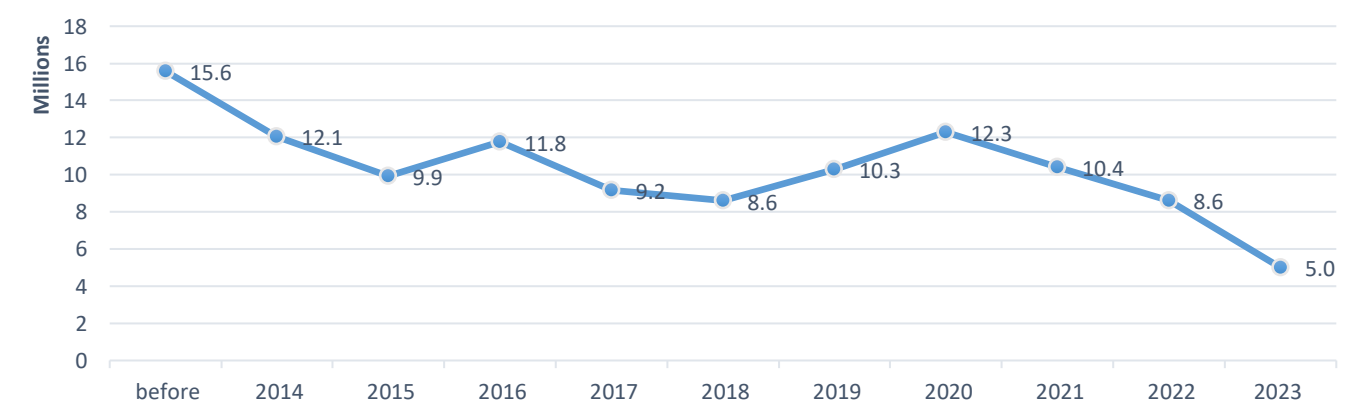
Cumulative Funding Received/Gap as of 2023-Q2(US\$)



Rakhine Funding Splits INGO, LNGO

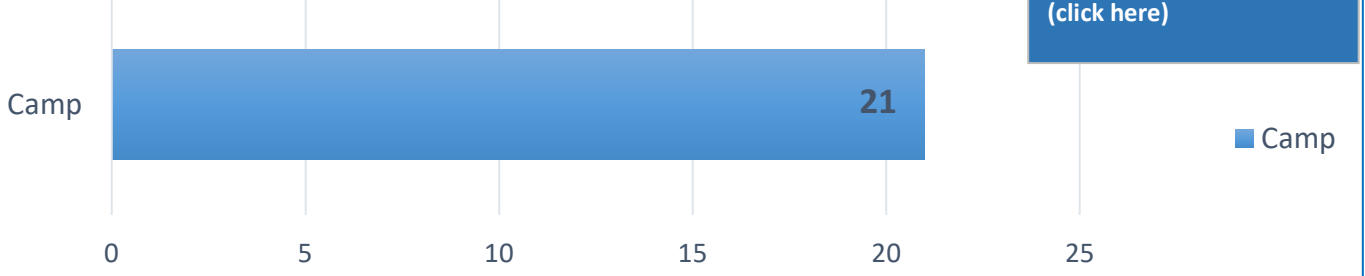


APPROXIMATE TOTAL FUND ENGAGED PER YEAR by state/region (US\$)

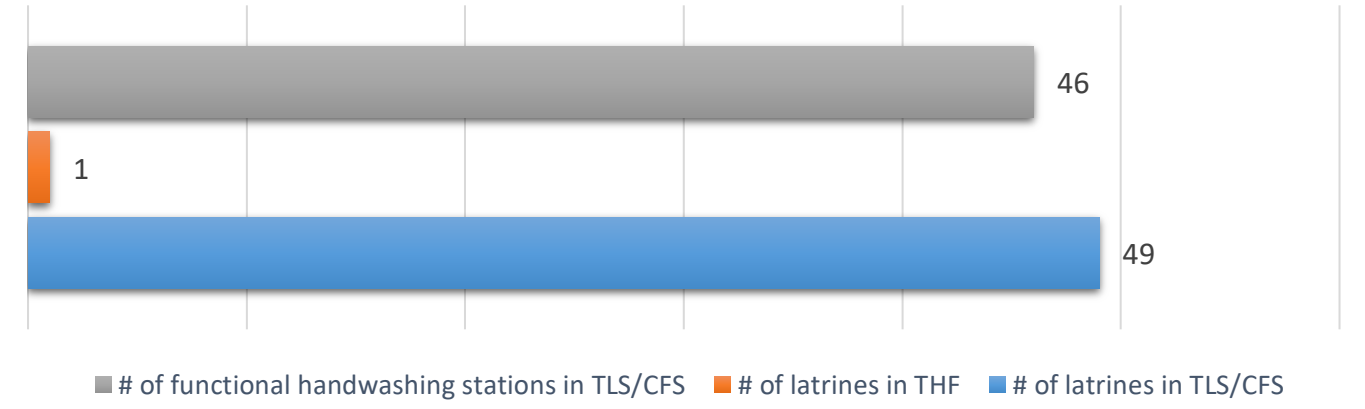

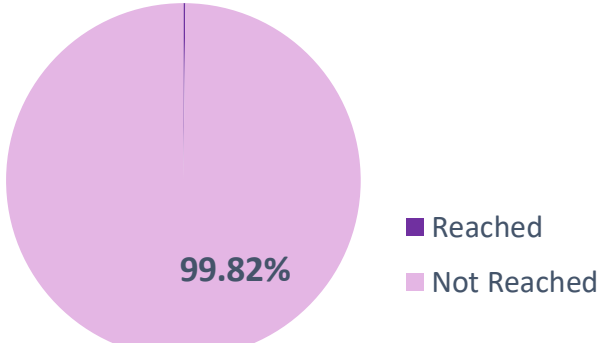

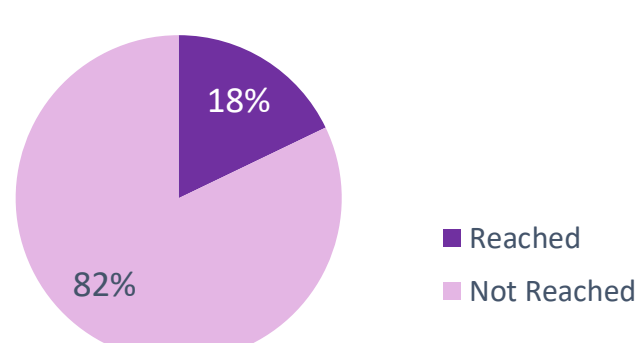
WASH in Temporary Learning Spaces

HRP6: Number of women, men, girls and boys accessing WASH services in temporary learning spaces which received support from the WASH Cluster.

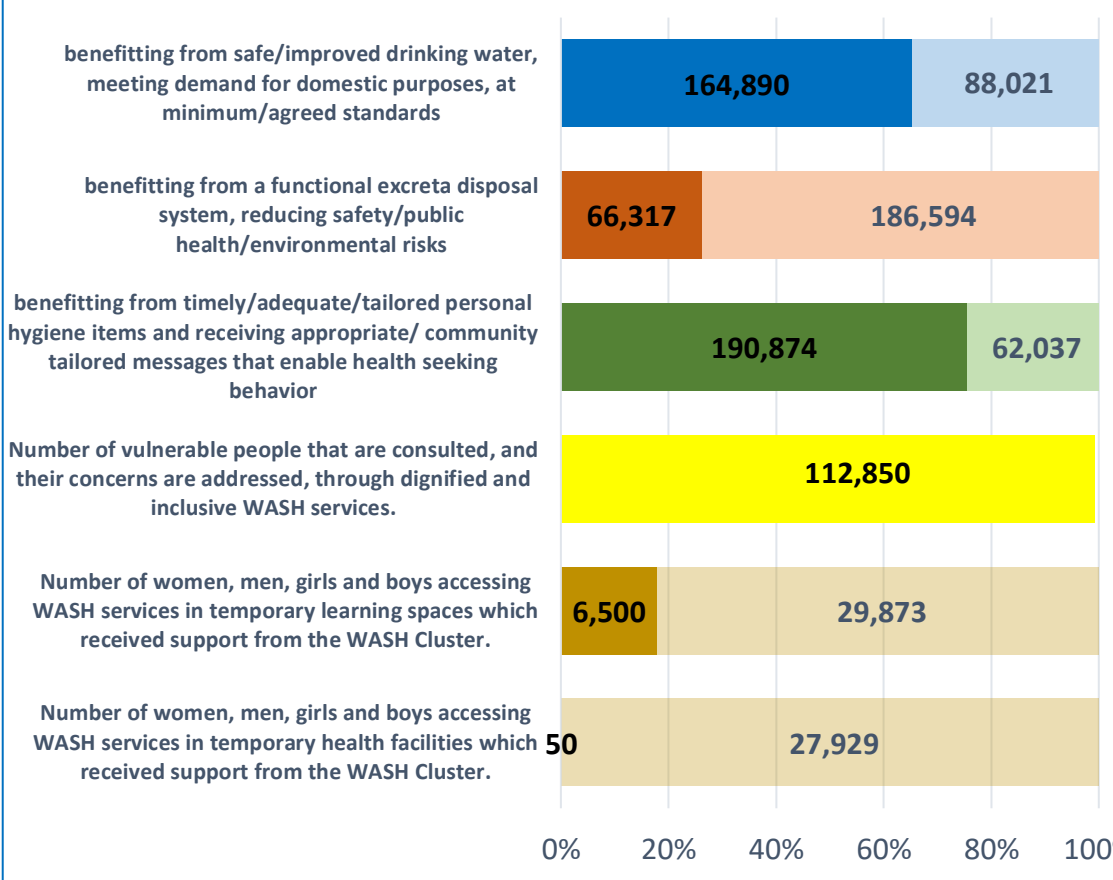


Under WASH cluster partner management:

- 210 students have access to functional water points in temporary learning spaces and child friendly spaces
- 2,450 students have access to functioning school latrines
- 50 people have access to functioning latrines in temporary health care facilities
- 33,456 people have received regular hygiene promotion, regular hygiene promotion sessions are decreased to adopt social distancing and to avoid crowded people in the camps as part of covid-19 prevention

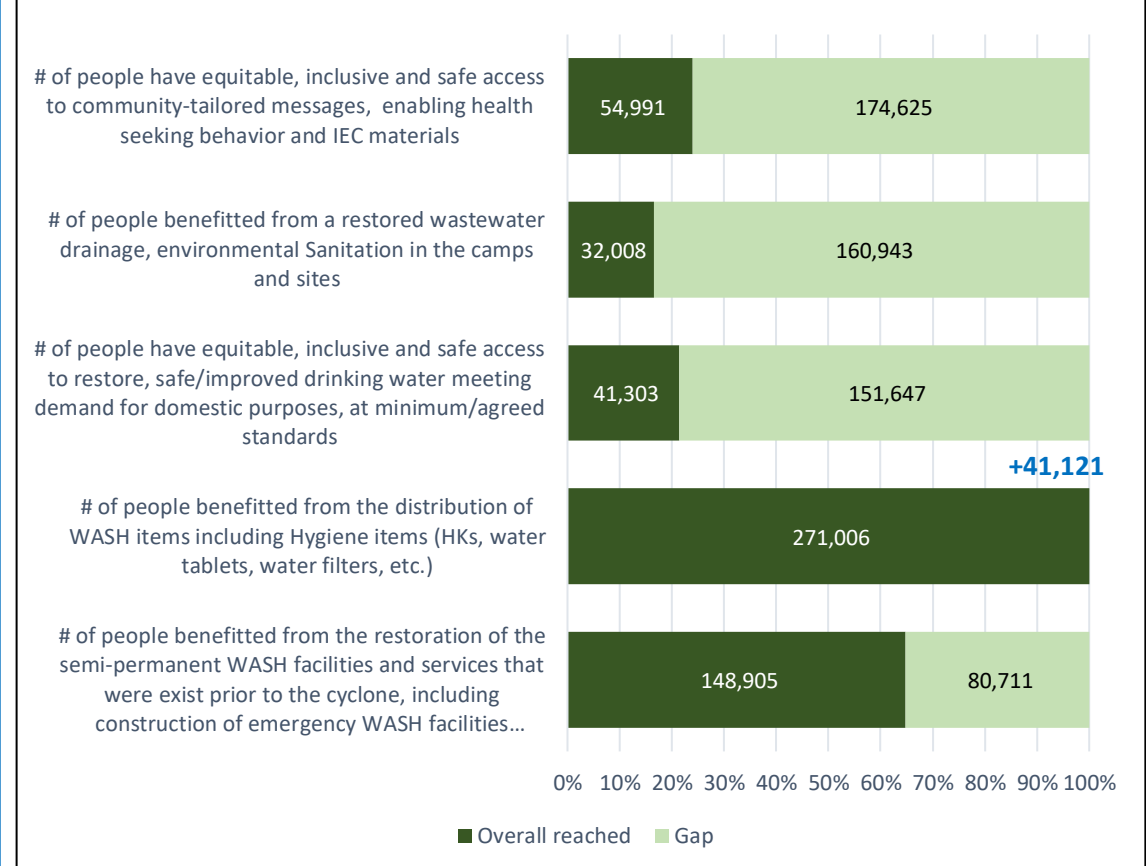

Number of ppl Covered against 2023 HRP targets Objective 1 :(IDPs- protracted+new displacement)

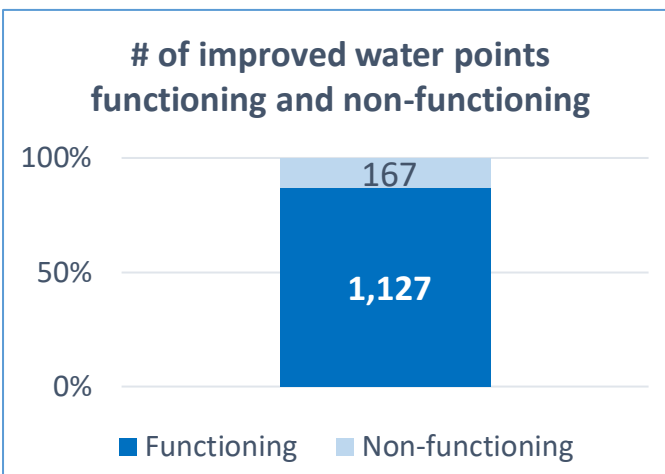

% of Sites which made water quality test at water sources as of Q2-2023

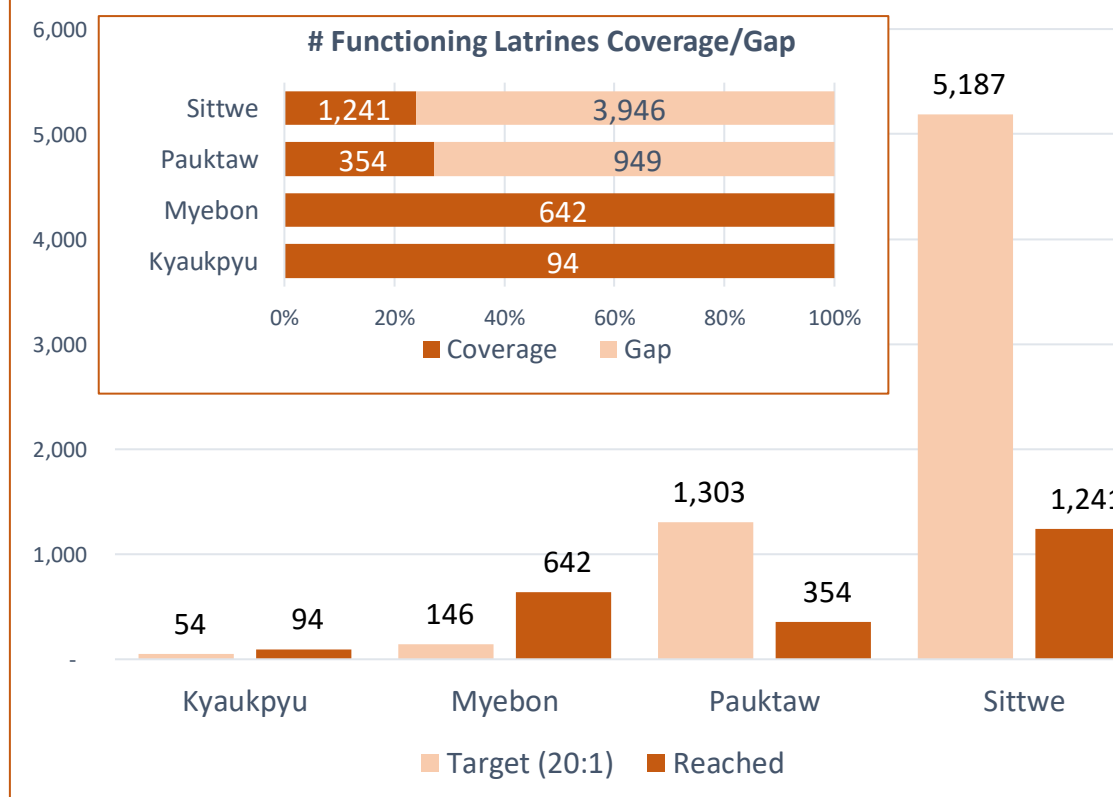


% of Sites which made water quality test at household as of Q2-2023

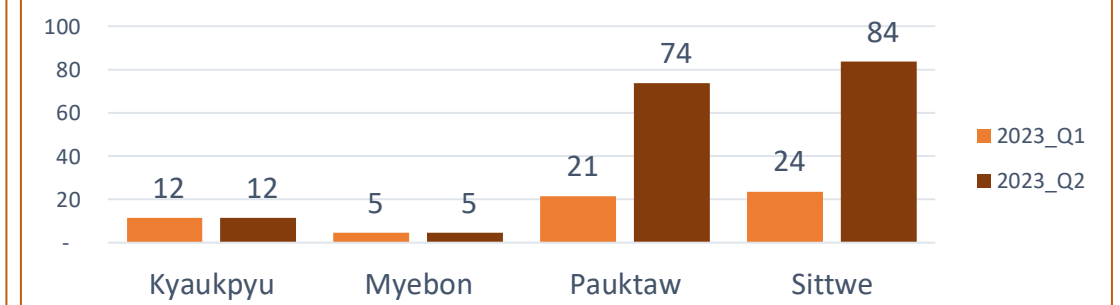

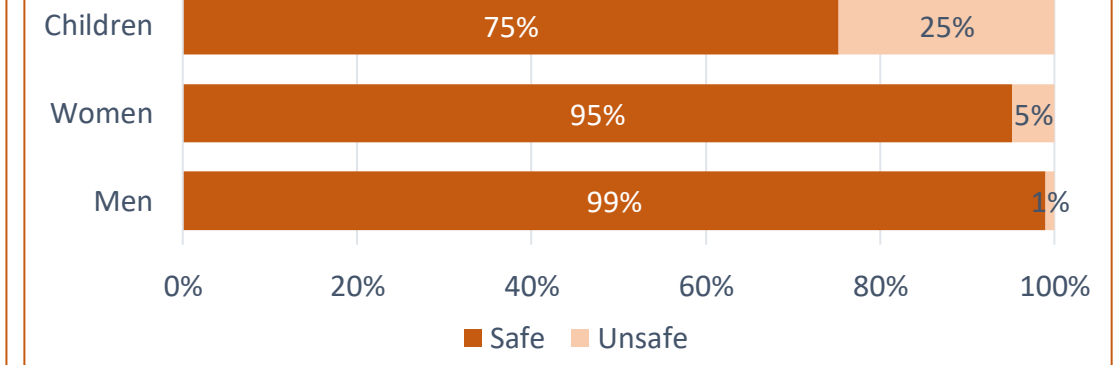
Latrine Target and Reached



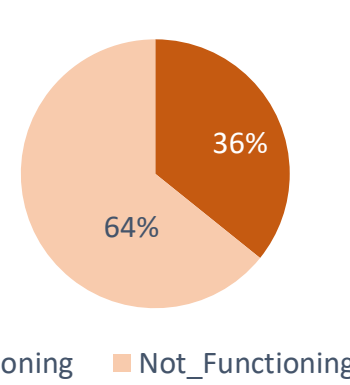
Average functioning adult latrine Usage (#PPL:1latrine)



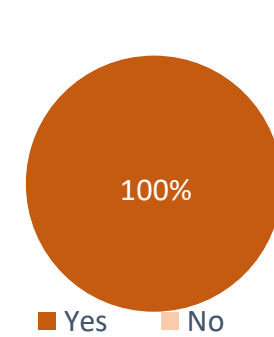
% of People feel safe to use latrines when they need to (or at day/night)



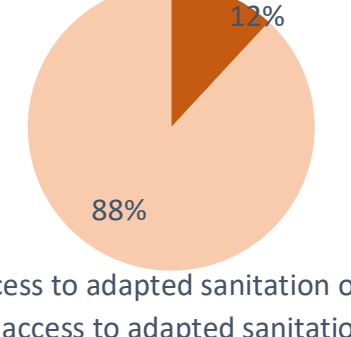

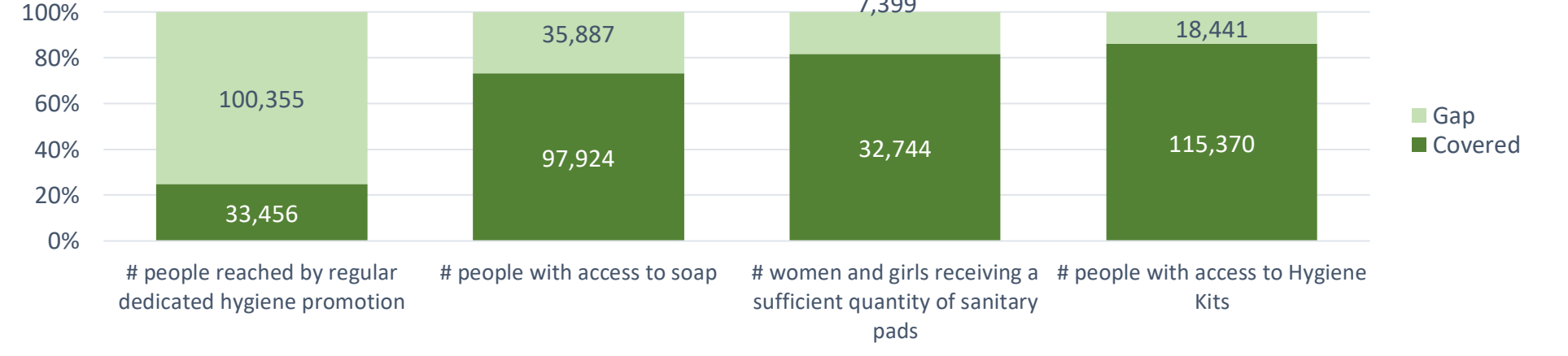

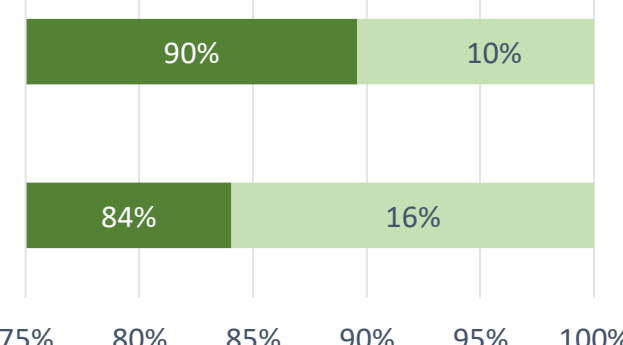

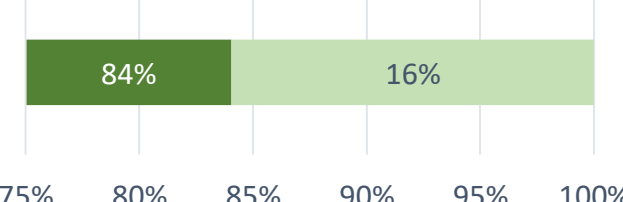

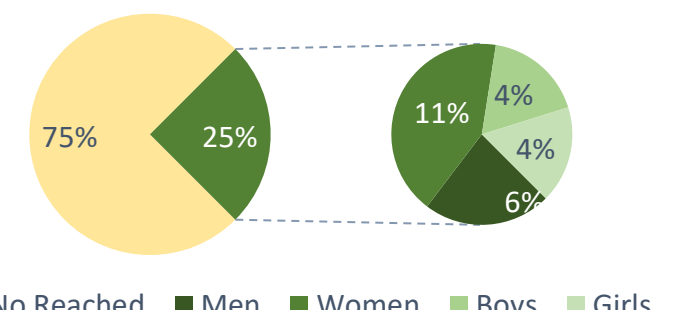
% of affected people who report handwashing at key times with soap



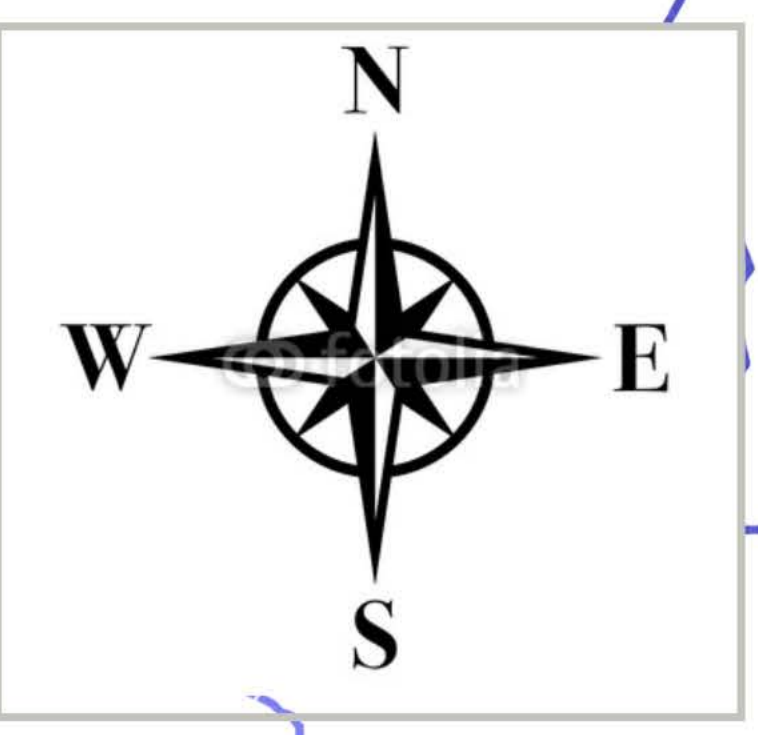
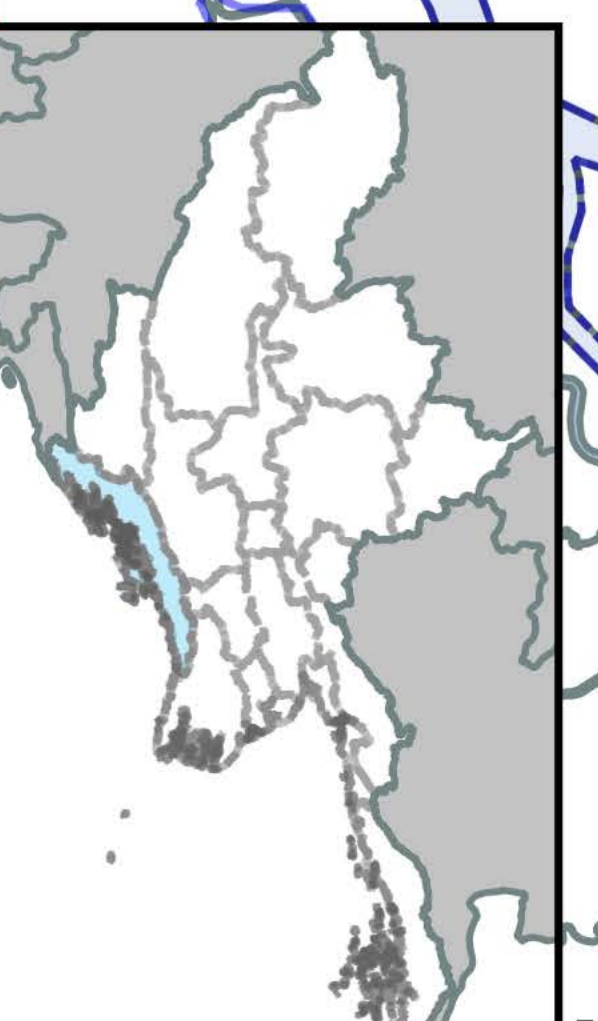

% of women and girls who report that they have an adequate system for disposing of used sanitary pads
