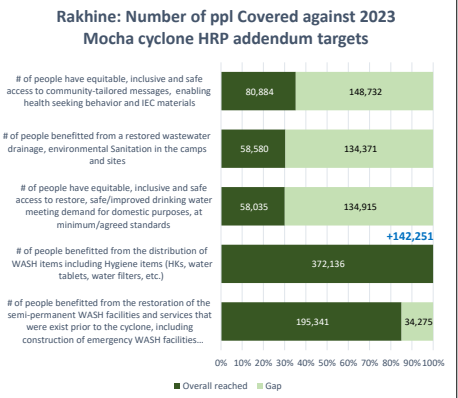


- Under WASH cluster partner management:

  - 42,596 people have received regular hygiene promotion

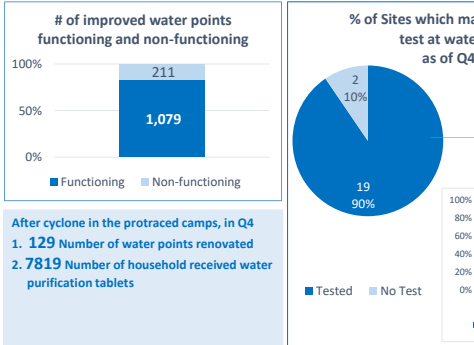
