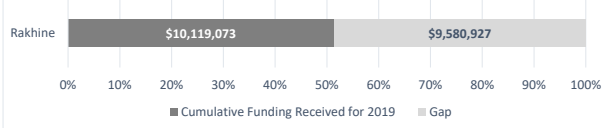

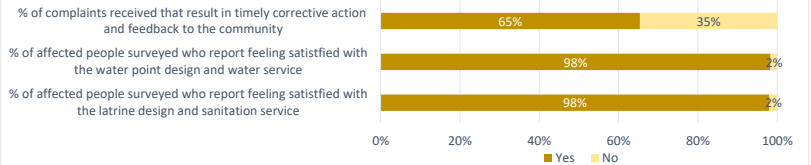

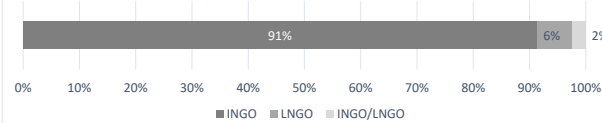
Funding Received/Gap as of 2019-Q3(US\$)



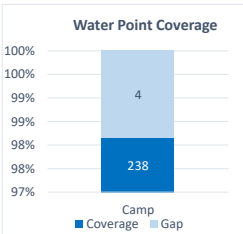

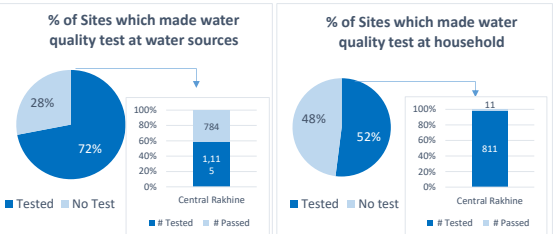

WATER Quantity

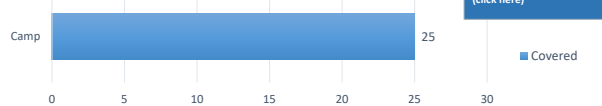

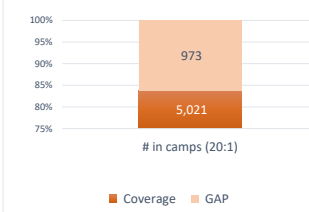

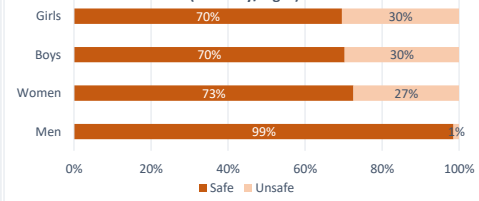

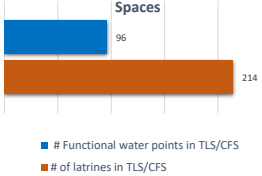


% of People feel safe to use latrines when they need to (or at day/night)

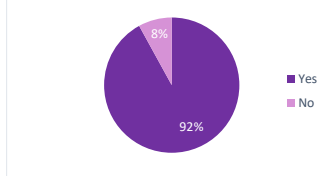

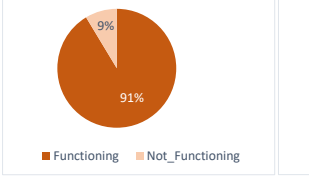
WASH in Temporary Learning Spaces



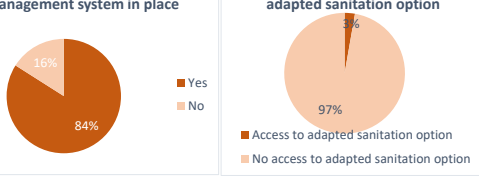
% Sites with TLS/CFS



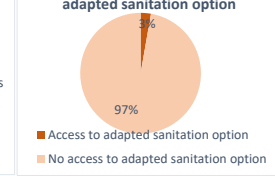
Latrine Functionality



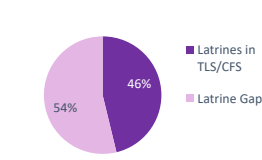

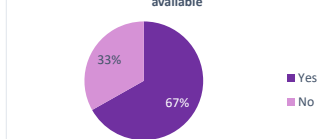
People with disabilities with adapted sanitation option

% of TLS/CFS with a designated place for children to wash hands where soap is available



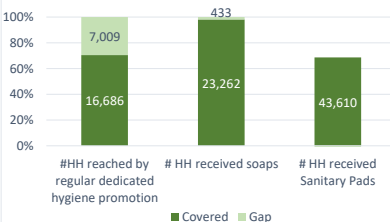

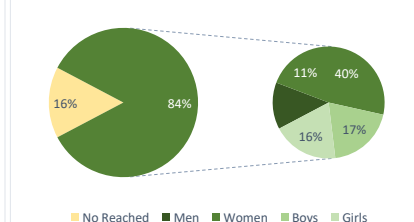
