

## RAKHINE STATE (2017-Qtr 4- 4W Analysis, as of 31 December 2017) Pakokku Highlight of the 4rd Qtr 2017 Cox's Bazar Mindat WASH Cluster Rakhine partners managed to distribute around 30,000 hygiene kits in Sittwe and Pauktaw mainly. Nyaung-U Distribution were undertaken mostly in the months of Nov and WASH Cluster conducted 5 days training (2 days for ToT and 3 days training for partners and counterparts) on WASH in Emergencies for relevant Gov't counterparts and cluster partners. 22 participants trained WiE and 3 on ToTs got the Effective drainage refresher training. in active camps WASH Cluster Rakhine formulated 3 Technical working groups for the year 2018: (1) Behavior change to be led by ■ Functional Oxfam, (2) Water quality to be co-led by SCI and RI, and (3) On-■Non\_Functional site sludge disposal management to be led by SI. ■ Not\_inPlace activities and only four partners working on WiNs. 



