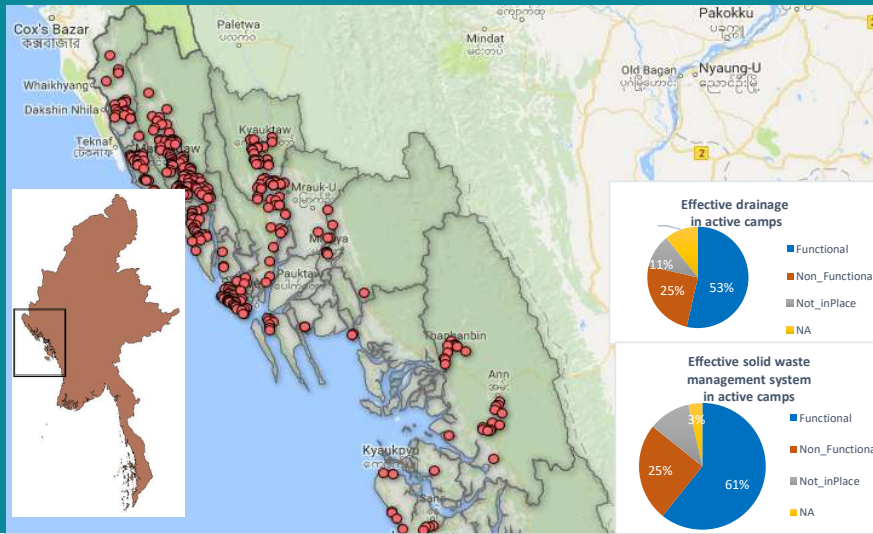


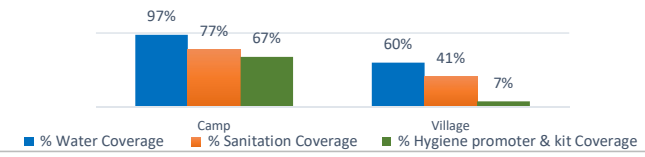
RAKHINE STATE (2017-Qtr 4- 4W Analysis, as of 31 December 2017)

Highlight of the 4rd Qtr 2017

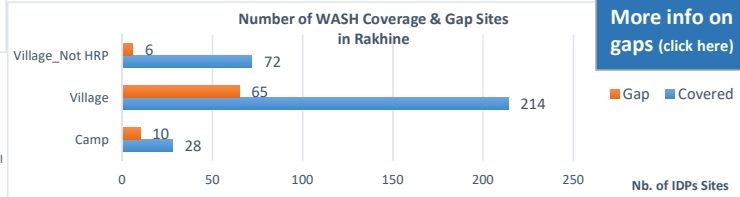
- WASH Cluster Rakhine partners managed to distribute around 30,000 hygiene kits in Sittwe and Pauktaw mainly. Distribution were undertaken mostly in the months of Nov and Dec.
- WASH Cluster conducted 5 days training (2 days for ToT and 3 days training for partners and counterparts) on WASH in Emergencies for relevant Gov't counterparts and cluster partners. 22 participants trained WIE and 3 on ToTs got the refresher training.
- WASH Cluster Rakhine formulated 3 Technical working groups for the year 2018: (1) Behavior change to be led by Oxfam, (2) Water quality to be co-led by SCI and RI, and (3) On-site sludge disposal management to be led by SI.
- WASH Cluster Rakhine collected data on WASH in Schools activities and only four partners working on WINS.
- WASH Cluster Rakhine updated the cyclone resistant latrine design for Rakhine.
- Rakhine WASH Cluster completed the field work for CDC Ceramic water filter study on 29 & 30 Nov 2017. Data collection done in Aunauk Ye village in Pauktaw, Set Yoe Kya (SYK)2 in Sittwe and Nidin camp in Kuaktaw Townships. Findings of the study will be released once finalized by CDC team.
- TA approved by RSG/CC for UNICEF's international staffs



% WASH Coverage against HRP 2017 Targets in Rakhine



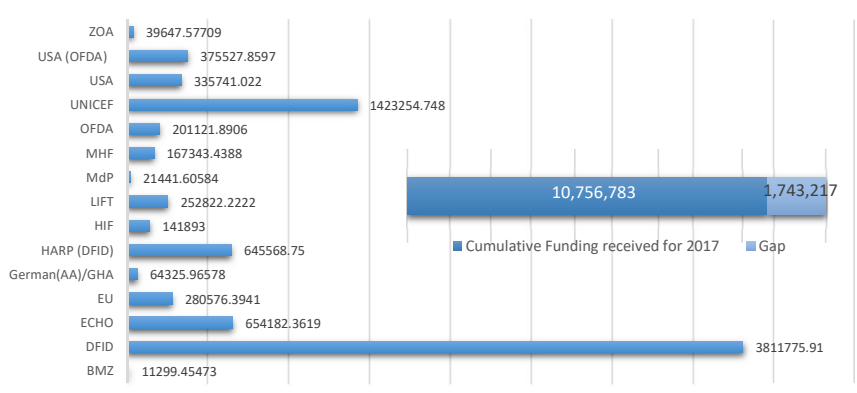
* Water coverage considers improved sources, and unimproved sources combined with treatment (filters). Water quality result data is not yet considered.

 * Hygiene coverage considers access to soap, sanitary pad and ratio of hygiene promoters to population



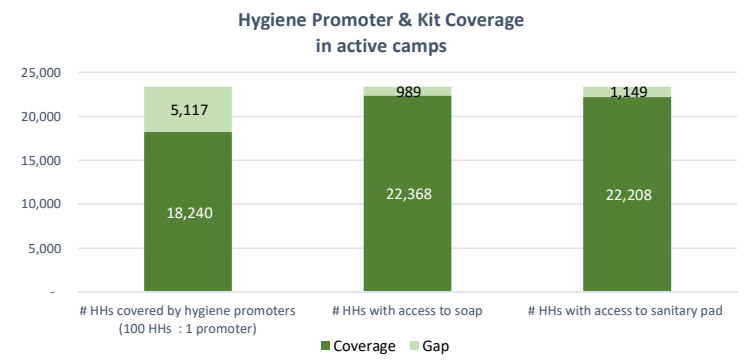
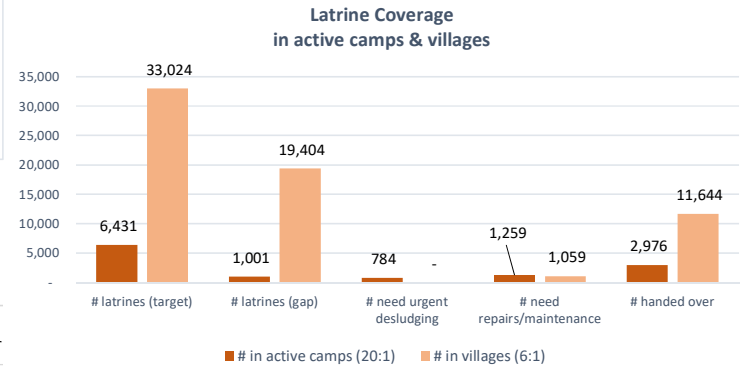
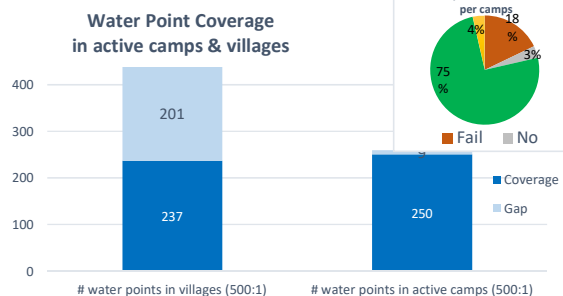
