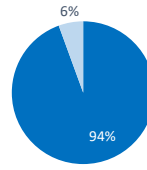

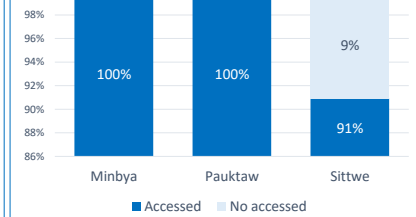

People accessed to safe/improved drinking water, meeting demand for domestic purposes

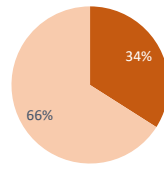

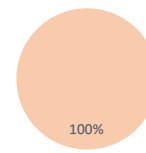


### Sanitation in communities under WASH actors management

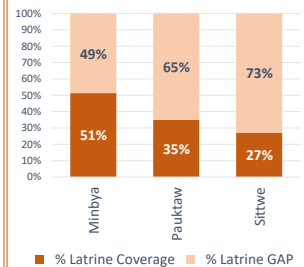
People access to functioning latrine



% of PWD with adapted sanitation option at HH level

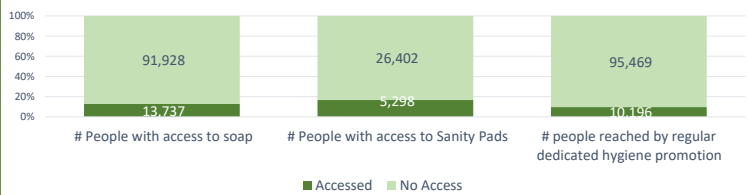


Latrine Coverage VS GAP in Villages

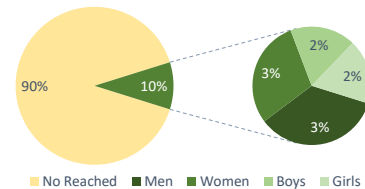

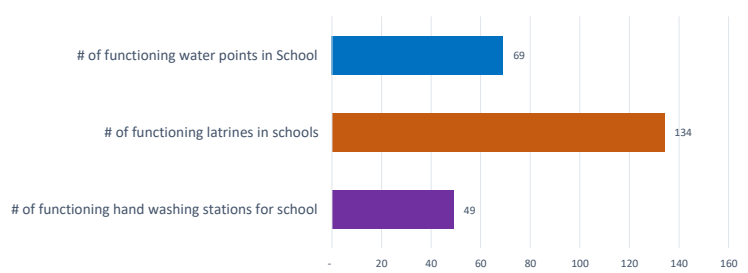
