

- Total 2,348 m3 of fecal sludge removed from the camps
- overall average 32 % of Open Defecation within 15ft of latrines
- 226 Number of functioning children latrine reported



- Total 403 camp paid staff (skilled & unskilled)
- 280 men and 128 women in camp WASH committee
- regular hygiene promotion sessions are decreased to adopt social distancing and to avoid crowded people in the camps as part of covid-19 prevention but covid-19 hygiene awareness with loud speakers are continuing.
