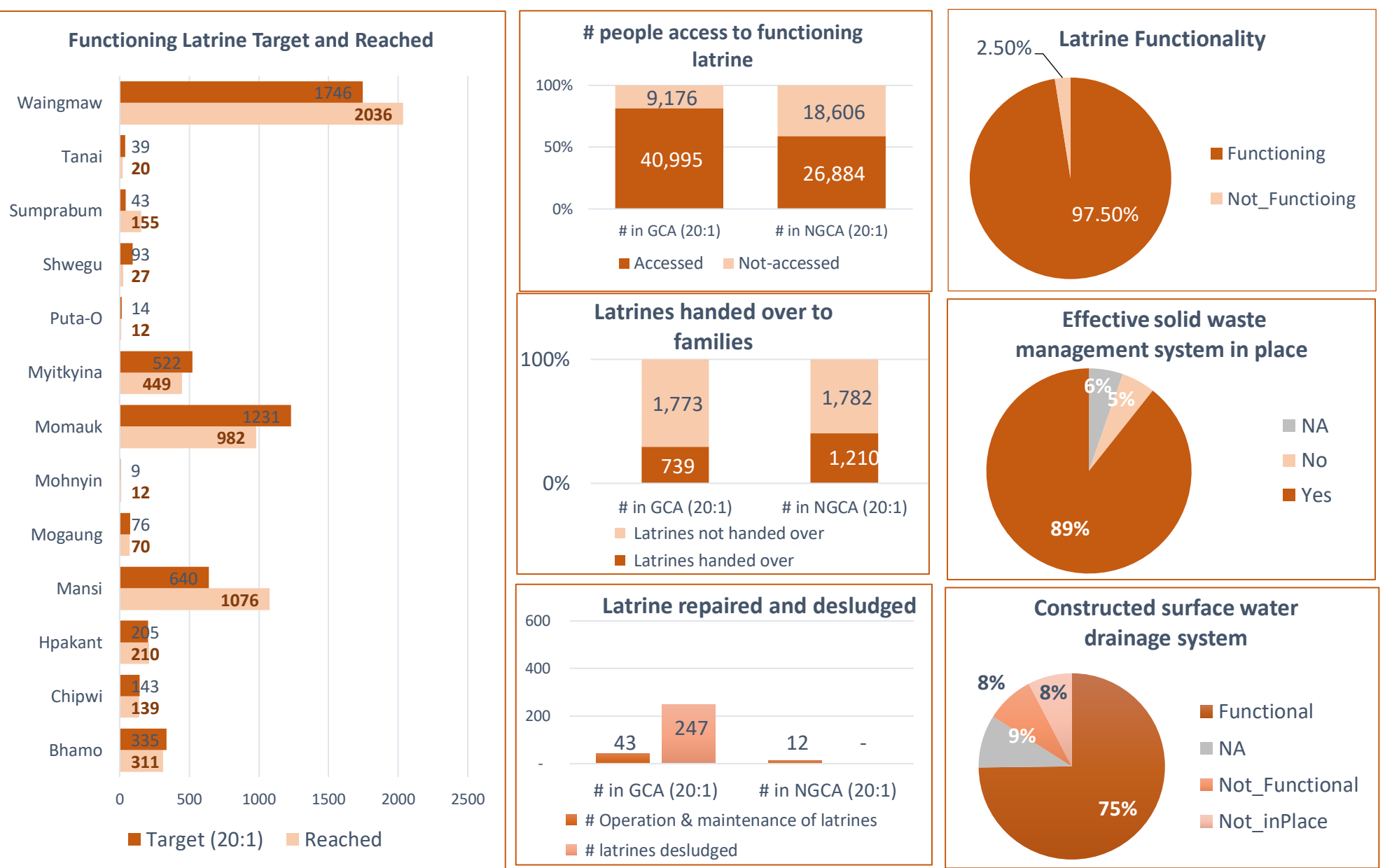
## Number of ppl Covered against 2021 HRP targets



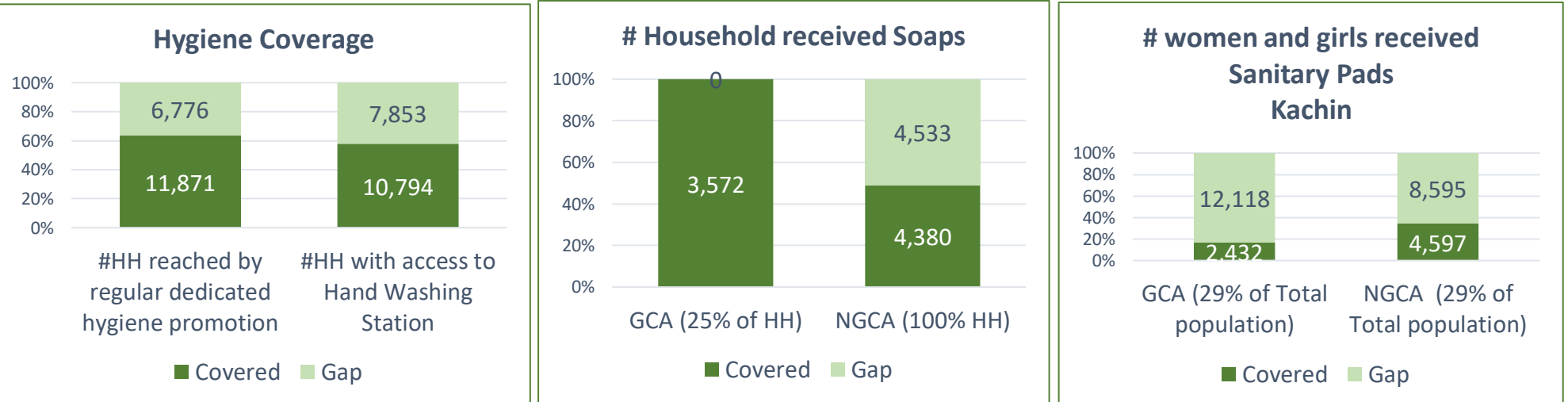
