2020 Cash and Voucher Assistance Activities

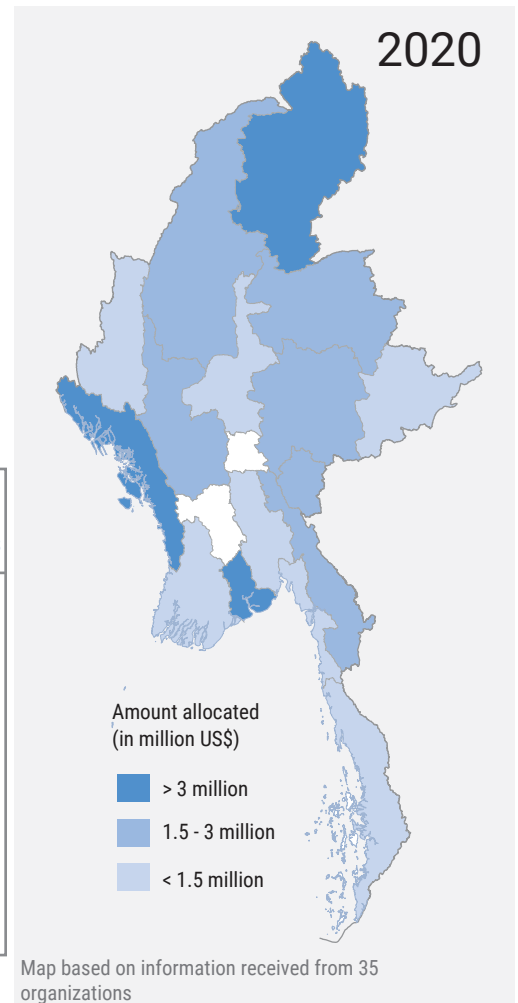
Cash and Voucher Assistance (CVA) interventions have increasingly been used by humanitarian organisations in Myanmar since Cyclone Nargis in 2008. In 2020, humanitarian organisations reached more than 1 million individuals with cash and humanitarian cash transfers totaling more than \$35.6 million. Cash and Voucher Programming is increasingly part of humanitarian response. Innovations such as mobile money and electronic voucher provide opportunities for further scale of CVA in Myanmar.

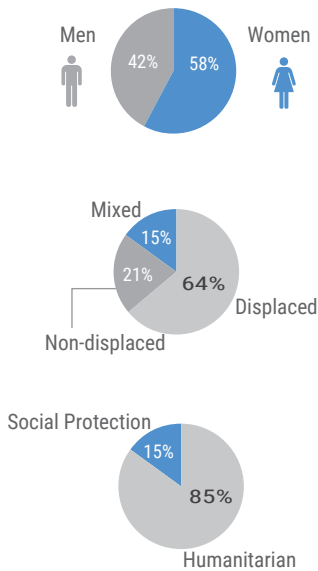

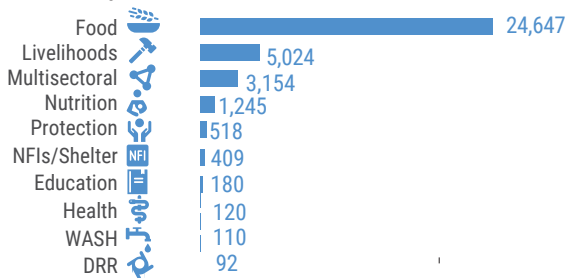

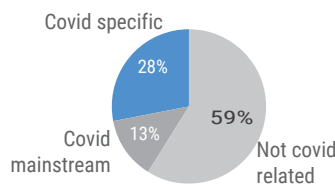

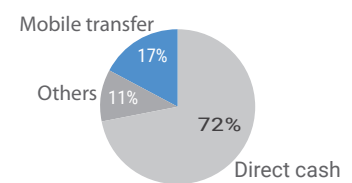
Value by sector of activities (in thousand US\$)
