## WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of IDPs continued to increase since last week, having past the half a million mark, rising from 510,900 to 511,400 people this week.

In Kayah State, 1,675 IDPs were verified. 553 IDPs were verified in Hpruso Township, among them 242 IDPs from Hpasawng Township and 311 IDPs from Thandaunggyi Township in Kayin state. 50 IDPs were verified in Demoso Township, displaced from Nganzun Township in Mandalay Region. Also 1,072 IDPs were displaced to Loikaw Township, from Pekon Township in Shan (South) State. The displacement was due to fighting airstrikes and shelling around their areas.

In Shan (South), 1,627 IDP individuals who were displaced within Pekon Township, returned to their areas of origin.

In Kayin State, due to the intensified fighting near some villages, 306 IDPs from Myawaddy township were displaced within the township.

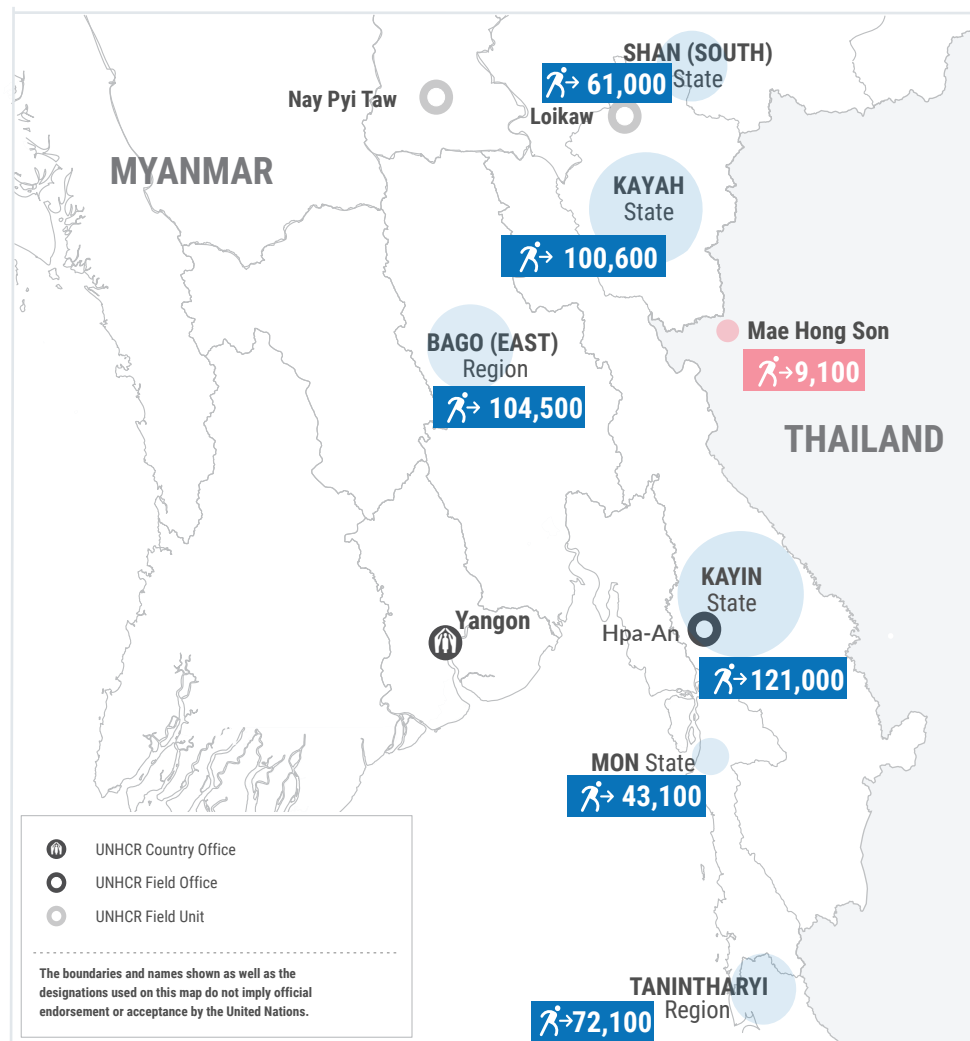
Across the border, 9,060 people from Myanmar remain displaced in Mae Hong Son Province, Thailand.

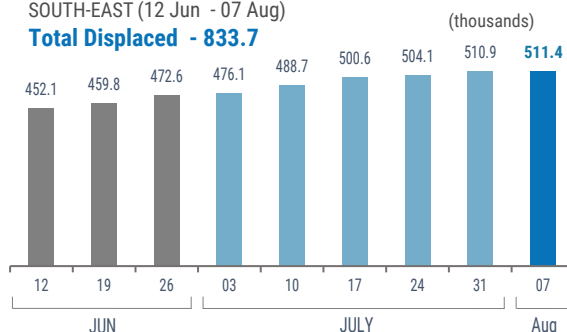

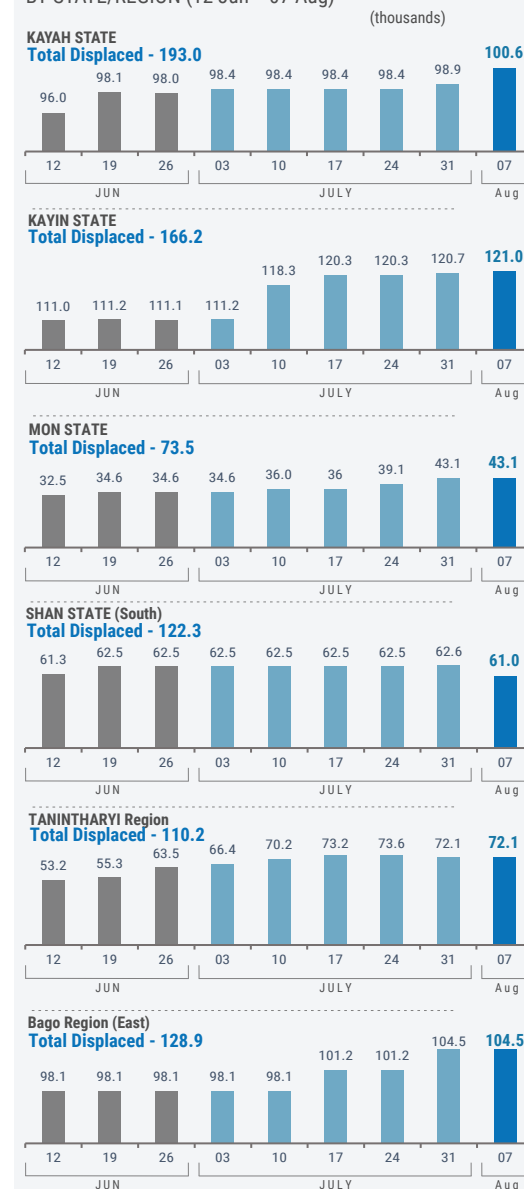
SOUTH-EAST (12 Jun - 07 Aug)
