WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS


In the South-East, the number of IDPs increased from 368,400 last week to 371,300 this week.


In Bago Region (East), indiscriminate shelling displaced about 4,300 people to Kyaukkyi, Phyu, and Htantabin Townships. Of the approximately 4,300 IDPs in Kyaukkyi Township, 1,880 were re-displaced. In Htantabin Township, 20 IDPs from Thandaunggyi Township in Kayin State were verified.

In Kayin State, fighting in Kawkareik and Kyainseikgyi Townships on 24 January displaced about 250 people within both townships. In Mon State, 360 IDPs were verified in Mawlamyine town following fighting in Kawkareik and Kyainseikgyi Townships in Kayin State.
