WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of IDPs increased from 502,300 last week to 503,200 this week.

In Tanintharyi Region, increased fighting near some villages due to the escalating conflict displaced 960 people. About 650 were displaced from Launglon Township. Among them, 340 were displaced within the township while 300 were displaced to Dawei Township. In addition, 320 IDPs from Dawei Township were displaced within the township.

Across the border, about 9,100 people from Myanmar remain displaced in Mae Hong Son Province, Thailand.


