
## **WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS**


In the South-East, the number of IDPs decreased from 438,500 last week to 433,003 this week.

In Bago Region (East), increased fighting near some villages, forced 170 IDPs from Thandaunggyi Township to flee to Taungoo town as secondary displacement.


In Tanintharyi Region, stabilization of the security situation enabled about 5,500 IDPs to return to their places of origin. About 2,200 IDPs returned to Palaw Township, while 3,300 IDPs returned to Launglon Township.

In Kayin State, 70 IDPs from Kayin State were verified in Hlaingbwe Township because of armed conflict near their villages, including 40 IDPs from Hpapun Township, 30 IDPs from Myawaddy Township and two IDPs from Kyaukkyi Township in Bago Region (East).
