Number of people displaced in South East since Feb 2021 and remain displaced

WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of IDPs increased from 491,600 from last week to 495,100 this week.

In Mon State, about 3,100 people were displaced by intensified fighting, shelling and use of heavy weapons near their villages on 14 July. Some 1,600 people from at least three villages in Kyaikto Township were displaced within the township. In addition, 1,600 people from three villages in Bilin Township were displaced within the township.

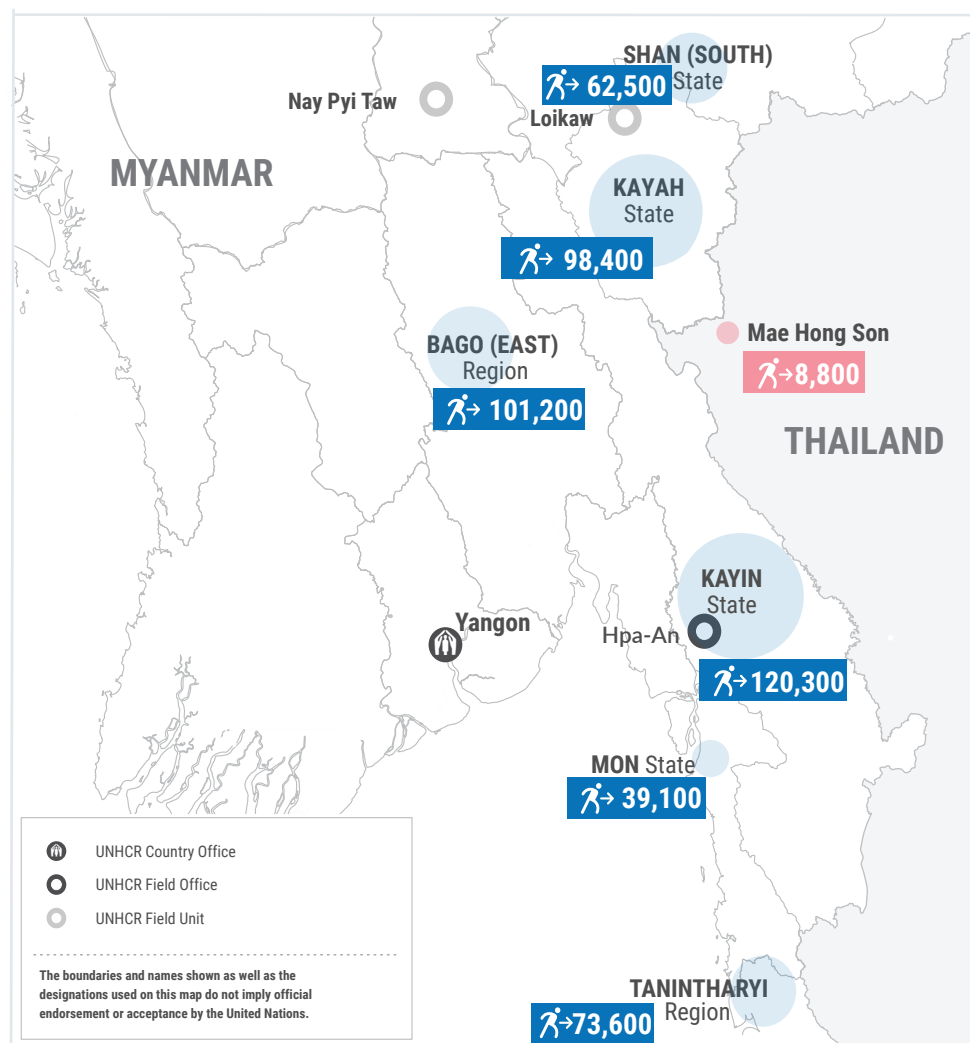
In Tanintharyi Region, 2,300 people from six villages in Tanintharyi Township were displaced within the township because of intensified fighting, shelling and use of heavy weapons near their villages. Among them are 500 IDPs who were secondarily displaced. Across the border, 8,800 people remain displaced in Mae Hong Son Province, Thailand.

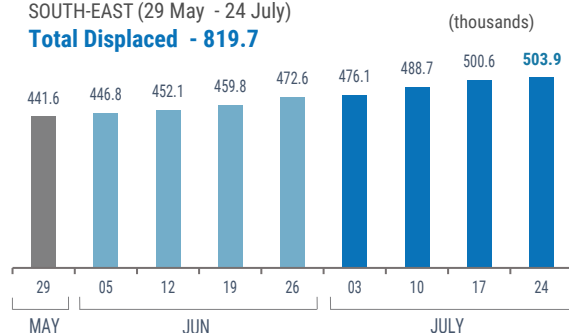

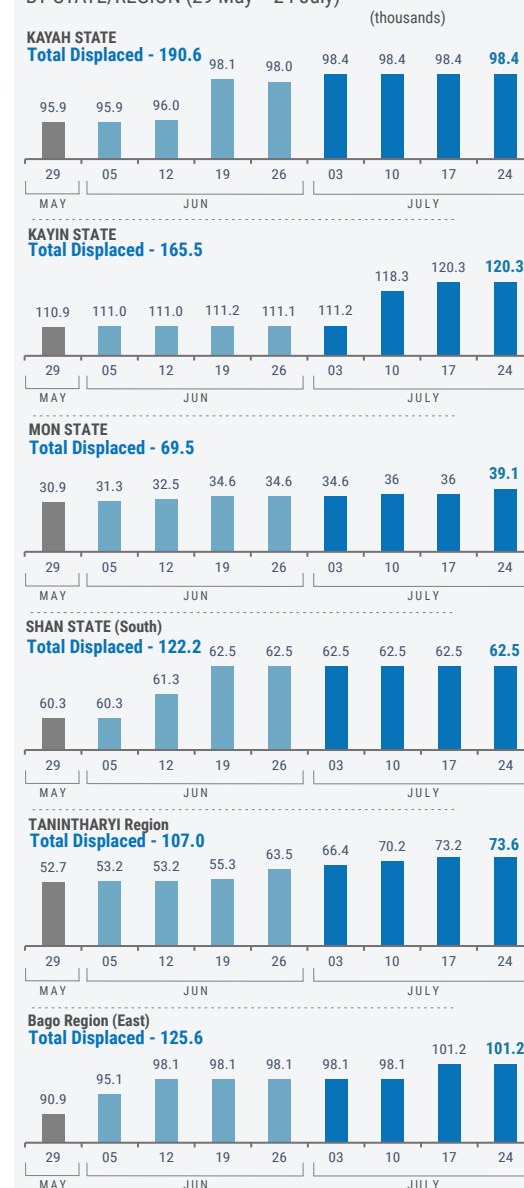
