WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of IDPs increased from 327,800 last week to 328,900 this week.

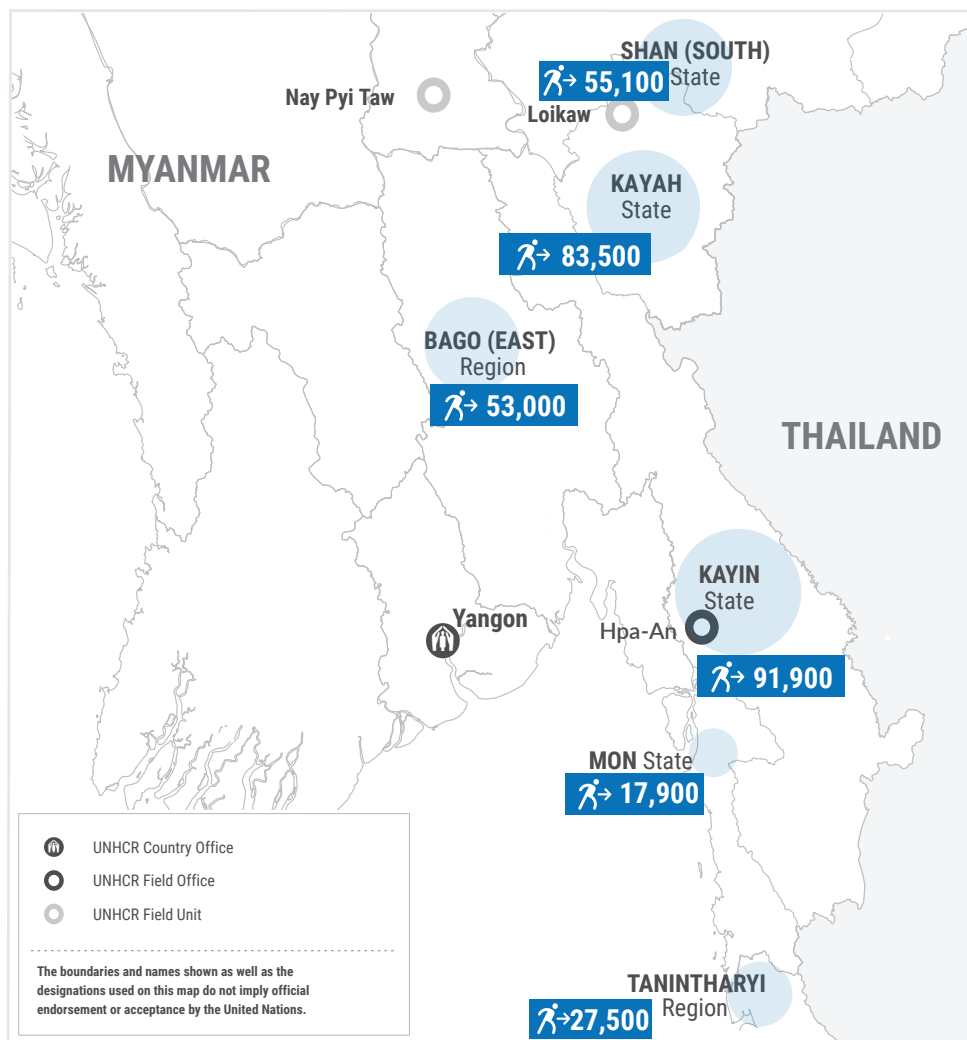
Clashes, airstrikes and indiscriminate shelling were reported in Kayin State where 625 people have been displaced in Kawkareik and Thand-aunggyi Townships.

In Mon State, some 1,073 IDPs from Thaton Township, who were temporarily displaced in nearby areas since early November 2022 have now returned to their places of origin as the situation improved.

Due to increased armed clashes in Shan State (South), a total of 1,168 IDPs originally from Loikaw Township, Kayah State (895 people) and Pekon Township, Shan State (South) (273 people) have been verified in Hsihseng Township.

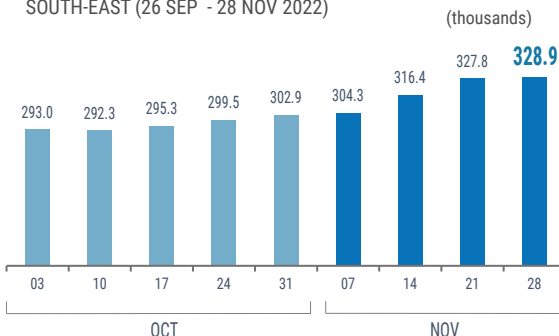

People who are estimated to be displaced by conflict in SE Myanmar (as of 28 Nov 2022).



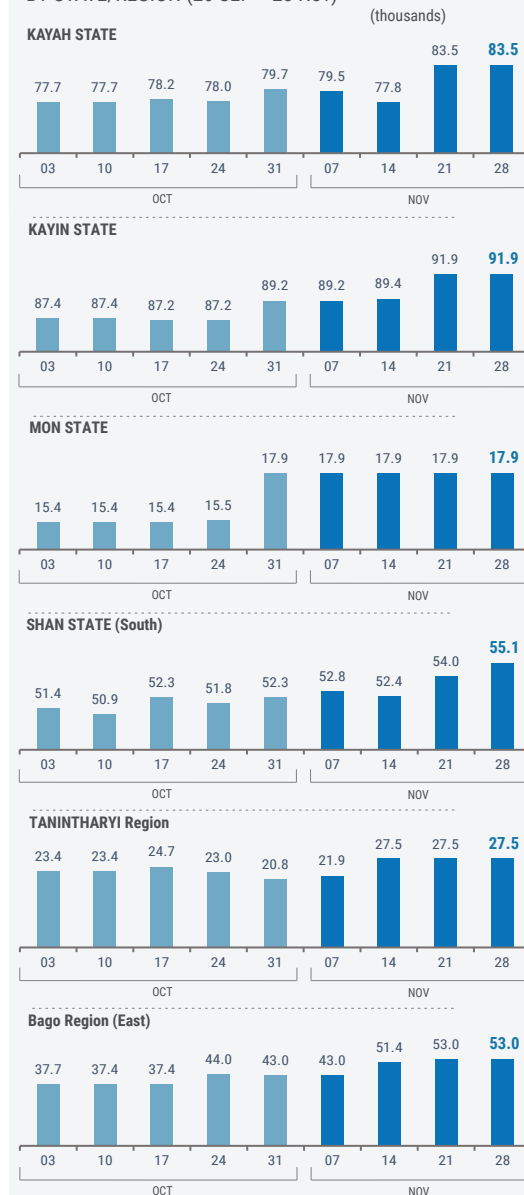
WEEKLY DISPLACEMENT FIGURES⁽¹⁾
