

EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION FOR CYCLONE

Transcript of audio recording

AS-SALAMU ALAYKUM/MINGALABAR! Please listen to this important message on what to do when a cyclone is about to hit your area.

- Unless otherwise indicated, your home is your main shelter during the cyclone. If your home is at risk, select the strongest house in your neighbourhood and bring your family there.
- 2. Stay as low down as possible during the storm and, if possible, take shelter under something strong such as under the table or chairs.
- 3. Keep children and other family members inside the shelter. Never hand your child over to a stranger who might offer help.
- 4. Keep all family members together. Before the cyclone, select a specific place where you can get together again, if anyone gets separated.
- 5. There will be strong winds. Ensure that any loose tin sheet or other sharp objects around your house cannot be dislodged during the storm, fly away and hit someone.
- 6. Keep your valuables such as: ID card, household list, ration card, etc. wrapped in plastic and in a safe place by digging in the ground.
- 7. Keep enough dry foods and water in your shelter and cover it with a plastic sheet.
- 8. Make sure the children, the elderly, the persons with a disability and pregnant women in your family or locality are safe and being taken care of.
- 9. During any cyclone, the wind speed may decrease, or the wind cease altogether for a while in some areas. In this situation, everything will become normal for a while. You must NOT go outside the house during this seemingly normal time. You can only go out when there is a clear signal or announcement that he storm has ended completely.
