The Advocacy and Awareness TTF meeting discussed 100 day plan of the RRD. Under 100 day plan, there have three tasks relating to DRR and Emergency response such as awareness program for DRR, review of existing IEC materials and preparation for upcoming Monsoon. In terms of resources for IEC materials, UNDP has some budgets under MCCDM project. AAM and ADPC also have some budgets for IEC materials printing and ADPC has a plan to support on TV spot (TV broadcasting) as well. 3	Myanmar Climate Research, BRACED – BBC media	<p>BBC Media Action presented the research findings on Myanmar Climate Research conducted in Coastal, Delta, Dry, Hilly and Plain zones during July – September 2015.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The objective of the research was to understand how people are living with changes in the environment and how its impacts shape their future, and how they, in turn, will shape their environment ○ BBC Media Action had also conducted Climate Asia study in seven countries namely; Bangladesh, China, India, Indonesia, Nepal, Pakistan and Vietnam in 2012. The findings are based on a total sample of over 33,500 survey respondents. ○ 3000 respondents were participated in the interview in Myanmar ○ According to the research findings, it is increasing in the percentage of temperature 94%, rainfall 52%, cyclones 26%, floods 34% and drought 37% in all areas. ○ The research provided a unique and replicable regional evidence base used to evaluate the impact of existing public information on climate change. ○ The research also helped to design more effective communication strategies to mitigate the impact of climate extremes in the future.
