The draft of writing the nomination for Sasakawa will be provided by Jaiganesh(UN-Habitat) by 16th September 2014 to SC members for the review. SC members will review and provide comments by email. List of Sasakawa Award Winner from Myanmar was asked by Director General U Soe Aung, Relief and Resettlement Department. After that he will request to Minister for nomination. 4	Discussion on representing at TTF.	 DRR WG chair shared the Generic ToR and Guidance Notes TTFs which was endorsed on last working group meeting (15th August 2014). When the DRR WG framework is developed, Technical Task Forces are formed with thematic areas. As per the work plan, TTFs are also working. In Working Group, individuals, consultants and agencies are included. The participants of TTFs are the representatives of agencies. The discussion is followed that whether to consider the participation of consultants in the TTF or not. There are some issues on participation of consultant in the TTFs. As consultants are focused with their assignment, there may have some issues on their representing as TTF members. SC members discussed and agreed that the representing at TTF will be only nominated by agency either they are fix term staff or consultant. 	
5	IDDR day preparation	 Update of IDDR day preparation is shared by Jaganesh and DRR WG suggested to commemorate the IDDR day preparation with DRR WG members. The estimate budget for national level is not yet out. For the National Level, Help Age shared the charter 14 which is going to conduct as side event workshop at IDDR day (national level). At side event, there will be presentation by Help Age about inclusion of older people in DRR and some discussion about Charter 14 which was developed by UNISDR and HelpAge. Help Age have one document to launch at IDDR day with 44 pages. For the budget contribution, SC suggested to put in budget list of DRR WG. Chair of DRR WG, Daw Lat Lat Aye will share the translated Charter to DG. SC members will request to RRD to put DRR WG logo on IDDR day main back drop as the acknowledgement from government for its collaboration. Action Aid shared the draft TOR of Media Strategy workshop and ask for suggestions and comments. MRTV, Live Line media groups, Ministry of Information and BBC media are suggested to be invited. The workshop is intended to have key messages for DRR public awareness. It means workshop outcome will be messages what to deliver to the public and any specific channel means journal, broadcasting, radio. Workshop is postponed to a later date after IDDR day. The revised concept note will be shared to SC members again by Khual Tawna, ActionAid. SC members suggested planning the workshop with the media groups and identifying the needs and gaps of media in DRR sector.
