gather information on affected populations following last year's	
flooding and we are looking at how better use of ICT can enhance its	
use,	
(5) enhancing capacity building – looking at how better use of ICT as well	
as practical non ICT-dependent methods can make MIMU resources as	
well as other guidelines and capacity building materials more
