Sector update from Rakhine and Kachin	 ACF: Regular activities as previous months. However, MAM children under 5 are not admitted since 31 Dec. ACF has enough RUTF until June 15th for NRS. No visibility after that. ACF suggests to UNICEF and WHO to meet in order to liaise their presence in NRS with MoH in order to have only one meeting (every month or every two months – to be determined) in order to allow better coordination and a more comprehensive approach. Improvement of OTP outcome in December could be attributed to the communities' involvement in nutrition activities as well as home visits and 	Sector coordinator to follow up with Rakhine
