Summary of discussion	<p>- WASH Cluster shared 2018-Q3 newsletter and Snapshot of Northern Shan resulted from 4W data analysis.</p> <p>- It was found that Most of Hygiene Gap in 100% in NSS , all the attendees suggested to collect the data form the NFI cluster partners who distribute the NFI and dignity kits in NSS protracted camps .</p>
Action points	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • WASH cluster had collected the data form NFI cluster partners. Esp .. IRC • Agency need to report to cluster if they distribute hygiene items whenever hygiene sessions was conducted.

Topic 3 &4: Agency Update/ New IDPs and Agency Response	
Summary of discussion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ICRC shared that on tube well 150’ have been drilling in Nam Pet Kar (Aung Tha Pyay camp) , finishing and availability of water will share after installation finished. - ICRC also shared they have planning for preposition of emergency stock in Namtu collaboration with MRCS in each township. - DRD department representative shared that their department has reserve stock for water supply, so ,NGOs can collaborate wtith DRD if they need support for water supply in rural area and protracted camp. But that need to engage with village administrator or GAD and can apply to department of rural development in each township. - DRD also shared their activities for rural solar project that being implementing in 63 townships with World Bank. - SCI shared that they will cover the KBC camp in Kutkai and Namtu area. They have been installed 2doors latrine (5)units , (2) water storage tanks , (6) Hand washing stations and (2) bathing room in Man San Monastery in Namtu townships as prepositioning of hardware for recent displacement . - SCI announced that they have some hygiene stock for contingency purpose.If needed in case of emergency it can request to SCI. - Metta shared that they had provided worm cloths and blanket to IDPs who fled to Enai Church . - KMSS is planning to conduct soap making training in Oct, Nov and Dec in camps. - KMSS also shared that KBC is being providing cash for hygiene items 50,000 Ks to one Household instead of distributing in kind, that can reduce the transportation cost and more effective because IDPs can choose what they need. - OCHA told that all agency should coordinate before distribution and should wait 48 hrs to have detail information . <p>IDPs up date Location1- Man Su Monastery – HH 256 , M-432, F 432, Total – 1000 as of 30 th October Location2-KBC Church in Lashio- HH 75, M-108, F 132, Total -240. Location 3- RC Church in Lashio – HH 30 , Total of 105 individuals.</p>
