The entire citizen must stand over the conflict, lower our identity barriers and bring out our sense of belonging to the nation, start to love the nation as a whole, as us and rally together for Nation Building.

The experience we are having now is happening because of incomplete nation building, an inheritance of the colonialist's divide and rule policies which worked brilliantly because of the diversities and different sociopolitical values of our people. There are many reasons for us being lacking a National Identity, a common destiny or belongingness to our Nation but one thing for sure is that we as a nation facing new challenges and unfamiliar concepts of the outside world which we had stay apart over half of the 20th century needs a common ground and the will to participate in the nation building process.

When it comes to conflicts such as the communal violence in Rakhine State, the religious tensions and ethnic problems we must find the roots of the problem to be able to solve them peacefully. We must initiate other Civil society groups that to be able to define what are the symptoms and what are the real source of the problems, is important in solving issues which concern our nation building.

In this case, there are the parts that the Government/ The Political Leaders need to bring focus to solve and we, from the citizen side must also look outside the individual perception and go forward with the spirit of oneness "Doe Pyi Htaung Su. Doe Lu Htu - One People One Nation" for the development and prosperity of our Nation. It doesn't mean that we have to leave our individual identities behind, we love our families, our ethnicity, our religions and our beliefs for without our identities we will be nothing but we must remember always that it is essential for us to stand as one people one nation . For example we want our country to practice nationalisms like the Mosaic nationalism from Canada, not the Melting pot nationalism from America.

To keep such kind of sprit among the public, we require concerned stakeholders' support through the role of Civil Society. On the other hand, the support of the Civil Society is still weak in long term development projects of the Nation Building process. The role of civil society has been greatly lessened over the years, the definition of civil societies is starting to seem as profit mongers by most of our citizens. 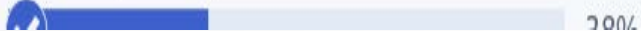

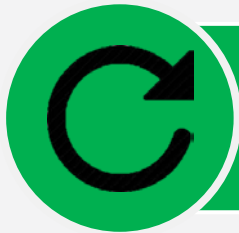
