



No. of Organizations reporting 5W Updates




46 more agencies reported in March 2022 compared to Oct 2021 (28% increasing), however there was a slight decrease in 2022 with 4 less agencies reporting in March 2022 than in August 2020.

The majority of agencies which no longer reported in May 2021 were NGOs, (26 less INGOs, and 19 less NNGOs). However, number of national NGOs contributed to 5W products had been increasing (9 more in Oct 2021 and 28 more in Mar 2022) while 12 more borderbased agencies reported in March 2022.

BBO* - Border-based Organization


CBO* - Community-based Organization

Reporting in August 2020 still the highest reported number of organisations in all states/regions except Shan south and Kachin.


There was a significant increase in the number of reporting agencies between October 2021 and March 2022 in all state/regions.




Compared to August 2020, reporting was reduced across 15 sectors in March 2022 and more agencies reported activities in 6 sectors.

The number of reporting agencies picked up in all sectors between October 2021 and March 2022, except DRR, Infrastructure, Peace Building/ Conflict Prevention and Shelter.







Overview of the August 2020 3W KACHIN State

The MIMU 3W gathers inputs from participating humanitarian and development agencies on Who is doing What, Where, across Myanmar. It is conducted every 6 months and provides information on agencies' activities at various levels (village/village tract/township, and IDP camps).

Myanmar Information Management Unit

In total, 213 agencies participated in the August 2020 3W, providing information on their humanitarian and development activities across 22 sectors and 157 sub-sectors as defined by technical/sector working groups. 3W reporting is quite comprehensive for projects of INGO. UN and field Cross agencies, but there is under-reporting of activities for local XIGOs and CBOs, since not all are participating. Agencies must report to a sufficiently detailed level (village or camp level) for their work to be reflected fully in the MIMU SW products.

1. Organizations active in Kachin State

A total of 73 agencies reported activities in Kachin state: 50 are engaged in Development focused projects (30% village tracts/towns), 17 are engaged in support to other violnerable groups (not IDP related, 274 village tracts/towns), 29 are engaged in activities which target IDPs and holds Communities (215 village tracts/towns and 118 camp) and 23 are active in IDP-Bocosed activities (59 village tracts/towns and 134 camps). IDP-related projects were reported in a total of 135 camps or camp-lake groups.

A total of 173 projects were reported in Kachin State: 32% of the projects involve work with IDPs (56 IDP & Host Community or IDP-only focused projects), and 68% have a focus on other populations (117 Other Vulnerable Groups and/or Development-focused projects).

<u>Non-DP focused projects (Dher Yuhnerable Groups and/or Development activities</u>): 99 organizations reported 117 village or tomothip-based projects under implementation in 462 village tract/stowns). The majority are implemented by INGOs. Most of the reported projects are in Momauk (48 village tract/stowns), Chipwi (41), Waingmaw and Mohnyin (38 in each), Manii (56), Mykrisin (32), Bharnol (31), Shwegi, (30) and Mogung (28).

<u>IDP & Biols Community and IDP-only Coursed activities</u>: 38 organizations reported 56 projects under implementation in 236 village tract/covers and 135. IDE camps. The majority are implemented by NicoS and UN agences. Most of these projects are in Morauk (47 village tract/covers and 153 course), Waingmaw (29 and 25), Shwagu (23 and 3), Matsing (21 and 13), Bahmo (17 and 8), Myritivina (16 and 8), Mogang (16 and 11), Mohying (14 and 5) and Hyaaht (12 and 2).


