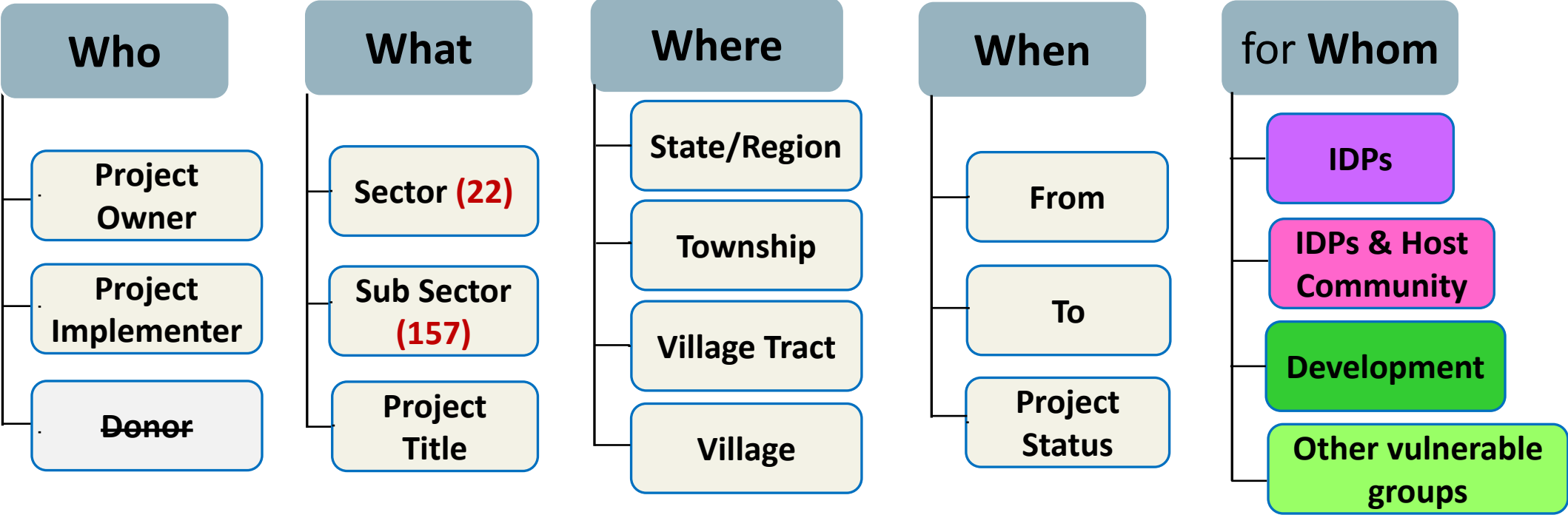

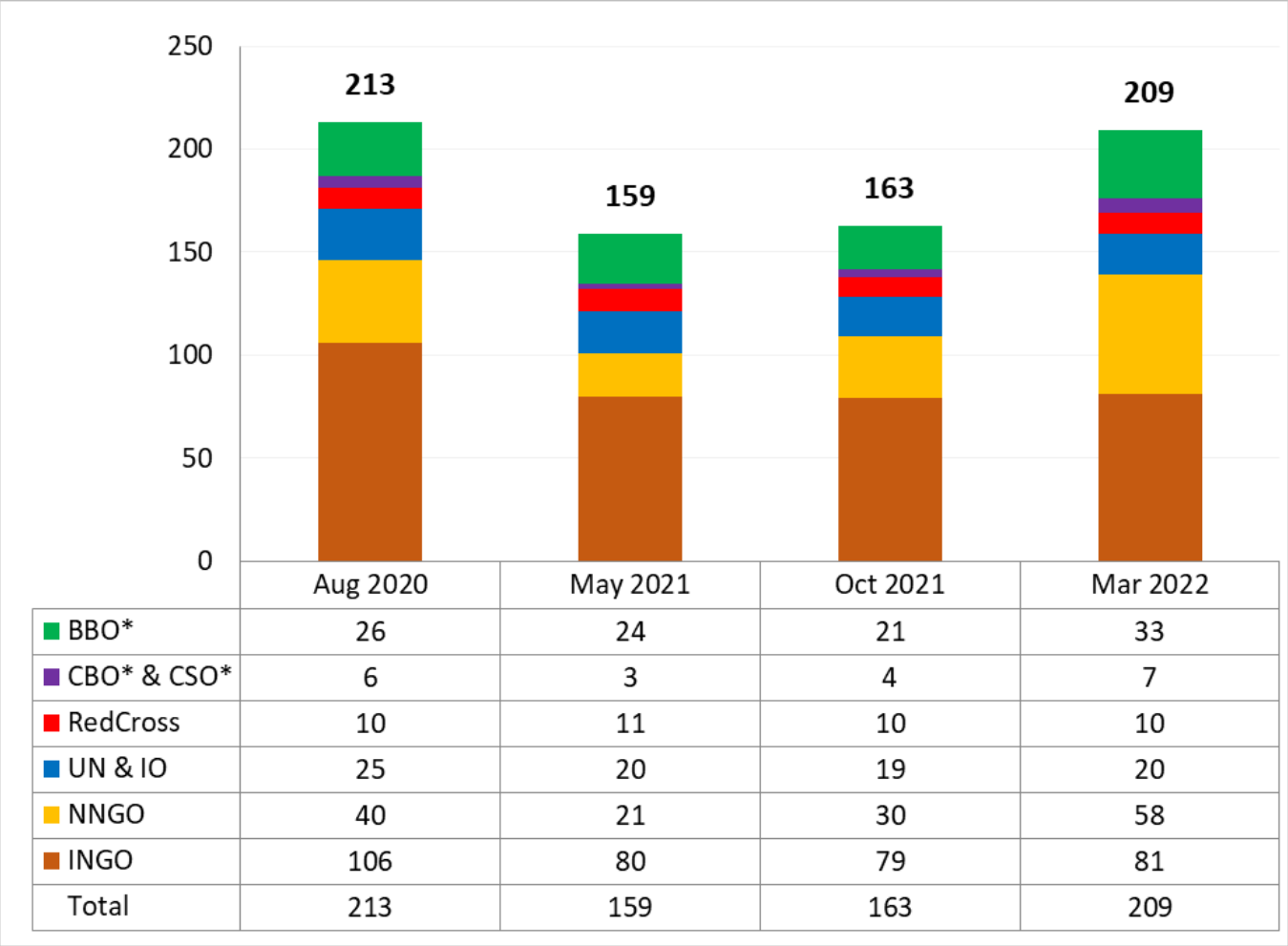

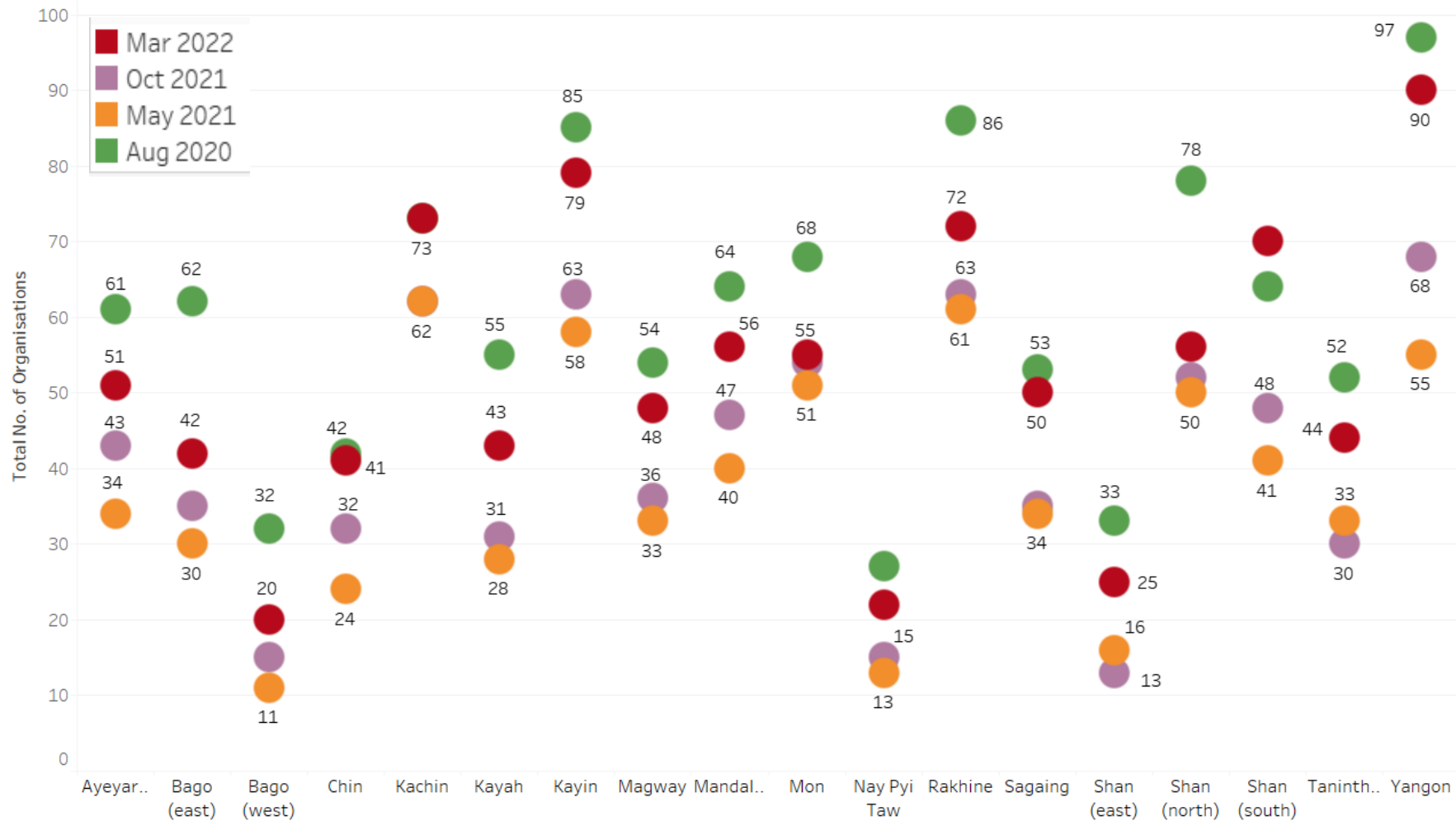
# No. of Organizations reporting 5W Updates



46 more agencies reported in March 2022 compared to Oct 2021 (28% increasing), however there was a slight decrease in 2022 with 4 less agencies reporting in March 2022 than in August 2020.

The majority of agencies which no longer reported in May 2021 were NGOs, (26 less INGOs, and 19 less NNGOs). However, number of national NGOs contributed to 5W products had been increasing (9 more in Oct 2021 and 28 more in Mar 2022) while 12 more border-based agencies reported in March 2022.

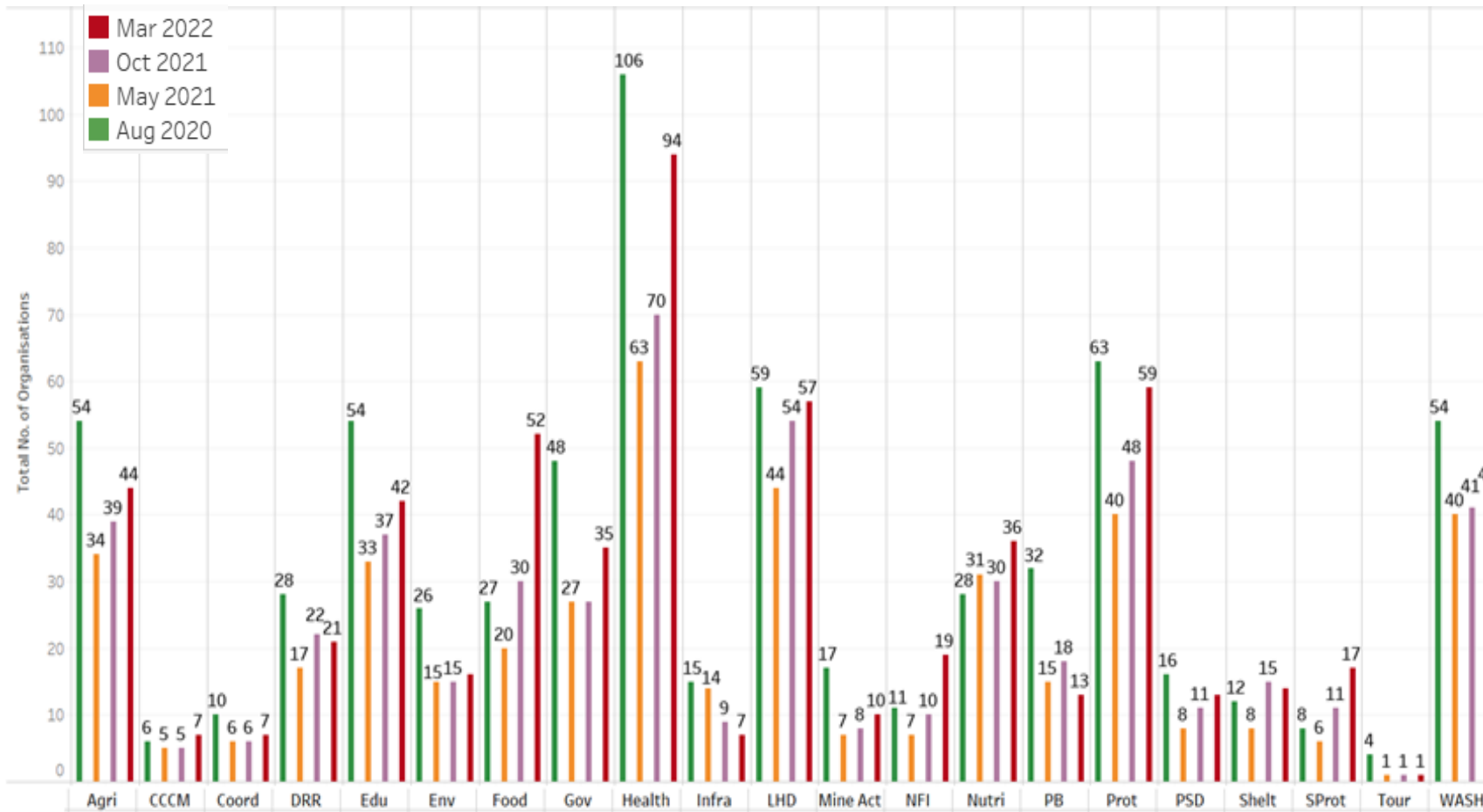
## Number of Organisations by State/Region



Reporting in August 2020 still the highest reported number of organisations in all states/regions except Shan south and Kachin.

There was a significant increase in the number of reporting agencies between October 2021 and March 2022 in all state/regions.

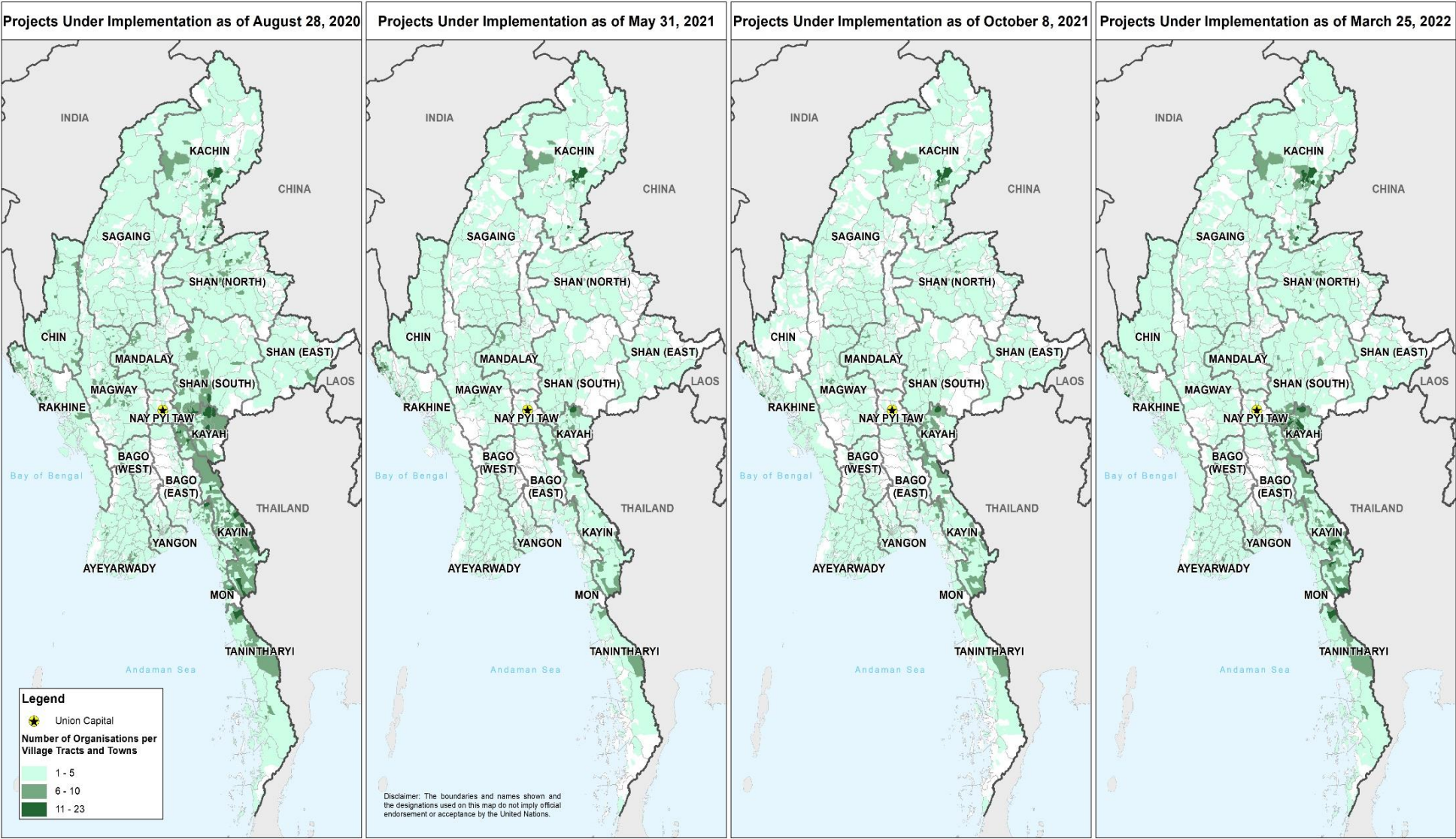
## Number of Organisations by Sector



Compared to August 2020, reporting was reduced across 15 sectors in March 2022 and more agencies reported activities in 6 sectors.

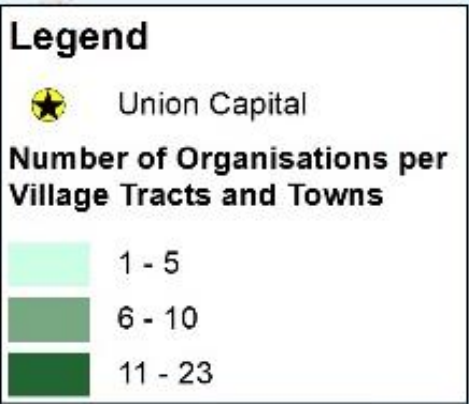

# Number of Organizations reporting Projects Under Implementation by Village Tract



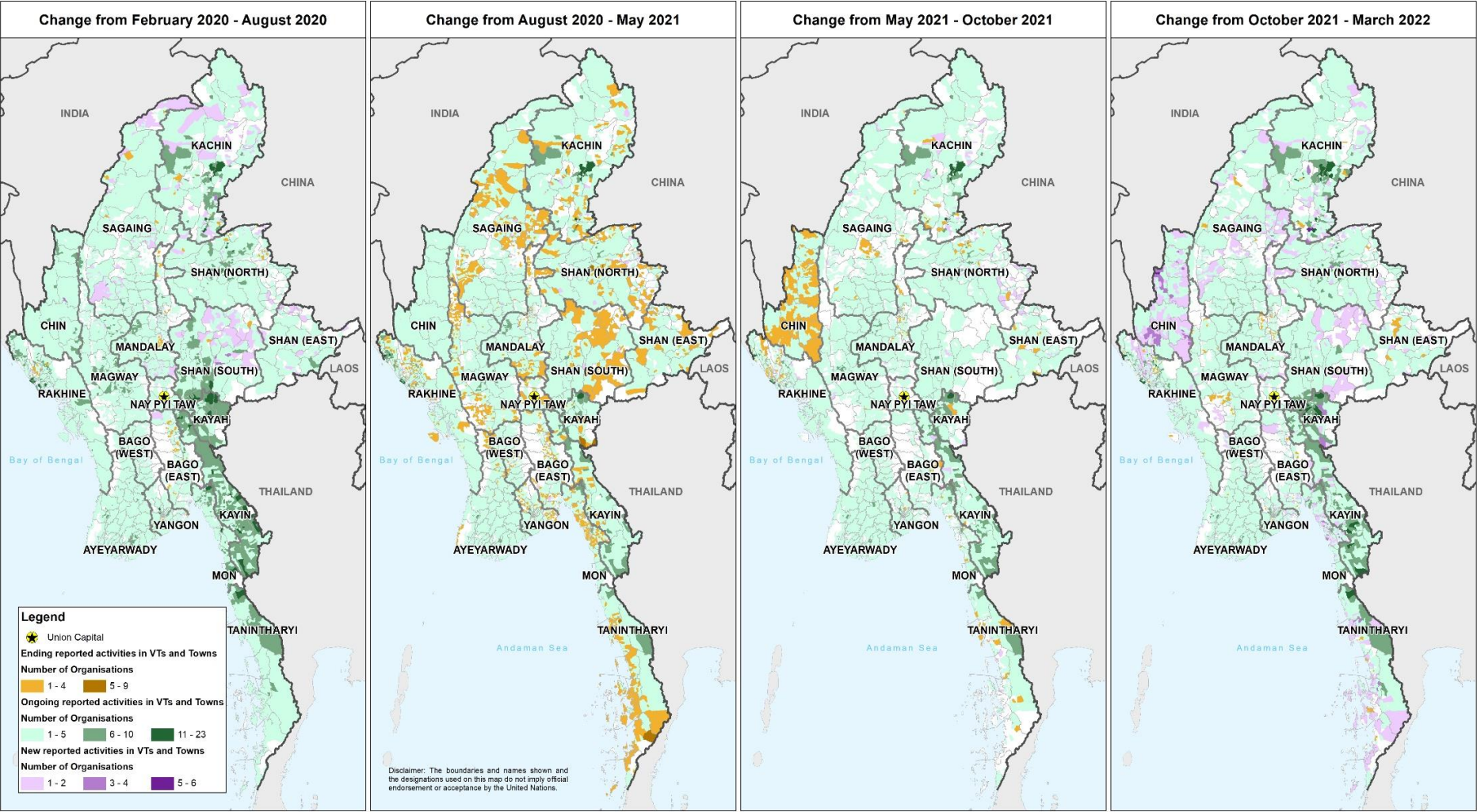

# Additional Data Protection measures since 2021

## 1) Agency names no longer appear in Public products

- But may be shared in 5W data for restricted use by contributing agencies, for inter-agency coordination.

## 2) Agencies decide level of data protection when submitting their 5W inputs

- **Open** – agency names can be shared for restricted purposes (contributing ags, inter-agency coordination)
- **Restricted** – agency name is marked UNSPECIFIED, including in restricted products

**Overview of the August 2020 3W**

**KACHIN State**

The MIMU 3W gathers inputs from participating humanitarian and development agencies on Who is doing What, Where, across Myanmar. It is conducted every 6 months and provides information on agencies' activities at various levels (village/tract/township, and IDP camps).

In total, 213 agencies participated in the August 2020 3W, providing information on their humanitarian and development activities across 22 sectors and 157 sub-sectors as defined by technical/sector working groups. 3W reporting is quite comprehensive for projects of INGO, UN and Red Cross agencies, but there is under-reporting of activities for local NGOs and CBOs, since not all are participating. Agencies must report to a sufficiently detailed level (village or camp level) for their work to be reflected fully in the MIMU 3W products.

**This Overview describes projects under implementation in Kachin as of August 28, 2020. Further information on planned and recently completed projects is available from the 3W dataset, published on the MIMU website. Projects under implementation can also be viewed on our interactive dashboards - 3W Township Dashboard, 3W Village Tract Dashboard, and the 3W Technical Assistance Dashboard.**

**1. Organizations active in Kachin State**

A total of 73 agencies reported activities in Kachin state: 50 are engaged in Development-focused projects (396 village tracts/towns), 17 are engaged in support to other vulnerable groups (not IDP related, 274 village tracts/towns), 29 are engaged in activities which target IDPs and Host Communities (215 village tracts/towns and 118 camps) and 23 are active in IDP-focused activities (95 village tracts/towns and 134 camps). IDP-related projects were reported in a total of 135 camps or camp-like settings.

A total of 173 projects were reported in Kachin State: 32% of the projects involve work with IDPs (56 IDP & Host Community or IDP-only focused projects), and 68% have a focus on other populations (117 Other Vulnerable Groups and/or Development-focused projects).

**Non-IDP focused projects (Other Vulnerable Groups and/or Development activities):** 59 organizations reported 117 village or township-based projects under implementation in 462 village tracts/towns. The majority are implemented by INGOs. Most of the reported projects are in Momaik (48 village tracts/towns), Chipwi (41), Waingmaw and Mohnyin (38 in each), Mansi (36), Myitkyina (32), Bhamo (31), Shwegu (30) and Mogauing (28).

**IDP & Host Community and IDP-only focused activities:** 38 organizations reported 56 projects under implementation in 236 village tracts/towns and 135 IDP camps. The majority are implemented by INGOs and UN agencies. Most of these projects are in Momaik (47 village tracts/towns and 15 camps), Waingmaw (29 and 25), Shwegu (23 and 3), Mansi (22 and 11), Bhamo (17 and 8), Myitkyina (16 and 26), Mogauing (16 and 11), Mohnyin (14 and 5) and Hpakant (13 and 22).

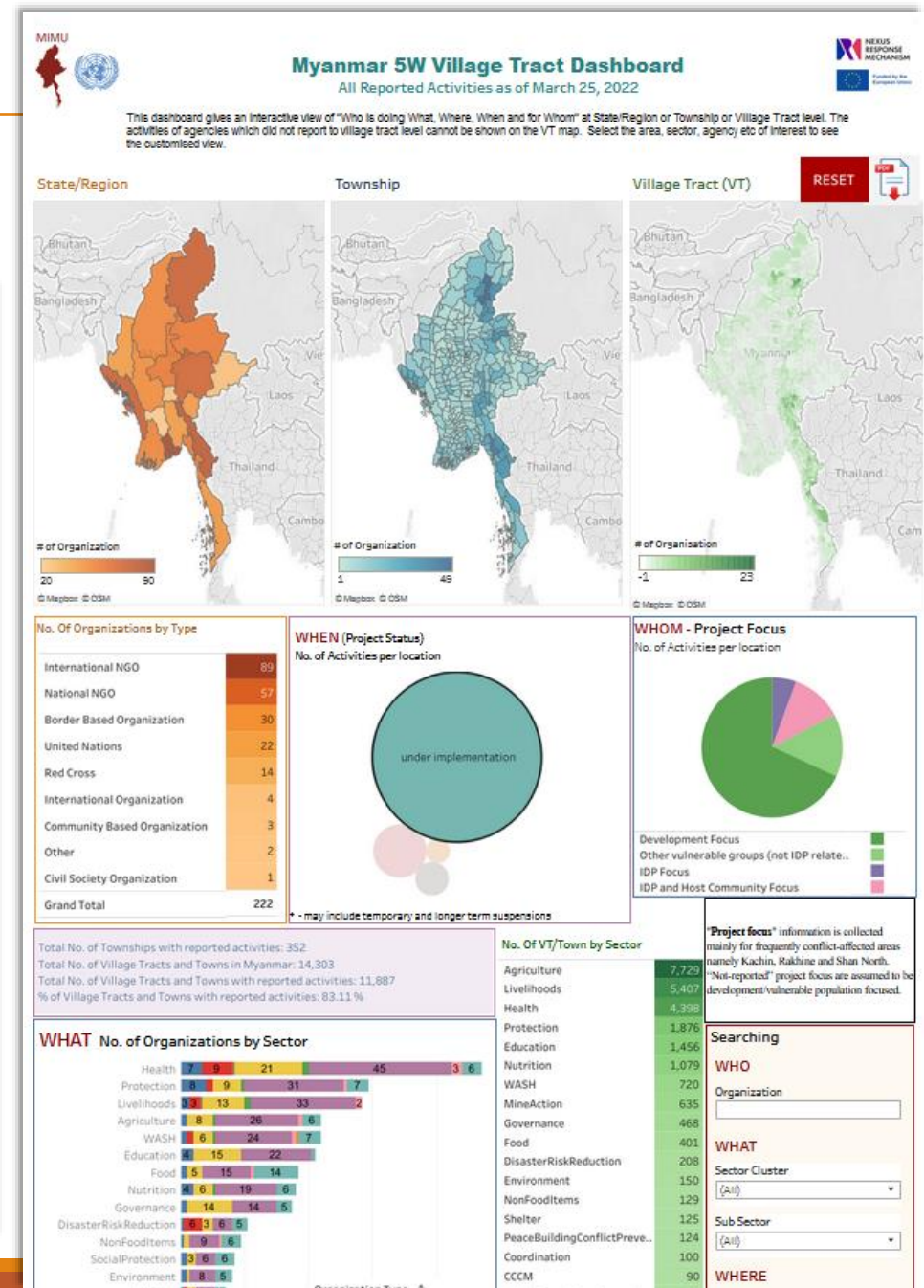
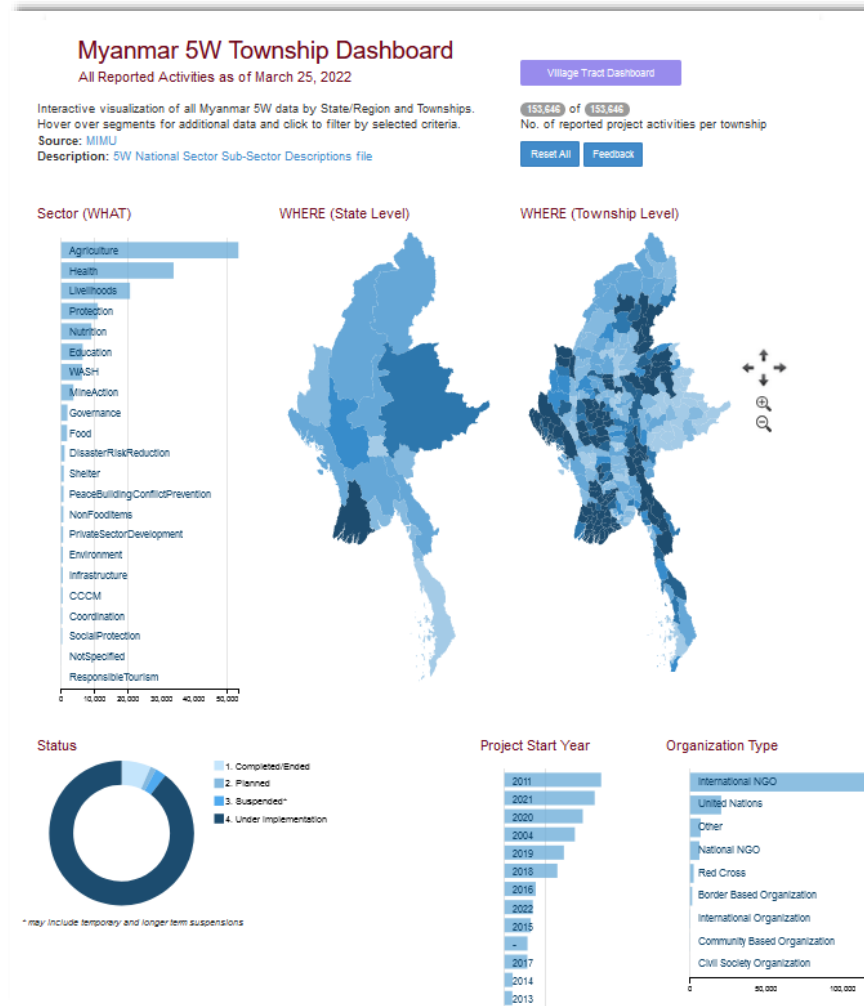

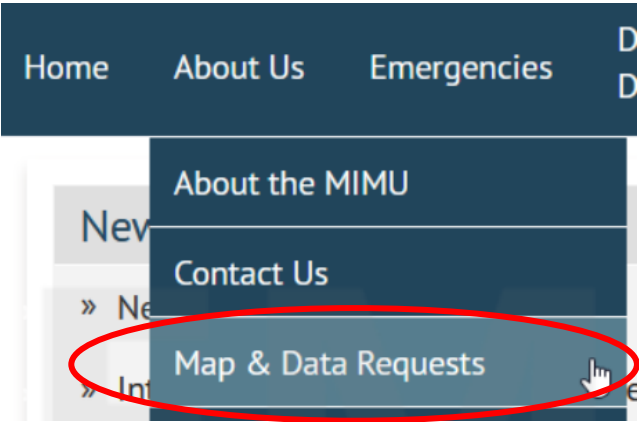
