## Sittwe disease surveillance

**Total number of consultations for Q1 is 66,444** with monthly average of 22,148. The top three reasons for consultation are common cold, hypertension and acute respiratory infection (ARI).

## Displacement situation

Sittwe has **92,529 IDPs** which is 80% of the total IDPs in Rakhine State (CCCM 2015 data).

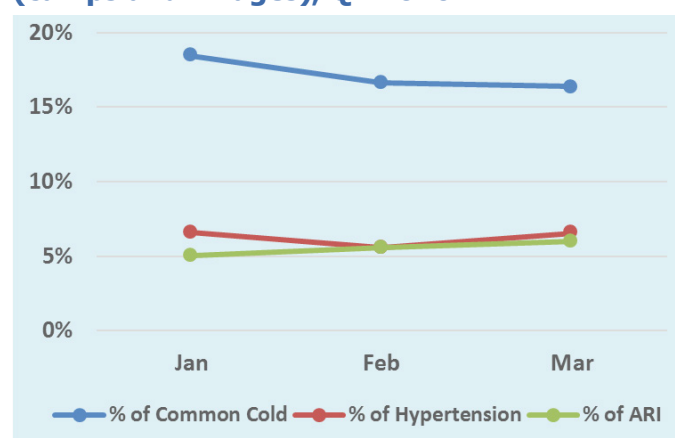

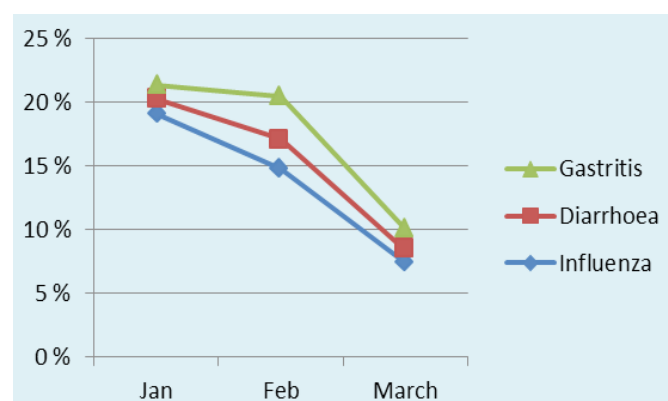
