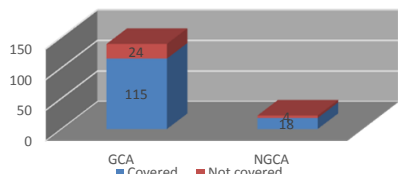


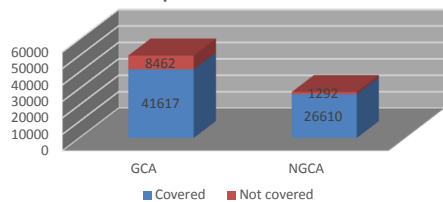
HIGHLIGHT OF THE MONTH

- ✓ About 300 participants including schools pupils, teachers, governmental representatives (DoPH, DoE), NGOs, INGOs and UNs staffs participated to Global Hand Washing Day and World Toilet Day event conducted on 8th Dec 2015.
- ✓ Rural WASH strategy workshop has been organized by UNICEF on 10th Dec 15 in Myitkyina with 93 participants from Governmental Departments (DoE, DoH, DRD, GAD, Planning, TDC, water resource) from 8 townships and from 3 humanitarian agencies, WASH situation monitoring was conducted by the WASH cluster team in 9 schools (total of 6372 students) in Myitkyina townships, Annual WASH cluster strategic review and lesson learnt workshops were conducted on 3-4 Dec 15 in Myitkyina with 41 participants from Governmental Departments (DRD, SDA, DoH, and DoE), WASH cluster members agencies and UN agencies,

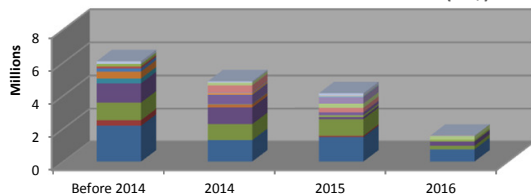
Location coverage



Population covered

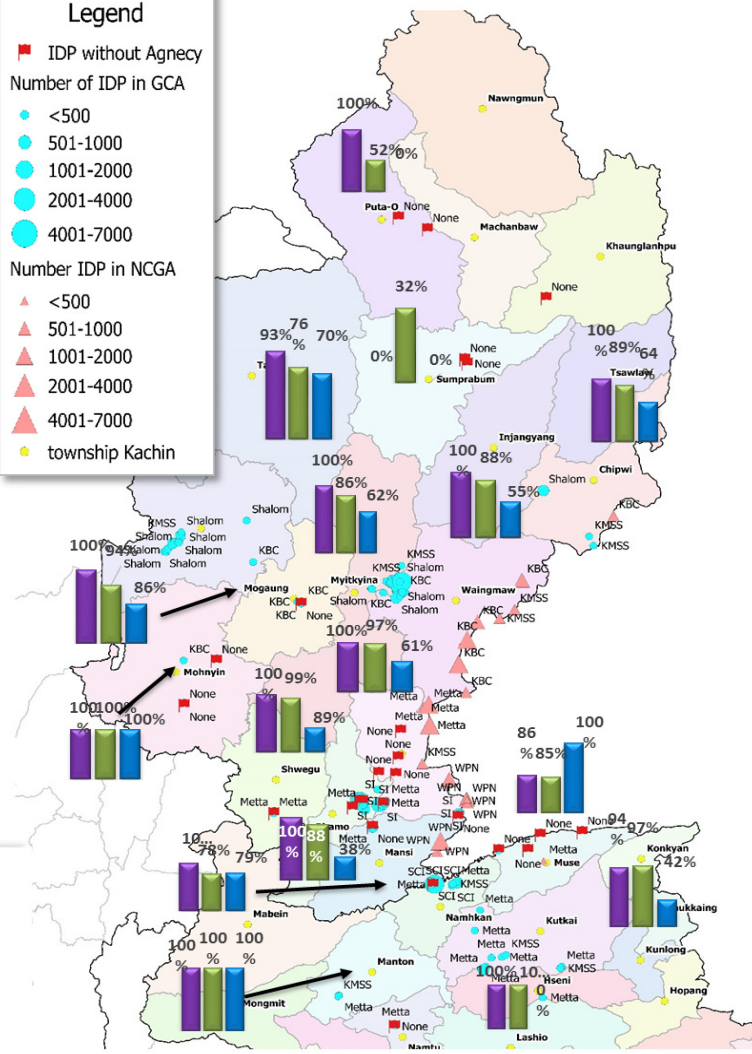


APPROXIMATE FUND ENGAGED PER YEAR (US\$)

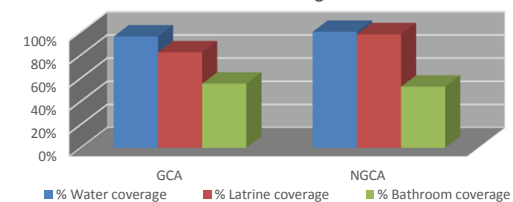

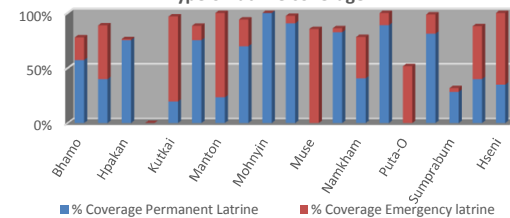

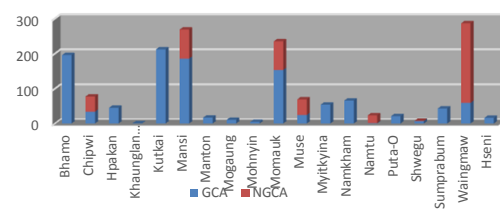
Needs Coverage



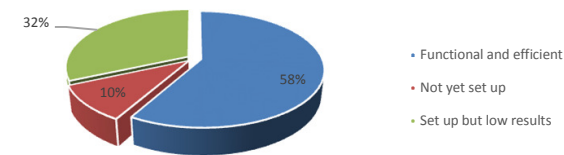
Type of latrine coverage



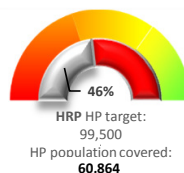
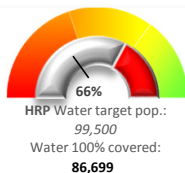
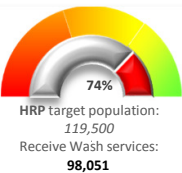
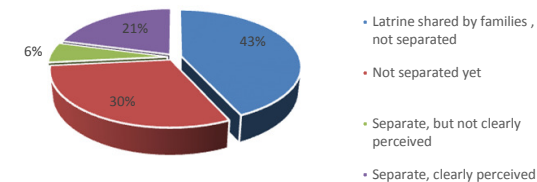
Number of latrine possible to be build vs space
