

HIGHLIGHT OF THE MONTH

- Wash cluster collected from partners and analysed the water quality of 346 water points
- The WASH situation in 69% of IDPs camps (105) of Kachin and NSS has been monitored over the last three months by the WASH associated to WASH focal agencies,
- A KAP survey has been conducted by Shalom in 17 camps of Hpakant area including 407 respondents (about 15% of total families),
- Response to the flooding in Mogaung township, Kachin, has been carried out through notably ERF mechanisms (SI) by the setting up of temporary emergency water supply,

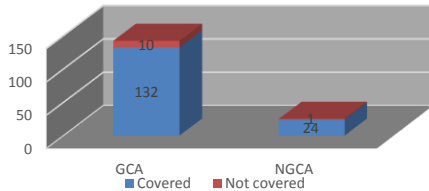

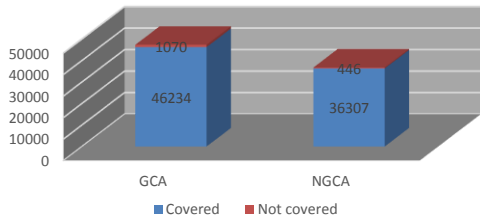

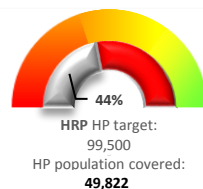
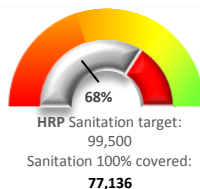
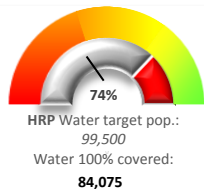
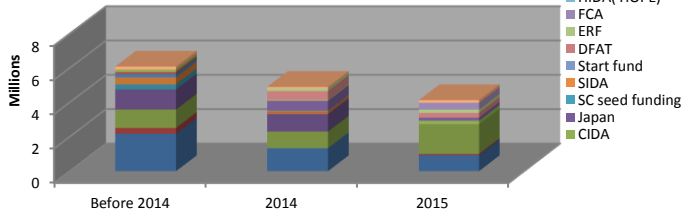
Location coverage



Population covered

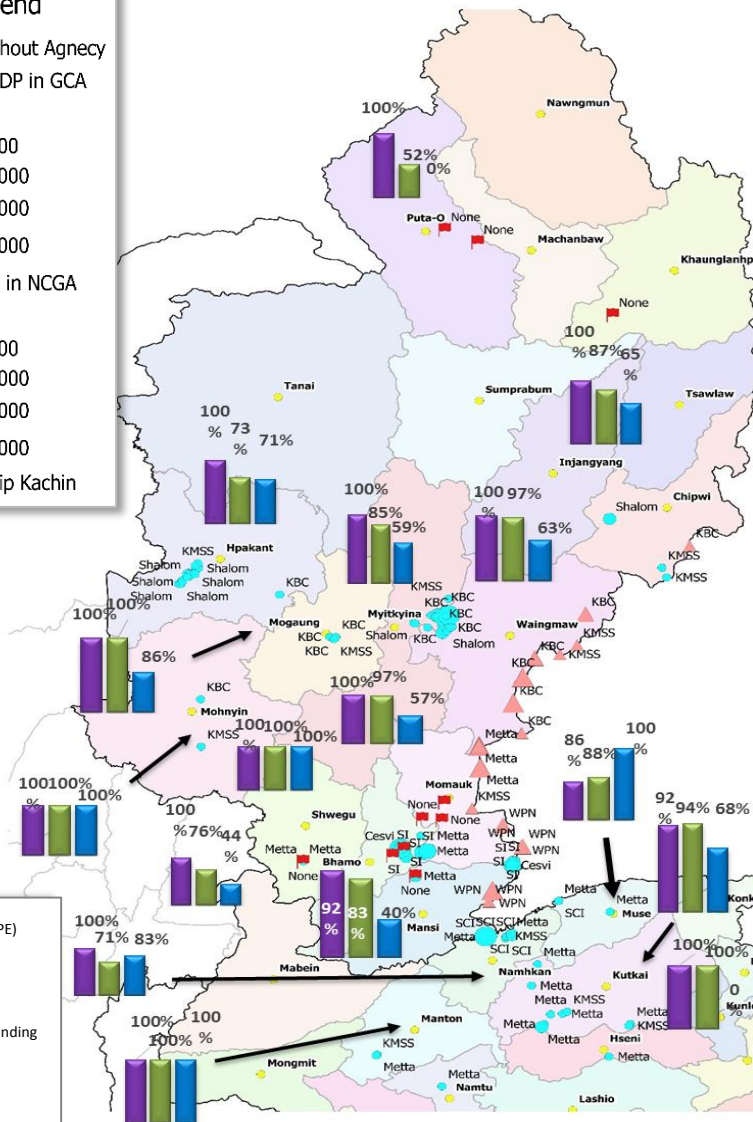


APPROXIMATE FUND ENGAGED PER YEAR (US\$)

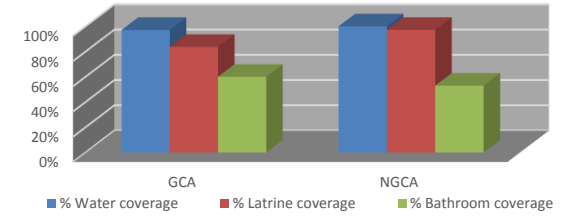


Limitation of analysis:

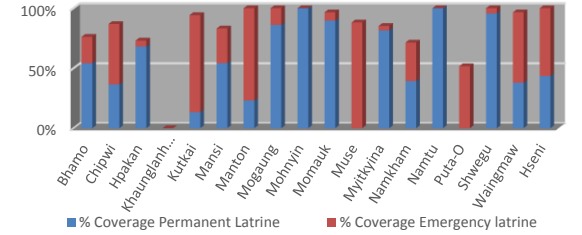
- Some location remain undocumented due to access

- Target 20,000 small scale emergency



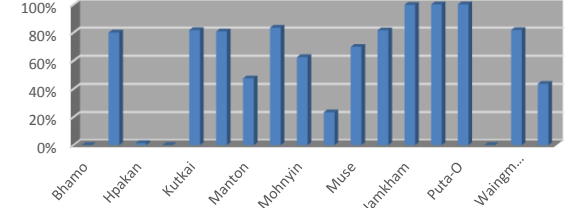
Needs Coverage



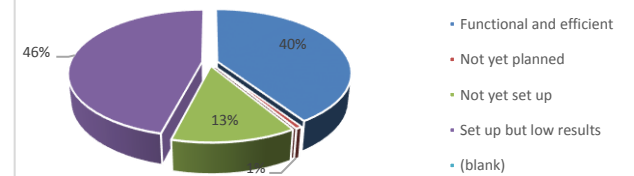
Type of latrine coverage
