



## **HIGHLIGHTS OF THE MONTH**


- > The government plan to support affected population was deployed in several location, tackling both village and camp set up. It led to multiplication of coordination meeting desagregated between maintenace and operation in camps and concerned villages
- > The wash needs are not adressed in that plan for villages
- In camps, assesment has been conducted by autorities, jointly with Camp management, about infrastructure (Shelter/Wash). Complete set of information should consolidated in May.
- Dry season Emergency water supply for camps continues



## Repartition beneficiary typology





- Camp with IDPs


