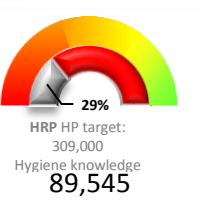
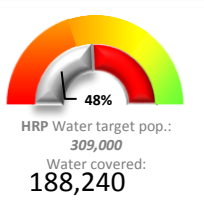
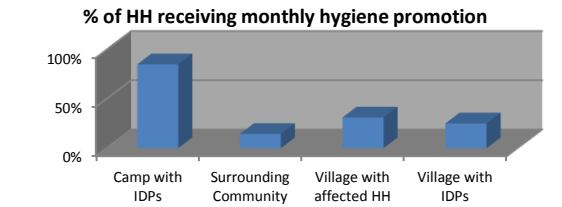
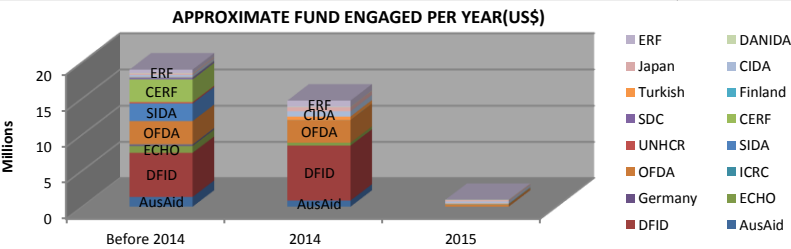
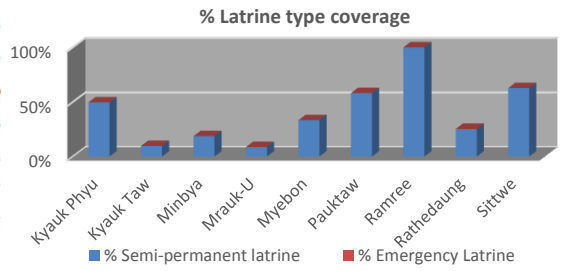
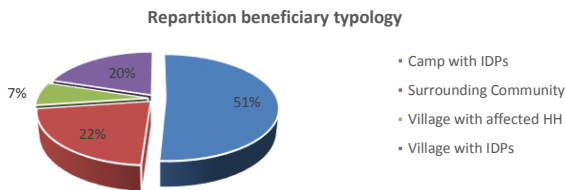
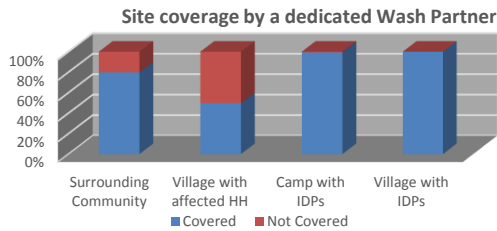
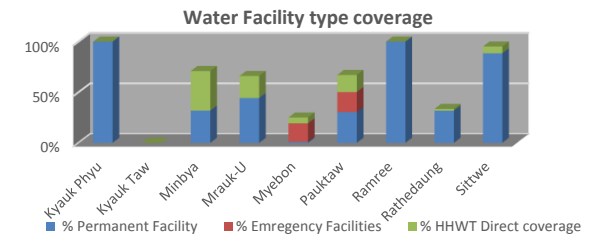
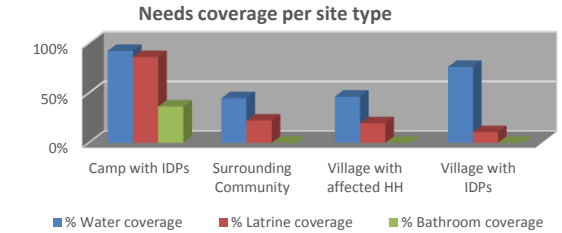
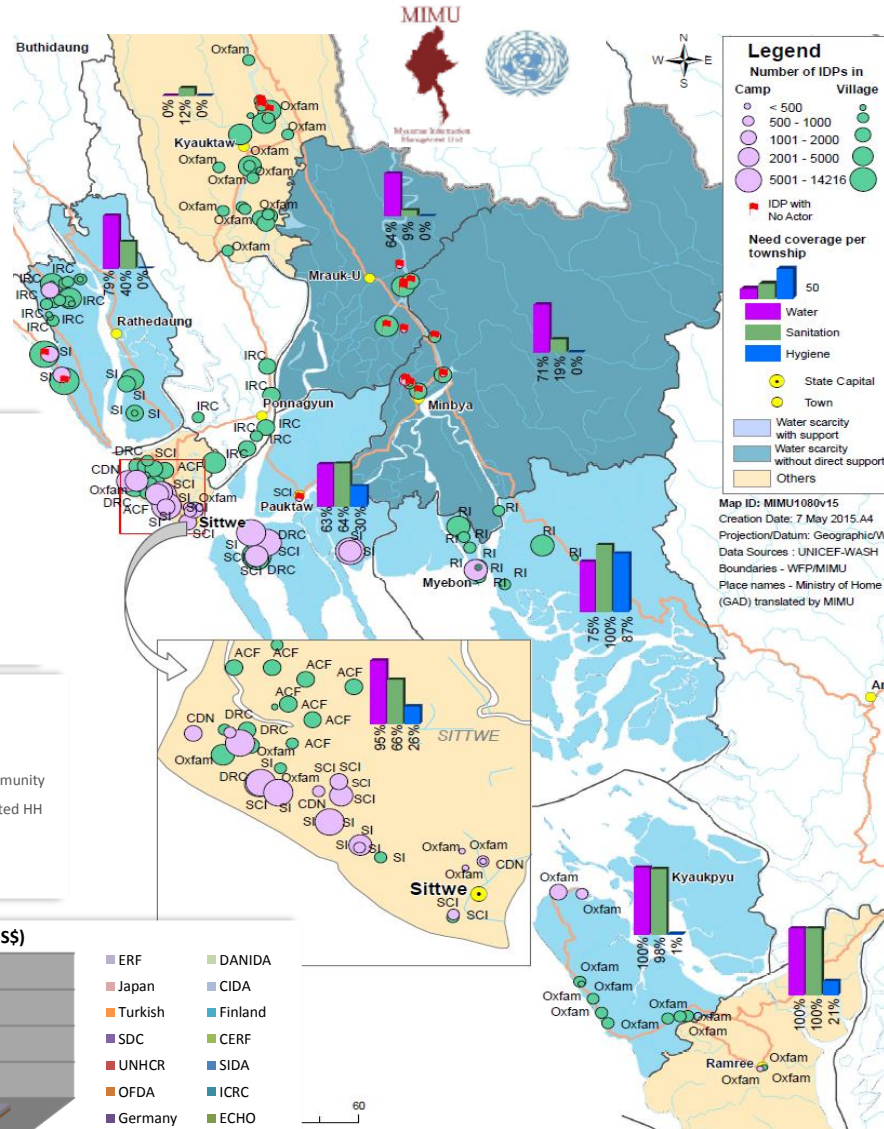


HIGHLIGHTS OF THE MONTH

- The government plan to support affected population was deployed in several location, tackling both village and camp set up. It led to multiplication of coordination meeting desegregated between maintenance and operation in camps and concerned villages
- The wash needs are not addressed in that plan for villages
- In camps, assesment has been conducted by authorities, jointly with Camp management, about infrastructure (Shelter/Wash). Complete set of information should consolidated in May.
- Dry season - Emergency water supply for camps continues



Limitations of the analysis:

- ✓ Lack of data on sanitation for villages where activities recently started
- ✓ No information provided for Maungdaw and Buthidaung townships
- ✓ Access to water does not report closely enough about safe drinking water
