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Specific Duties and Responsibilities

Project Implementation

- Coordinate with the respective private hospital, field agents and TB volunteers for initiation of TB diagnosis and provide the results from the diagnosis.
- Ensure quick turnaround time for integrated services delivery packages such as HIV, HCV, DM, and follow-up investigations including, sputum and CXR at GPs and private clinics.
- ❖ Facilitate the proper enrollment of notified TB cases in the Township Health Department with the coordination of the Treatment Coordinator.
- ❖ Ensure all TB patients undergo regular follow-up visits to respective GPs/private clinics.
- Ensure complete and accurate all the project records and data and report it to the Project coordinator or Treatment coordinator.
- Other project activities related to TB REACH Wave 10, as assigned by the project manager.
