MERCY Malaysia (<u>www.mercy.org.my</u>) is an international humanitarian nongovernmental and non-profit organisation with a Country Office registered with the Ministry of Home Affairs. MERCY Malaysia is a member of the International Council of Voluntary Agencies (ICVA) and Asian Disaster Reduction & Response Network (ADRRN), and has Special Consultative Status with the United Nations Economic & Social Council (ECOSOC) and is certified by the Humanitarian Accountability Partnership (HAP) International.

MERCY Malaysia provides medical relief, health services, risk reduction, and development programmes for vulnerable communities, in both crisis and non-crisis situations in Myanmar since 2008. MERCY Malaysia in Myanmar is currently undertaking Health Care Programmes in Rakhine State.

The Medical Officer (MO) is responsible for providing primary and secondary health care services in MERCY Malaysia's supported health facilities. The MO is responsible for managing emergency cases needing more specialized attention including, but not limited to, monitoring of admission cases hospitalized in the health facility. The MO, from time to time, will also be requested to represent MERCY Malaysia in health meetings with the government, other health actors and/or stakeholders. The MO also produces reports related to his/her task and contributes to the overall health programming of the organization. The MO reports directly to the Medical Coordinator.

The successful candidate must have a medical degree with a valid SAMA registration, and has at least two-year experience as a practicing doctor, ideally in field and remote locations. The candidate has strong analytical skills and excellent English communication. The candidate is also able to work and thrive in stressful operational environments, able to work long hours and is comfortable being around a diverse

group of people from various backgrounds. Experience in the NGO sector as well as in an international organization is an advantage. The candidate must be willing to be assigned both day and night time as per requirement of the situation.

The position is open to **Myanmar nationals only**. The position is based in Sittwe, Rakhine, but may be re-assigned either temporarily or permanently depending on need, specially during emergency response. The position is a full time assignment. The successful candidate will be entitled to an attractive compensation package.
