

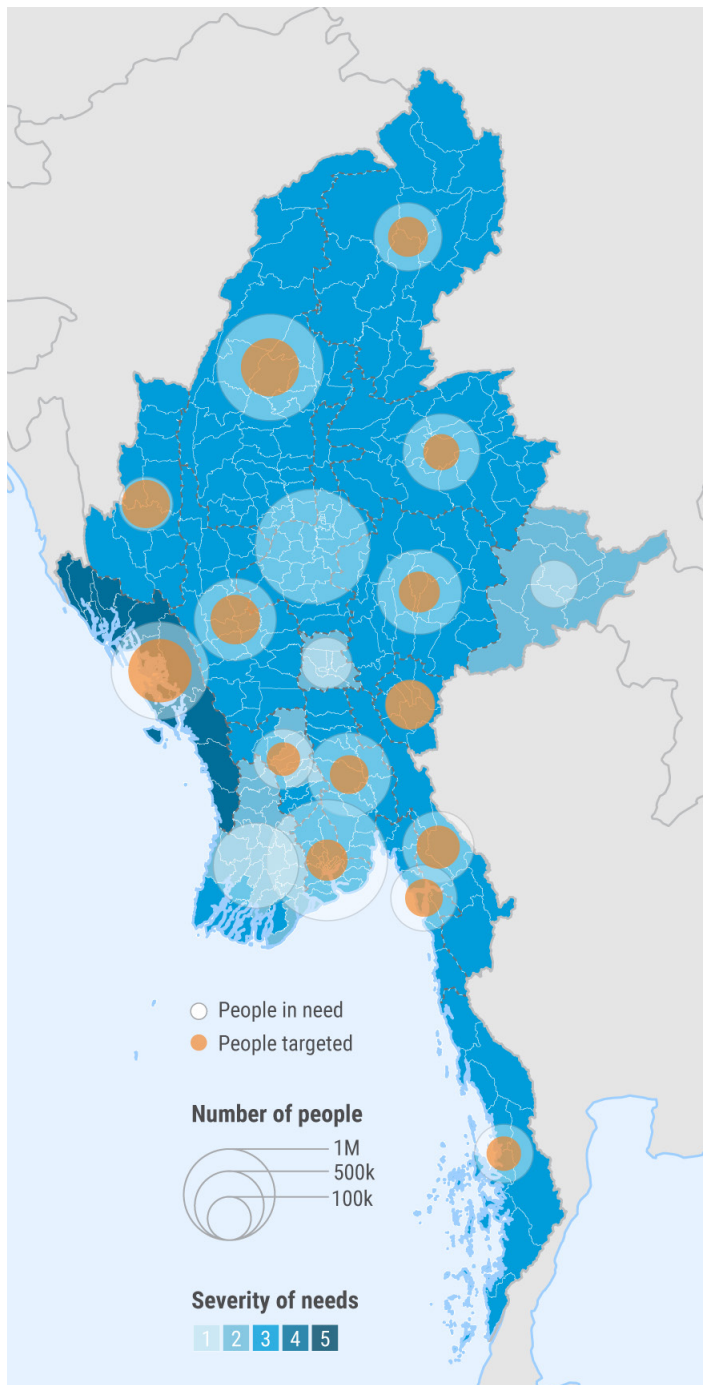


Food Security Cluster at a Glance

Other crisis-affected people with humanitarian needs	12.8M	845K

Cluster objectives and activities:

C01: Emergency life-saving food assistance is provided to IDPs, IDP-returnees and stateless people.

CA1: Provide emergency life-saving food assistance to IDPs, IDP-returnees, and stateless people.

C02: Emergency life-saving food assistance is provided to other crisis-affected people.

CA2: Provide emergency life-saving food assistance to other crisis-affected people.

C03: Emergency life-saving food production assistance is provided to IDPs, IDP-returnees, stateless people and other crisis-affected people.

CA3: Provide emergency life-saving food production assistance to IDPs, IDP-returnees, stateless people, and other crisis-affected people.

C04: Cluster coordination and information management are strengthened at all levels.

CA4: Dedicated cluster coordination and information management by 12 staff members: 1 national coordinator, 1 national co-coordinator, 1 national IMO, 1 national senior IMO, 4 subnational coordinators, and 4 subnational co-coordinators.
