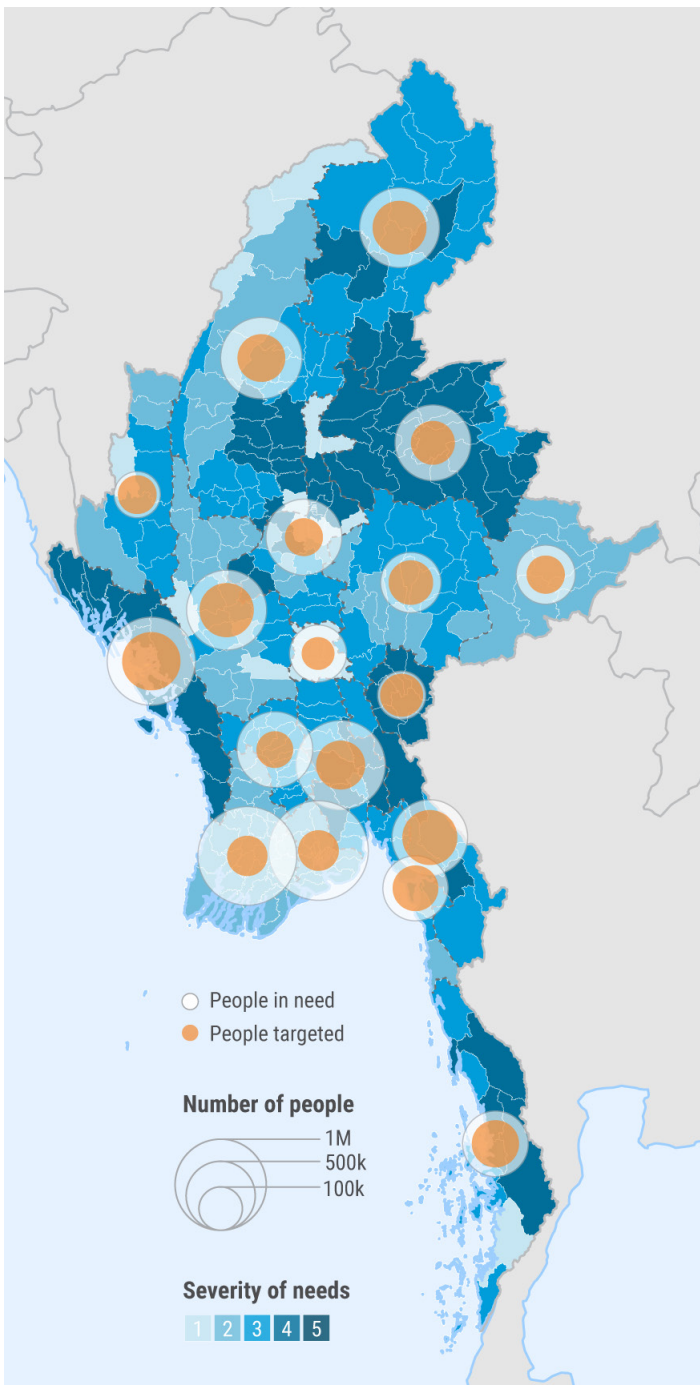

Cluster objectives and activities:

C01: Timely and effective validation and coordinated response to outbreaks are conducted.

CA1: Emergency verification and response, including disease outbreaks.

C02: Improved access to life-saving health services, ensuring quality and inclusive healthcare, among 1.7 million displaced, returned, stateless and other crisis-affected people.

CA2: Capacity building.

CA3: Delivery of primary health care.

CA4: Health promotion.

CA5: Medicines, supplies and equipment.

CA6: Mental health and psychosocial support services.

CA7: Patient referral.

CA8: Rehabilitation services and provision of assistive devices for persons with injuries and different forms of impairments.

CA9: Reproductive, maternal and child health care, including emergency obstetric care.

CA10: Support activities to national programme of immunization.

C03: Cluster coordination and information management are strengthened at all levels.

CA11: Dedicated cluster coordination and information management by 18 staff members: 1 national coordinator, 2 national IMOs, 10 subnational (co-)coordinators, and 5 subnational IMOs.

CA12: Coordination.
