



#### Cluster objectives and activities:

CO1: Evolving protection concerns, needs, and violations are monitored, analyzed, and responded to through multilayered protection response, upholding fundamental rights and restoring the dignity, physical safety and well-being of affected populations. (Monitoring and Response)

- CA1: Provision of targeted/specialized protection support and case management services to persons with specific needs and persons living in heightened risk.
- CA2: Provision of legal aid support and access to civil documentation.
- CA3: Strengthen protection assessments, monitoring, incident reporting and joint protection analysis among protection actors.
- CA4: Provision of specialised MHPSS services.

CO2: A conducive environment to prevent and mitigate protection risks and concerns is supported through inclusive, localized community protection approaches, mainstreaming of protection and enhancement of capacity of protection and non-protection actors to address the impacts of armed conflict and other shocks on civilians. (Risk mitigation and prevention)

- CA5: Support community awareness raising for prevention and mitigation of protection risks.
- CA6: Support community-based protection and accountability structures and community-led risk mitigation initiatives.

CO3: Cluster coordination and information management are strengthened at all levels.

- CA7: Strengthen mainstreaming and localization approaches through capacity building and engagement with partners and stakeholders.
- CA8: Dedicated cluster coordination and information management by 13 staff members: 1 national coordinator, 1 national co-coordinator, 1 national IMO, 4 subnational IMOs, 1 national co-IMO, 1 national officer, and 4 subnational coordinators.
