## **WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS**

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) increased from 932,400 last week to 933,100 this week.

As a result of increased fighting in Shan State (North), 481 people from Lashio Township have been displaced to Kyethi Township.

In addition, 200 people from Tanintharyi Township have been newly displaced within the same township.


