WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) increased from 922,100 last week to 923,700 this week.

As a result of increased fighting in Shan State (North), 1,933 people from Lashio Township were displaced to Loilen, Taunggyi, Lawksawk, Nansang, Laihka and Mongkaing townships in Shan State (South).

In Kayah State, 166 IDPs Demoso Township and 127 IDPs from Hpruso returned to their place of origin in their respective townships.
