Number of people displaced in South East since Feb 2021 and remain displaced



WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of conflict-affected IDPs slightly decreased from 970,700 last week to 970,600 this week.

In Tanintharyi Region, Thayetchaung Township saw both displacements within the same township two weeks ago, followed by returns nearly seven days later.

Other returns could be verified in Hsihseng Township (180 displaced persons), in Shan State (South), as well as in Demoso Township (130 IDPs), in Kayah State.




