

WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of IDPs increased from 1.045.300 last week to 1.050.300 this week.

In Bago Region (East), 1,414 Taungoo Township were displaced within the same township, while 698 and 890 people respectively from Htantabin and Thandaunggyi Townshis fled to Taungoo Town due to the intensified clashes that included the employment of airstrikes, drone strikes and artillery shelling by the Tatmadaw.

In Tanintharyi Region, 2,000 people from Chaung La Mu, Tanintharyi Township were displaced within the same township due to the air bombardment.
