EUR 46 million in humanitarian and emergency aid funding¹

The Joint Environmental Unit from UNEP/OCHA (29 March, closed), UN OCHA Myanmar (30 March) and WHO (4 April) have requested assistance from the UCPM. 6 Member States have offered assistance in WASH, food, shelter and medical items:




Other EU support:

- 7 EU HAB flights transporting over 386 tonnes** including ReliefEU stocks and other in-kind assistance
- 2 ERCC Liaison Officers** were deployed to Bangkok
- 1 EU Civil Protection Team composed of 12 members** was deployed to Bangkok

On 28 March, Copernicus EMS On-Demand Rapid Mapping Service was requested to provide damage assessment emergency mapping ([EMSR798](#)): **147 damage assessment maps** have been produced.
