Given the new HNO/HRP process, the WASH Objectives will have to be classified amongst Humanitarian consequences. In Myanmar, 2 Humanitarian Consequences apply: *Living standards* and *Physical and mental wellbeing*. The SAG will decide on Objectives that will be classified accordingly.
